Post-Game Coaches' Quotes

Clemson Head Coach Dabo Swinney

Overall Thoughts:

"Well, I'm very proud of our players. I really appreciate our fans tonight. Our fans deserve this win, our players deserve this win, and the administration deserves this win. Championship teams find a way to win games, and that's what we've been teaching these guys. And they found a way to win, despite many obstacles. This team rose up in the fourth quarter and refused to lose.

"You have to believe to be a champion, and these guys believed tonight. I'm proud of the seniors. They stepped up as leaders tonight. Durrell Barry caught a pass that was a critical momentum-changer for us. The defense produced five turnovers, which was great. And C.J. Spiller and Jacoby Ford are now the all-time all-purpose duo in NCAA history. Overall, these guys stepped up, made adjustments, and got the win.

"Were happy, but we're not satisfied. We still have more games to play, so we still have to go back to work and get ready for the NC State game next week. We've come far, but we still have a ways to go."

On the team's play in the fourth quarter:

"We've taught these guys to be a lot tougher. They are mentally and physically tougher than they were in the beginning of the season. During the fourth quarter, we used a lot of mental toughness to overcome the pressures of the game. We made mistakes, but we did capitalize on critical moments, and took the momentum in the fourth quarter."

On the play of his defense:

"We couldn't stop them in the first half. We came in at halftime and made good adjustments, and these guys executed. Florida State throws the ball well, and I'm proud of our secondary's efforts tonight. Chris Chancellor went out of the game due to a leg injury, and Byron Maxwell, Xavier Brewer, and Coty Sensabaugh stepped up and got the job done. Overall, I'm really proud of the defensive efforts from our guys."

On the game atmosphere:

"The atmosphere was great tonight. The fans really had the stadium rockin'. I'm happy for our fans, because they deserve this win. They really came out tonight and have been supporting this team all season."

Thoughts on the Game:

"I think that game is pretty easy to summarize. I thought that Spiller was the difference in the ball game. He is one guy that made the biggest difference. Our problem was turnovers. I was concerned last week when our quarterback was unable to practice, and when I was interviewed yesterday, I was concerned that he would lose his timing by not throwing much. I wouldn't take a thing away from Clemson. They won. They deserved to win and made more big plays than we did. We hung with them for three and a half quarters and then Clemson won the ball game."

On the play of C.J. Spiller:

"I doubt if anybody is playing better than him in the country. I look at the running back at Alabama and he is mighty good, but Spiller is such a dynamic player. The happiest I was, was when he was off the field. I knew he couldn't get the ball. We talked all week about the wheel route, and he runs it one time and it was about ninety miles per hour for a touchdown. That is why I say he is mighty hard to handle."

Where would you rank him, having seen some really great players?:

"I would rank him pretty high. The people that recruit those kinds of guys, they are the ones that have a chance to win national championships because it is people like him that can get you in there. He is the kind of guy that can put you on top."

On emotions in the ball game:

"There were some critical errors. We probably scored on some of their errors too. We turned the ball over and they would go down and score and then we would turn it over and they wouldn't score. The game kind of went that way. We felt very comfortable, but you know you haven't won yet. Then of course the dam broke."

On the Rashard Hall interception and lateral:

"That was when we were ahead by three. He (Christian Ponder) hardly ever under throws that and he just under threw it. It is probably my fault I think I probably suggested it."

On series between FSU and Clemson:

"They have just played better than us and have probably been better. We have lost to some other folks too, though."

On defense in the first half:

"We played with fire all year, we just made too many mistakes."

Clemson vs. Florida State postgame notes

November 7, 2009

Team Notes

- *Prior to this evening's game, Clemson head coach Dabo Swinney and defensive coordinator Kevin Steele presented Florida State defensive coordinator Mickey Andrews with a Clemson helmet signed by the Clemson staff, and a football signed by the Clemson team. The presentation was made privately outside the Florida State locker room. Andrews announced he is retiring at the end of the season. He served as an assistant coach at Clemson from 1977-80.
- *Clemson had five penalties in the first half, including one when the Tigers had first and goal from the half yard line. Coming into the game, Clemson averaged 4.6 penalties, fourth best in the country. Clemson ended the contest with 7-60 in penalties.
- *Clemson finished with 241 yards rushing and 242 yards passing for 483 total, a season high. It was the first game all year Clemson has had at least 200 of each. Clemson is now 51-0-1 in the history of its program when it has at least 200 yards or each.
- *Clemson had four interceptions as a team for 82 return yards. The Tigers now have 19 interceptions for the year.
- *Clemson missed three extra points in tonight's game. The Tigers had made 116 consecutive extra points over the last three years prior to tonight's game. Richard Jackson had been 25-25 entering tonight's game, but missed two this evening.
- *Clemson has now scored at least 38 points in four straight games. This is the first time Clemson has done that in the history of the program.

Individual Notes

- *CJ Spiller had a Clemson record 312 all-purpose yards in tonight's game. He broke his own record of 310 against Miami (FL) just two weeks ago. His performance included a career high 165 yards rushing. His previous high was 155 against NC State in 2006.
- *CJ Spiller had three receptions tonight for 67 yards. The three catches give him 108 for his career, a school record for a running back. The previous high was 105 by Travis Zachery, who played from 1998-01.
- *Spiller went over the 3000-yard mark in terms of rushing in this evening's game and now has 3074 for his career. He moved ahead of Kenny Flowers (2914) and Travis Zachery (3058) on Clemson's career list tonight and is now in third place. His former teammate James Davis (3881) and Raymond Priester (3966) are the only players ahead of him.
- *Spiller became just the second player in Clemson history to go over 3000 yards rushing and 1000 receiving in tonight's game. Zachery is the only other Tiger to do it. Spiller now has 3074 rushing and 1251 receiving.
- *Spiller now has 6702 all-purpose running yards. He moved ahead of Reggie Bush on the all-time NCAA list tonight. Bush finished his career at USC with 6551. Spiller now needs just 298 all-purpose yards to become the fifth player in NCAA history to reach 7000 all-purpose yards.
- *Kyle Parker threw four touchdown passes tonight to tie the Clemson single game record for a freshman. Charlie Whitehurst threw four against Duke and North Carolina in 2002, his freshman year. Parker now has 14 touchdown passes, breaking the previous record for a freshman. Whitehurst had 10 in 2002. Parker also established the record for passing yards by a freshman tonight. He now has 1665 for the year, breaking the previous mark of 1554 by Whitehurst in 2002.
- *CJ Spiller scored his 20th career touchdown of 50 yards or more, eighth this season, off of a 58-yard pass from Kyle Parker in the third quarter.
- *With the 36-yard rush by CJ Spiller in the third quarter, Spiller and Jacoby Ford became the all-time all-purpose yard leaders for two teammates. The previous record was 10,253 set by Marshall Faulk and Darnay Scott of San Diego State from 1991-93. Spiller and Ford now have 10,334.
- *DeAndre McDaniel's 8th interception ties a Clemson single season record. Robert O'Neal (1989) and Justin Miller (2002) also had eight in a year.
- *Graduate Durrell Barry caught a two-yard touchdown pass in the fourth period. It was his second career TD, his first since his freshman year when he caught a 32-yard scoring pass against Kentucky in the Music City Bowl. It was Barry's first catch this year and the ninth of his career. Four of his nine career catches are against Florida State.

PICK SIX FOR PALMETTO STATE'S J-ROB

Florida State senior free safety Jamie Robinson, a South Carolina native, returned a Kyle Parker interception 52 yards for the first touchdown of his career. It was the third interception in as many weeks for Robinson, who collected 27 interceptions during his high school career at Rock Hill Northwestern. He has four career interceptions for the Seminoles.

WATSON MAKES IMPACT AS WELL

Senior linebacker Dekoda Watson, another South Carolina native playing for the final time as a collegian in his home state, enjoyed a big first half as well. The South Aiken grad posted four tackles, including one tackle-for-loss, recovered a fumble on Markus White's late-half sack and added a quarterback hurry.

PRYOR FINDS END ZONE ... AS RECEIVER

Freshman running back Lonnie Pryor's 49-yard touchdown reception from Christian Ponder in the opening quarter was his first receiving score of the season and his first touchdown since scoring twice on runs against BYU on Sept. 19. Pryor is the eighth different Seminole to collect a touchdown pass this season.

HALFTIME LEAD HAS BEEN GOOD OMEN

Leading at the half against Clemson has been a good omen for Florida State. The Seminoles are 14-1 when leading at halftime in the 22 previous meetings between the schools. The lone loss came in 1976, FSU coach Bobby Bowden's first season, when the Seminoles carried a 9-0 lead into the locker room but suffered a 15-12 loss in Tallahassee. The last time the 'Noles held a halftime lead at Clemson was 2001 when they turned a 27-10 lead into a 41-27 victory. FSU has lost its last three games at Clemson Memorial Stadium.

FIRST QUARTER SCORING FLURRY

Jumping out to a 17-6 lead at the end of the first quarter marked a rare outburst on the road over the first 15 minutes of play by Florida State. The last time the Seminoles scored more than 17 points in the first quarter on the road was Oct. 14, 2006 at Duke, when they put up 21 en route to a 51-24 victory over the Blue Devils. The last time the Seminoles scored more than 17 points in the opening quarter of any game was Sept. 13, 2008 against Chattanooga, when they put up 21 on the way to a 46-7 victory.

HOPKINS DIALED IN

Freshman kicker Dustin Hopkins' 35-yard field goal on the Seminoles' opening possession, which put FSU ahead 3-0, was his sixth consecutive successful conversion. Hopkins' streak began with a 40-yard field goal against Georgia Tech (Oct. 10), following a miss from 45 yards. The streak includes field goals of 40, 48, 26, 40, 24 and 35 yards. His streak ended with a 58-yard miss on the final play of the half, though he did earn a solo tackle of Crezdron Butler on the return.

TIGERS RECOGNIZE ANDREWS

Retiring Florida State defensive coordinator Mickey Andrews, who spent four seasons as a Clemson assistant (1977-80), was recognized prior to the game for his contributions to the Tigers and his excellence over 26 seasons with the Seminoles. Clemson head coach Dabo Swinney and assistants Brad Scott and Kevin Steele – former FSU assistants – presented Andrews with an autographed helmet and football in the locker room before the game.

THOMAS OVER 100, AGAIN

With a 13-yard carry on the first play of the fourth quarter, FSU sophomore tailback Jermaine Thomas eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark for the second consecutive game. Thomas finished with 119 yards on 26 carries. It marks the first time since an FSU back strung together consecutive 100-yard rushing games since Antone Smith during the 2007 season, when he ran for 114 against Miami (Oct. 20) and followed with 146 against Duke (Oct. 27). Thomas was coming off a 186-yard rushing effort against N.C. State last week.

NEW SEASON HIGH FOR THOMAS

Thomas established a new season-high for rushing yardage with his second consecutive 100-yard performance. It pushed his season total to 497 yards on 95 carries. As a freshman, Thomas ran for 482 yards on 69 carries and a team-leading 7.0 yards per carry. He came into the Clemson game with 860 career rushing yards.

OWENS MATCHES GAME-HIGH FOR GRABS

FSU senior wide receiver Rod Owens matched his career, game-high for receptions with nine (for 77 yards) against Tigers. Three weeks ago the Jacksonville native collected nine receptions for a career-high 199 yards against North Carolina. Over the past three games, Owens has 25 receptions for 332 yards. He came into his final season of eligibility with 30 career receptions for 351 yards.
