STATEMENT BY NORTH CAROLINA COACH JIM HICKEY:

"I thought we played fairly well for a long time, and then the interference call killed us. We never were the same team after that. It was the same old story. We had our chances and just couldn't take advantage of them.

"Clemson has a good, tough football ~~me~~ team and I congratulate Frank Howard on his fine victory.

"We could snap out of this losing streak if we could get some of our key players healthy again. I don't want to sound like I'm alibing, but I've never been associated with a group of boys as crippled up as this one is.

"Talbot couldn't maneuver well out there on his bad ankle. You could see that. I don't think he suffered any great additional injury to the ankle today. But we just decided to hold him out in the second half rather than risk additional injury.

"I suppose Clemson passed on us better than anyone has. We didn't have a very good rush."

POSTGAME QUOTES: by Coach Frank Howard

"I don't want to sound like I ain't glad to win like this, but I thought we looked awfully tired when we should have been sharp today.

"We thought we could win. But neither of the teams was hitting as hard out there today as they was up at Chapel Hill last year. (Clemson lost 17-13)

"When you beat a fellow like Jim Hickey you can't enjoy it as much as beating somebody you don't like. Ole Hickey is a great fellow and he's had some tough problems. He's in a heck of a fix.

"I ain't gonna give no scouting report on myself, but we put in some single wing passes during the week and they worked good today. But don't ask nothing about 'em cause we won't to let the other teams do their own scouting.

"I thought my quarterback, Addison, did a good job today. The offensive line gives him good protection on the passes, but they ain't blocking like they should.

The line is sluggish. Another thing that hurt us on defense although it shouldn't have is the fact that North Carolina was running a little different wrinkle in their offense. Our defense had to adjust to it. It took 'em a while to do it.

"I think switching Mac McKilmurray to middle guard helped us a lot. And I'm glad to have Craig (Arthur) back in there--he's one heck of a tough hombre."

"I'm gonna rest the team a little more in the next few weeks during practice. They tired--they been playing since August. They ain't got the zip they should have.

"My fullback Cooper did a good job. He has come through in the last two games.

"I ain't gonna be satisfied until this team of mine ~~take that~~ takes that ball and drives it right down somebody's throat everytime they get the ball.

STATEMENT BY NORTH CAROLINA COACH JIM HICKEY:

"I thought we played fairly well for a long time, and then the interference call killed us. We never were the same team after that. It was the same old story. We had our chances and just couldn't take advantage of them.

"Clemson has a good, tough football ~~me~~ team and I congratulate Frank Howard on his fine victory.

"We could snap out of this losing streak if we could get some of our key players healthy again. I don't want to sound like I'm alibing, but I've never been associated with a group of boys as crippled up as this one is.

"Talbot couldn't maneuver well out there on his bad ankle. You could see that. I don't think he suffered any great additional injury to the ankle today. But we just decided to hold him out in the second half rather than risk additional injury.

"I suppose Clemson passed on us better than anyone has. We didn't have a very good rush."

POSTGAME QUOTES: by Coach Frank Howard

"I don't want to sound like I ain't glad to win like this, but I thought we looked awfully tired when we should have been sharp today.

"We thought we could win. But neither of the teams was hitting as hard out there today as they was up at Chapel Hill last year. (Clemson lost 17-13)

"When you beat a fellow like Jim Hickey you can't enjoy it as much as beating somebody you don't like. Ole Hickey is a great fellow and he's had some tough problems. He's in a heck of a fix.

"I ain't gonna give no scouting report on myself, but we put in some single wing passes during the week and they worked good today. But don't ask nothing about 'em cause we won't to let the other teams do their own scouting.

"I thought my quarterback, Addison, did a good job today. The offensive line gives him good protection on the passes, but they ain't blocking like they should.

The line is sluggish. Another thing that hurt us on defense although it shouldn't have is the fact that North Carolina was running a little different wrinkle in their offense. Our defense had to adjust to it. It took 'em a while to do it.

"I think switching Mac McElmurray to middle guard helped us a lot. And I'm glad to have Craig (Arthur) back in there--he's one heck of a tough hombre."

"I'm gonna rest the team a little more in the next few weeks during practice. They tired--they been playing since August. They ain't got the zip they should have.

"My fullback Cooper did a good job. He has come through in the last two games.

"I ain't gonna be satisfied until this team of mine ~~take that~~ takes that ball and drives it right down somebody's throat everytime they get the ball.
