

Weather: Sunny, Warm, partly cloudy

Maryland Coach Ward: (Asked about the two calls against Maryland--the one in which Clemson was thought (by Maryland) to have trapped a pass and the touchdown pass to Dutton which was disallowed)--"This seems to be the story of our life this year. We just don't get the break on close calls. I did not think the officiating was too good."

(The TD play, with Fitzpatrick tossing to Gillespie, was one of the surprises concocted for Clemson this past week).

(This was only the second touchdown of the year for Maryland and Gillespie is the only other player besides Dick Carlson to have scored for the Terps)

CLEMSON COACH FRANK HOWARD: "Well, we were just lucky to win that one. Of course, we pulled off some good plays out there, but we just weren't sharp. We gonna have to get better for those Wolfpack ~~is~~ fellows next week. I was sorry to hear that No. 6 State lost. I was not hoping they would come down here with a clean slate.

"Gore's run was pretty. We had good blocking on that one. If they would block like that every time we ran the ball, we'd have a lot more points on the board week after week.

"All I heard this week was how we were going to have to get ready for ~~Mississippi~~ State and then again for South Carolina. Nobody even mentioned Maryland. Well, you saw out there today what can happen when you don't count on a rough game. Maryland played a good game, despite what everybody thought about them. They've had a lot of tough breaks and actually they should have won some games this season.

"I know we could have played a better game, but heck, we scored four touchdowns and I can't complain I don't guess. Our best game this season was Alabama but we didn't win, so there you go. When it's all over, no matter how you played, it's the points on the board that counts. I'm just glad that we had 28 of 'em today."

CLEMSON COACH FRANK HOWARD: " Well, we were just lucky to win that one. Of course, we pulled off some good plays out there, but we just weren't sharp. We gonna have to get better for those Wolfpack ~~ix~~ fellows next week. I was sorry to hear that N.C. State lost. I was ~~not~~ hoping they would come down here with a clean slate.

" Gore's run was pretty. We had good blocking on that one. If they would block like that every time we ran the ball, we'd have a lot more points on the board week after week.
