STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

I don't think we played very good, but we played good enough to win. We gotta get a lot better before next week (against Georgia), but I think we'll get all right.

It's been a long time since a defensive team of mine had to play that much, and that was one thing I wasn't sure of. But they played better than I thought they would. But we gotta work on that offense.

Watts and Southerland and Hefner did a pretty good job in there on defense.

I thought Virginia played real well. I don't think we ever found out who to block out there.

But we're gonna have to improve a whole lot. We might do better under better conditions, but you gotta remember, Virginia was playing on the same field we was.

At the midfield meeting between Howard and Blackburn, Howard complimented Blackburn on his defense. "You get a little better offense going out there, Blackie," Howard said, "and you'll have a heckuva of a ball club."
