## COACHES QUOTES

Coach Heotie Ingram: Even though it might have looked like we were trying to freeze the ball in the second half, we weren't. We broke more big plays in the second half than we did in the first, but we couldn't hold the ball.

We had that little pass we were getting to (Don) Kelley, which caused them to have to double cover him and that opened up our dive play some.

I thought we put some good pressure on ~~Mr~~ Nevills and the did a fairly good job covering their receivers.

When we called for a run just before we missed the first down (late in the fourth quarter), I thought a good play was called and I thought we had a first down. But we didn't want to kick a field goal because it might get blocked and if we had punted, we couldn't have gained more than 10 yards out of it.

We tried to do a few things with the 'I' today because of some of their defenses, and we got some good yardage off it. We did a few bad things defensively and we had a few bad calls on third down on offense.

We approached this thing at halftime like we always do by going over our mistakes and trying to make corrections. They hurt us some with their big line splits and we tried to adjust to those. We didn't think that 17 points was enough at halftime.

Ken Pengitore started because at times I think he can get things done better than Kendrick and Tommy is better on other things. Kendrick is the ~~master~~ master of the automatic. Several times we called a bad play in the huddle and he got us out of it at the line of scrimmage.

Overall, I ~~was~~ was pleased with the performance. We can overlook some of these things when you win, but ~~we~~ we'll certainly go over all of them when we grade the films.

Coach Roy Lester: I thought our offense did not play well in the first half and gave the defense poor field position.

Clemson looked real good, Kendrick especially. He appeared to do an excellent job picking our his secondary receivers and hitting the man over the middle. Clemson hurt us with penetration from the back side. I did not think our offensive line blocked as well as they did last week but many of the tackles were not made at the line but from the back side.

Our offense of course did not look as well as last week but Clemson gave us a different coverage while Penn State let us thro. Clemson has a pretty good defense and they are tough.

Questioned as to why Guy Roberts did not play: "We did not think it was in the best interest of the team to play him today. I had a long talk with him last night.
