POST-GAME STATEMENTS BY THE COACHES

BY COACH BILL FULCHER OF GEORGIA TECH

"You hope when you have a day like today that you can make the big plays, and we did.

"Clemson put a very good rush on our quarterback which slowed our passing game. We executed poorly all afternoon and I'm sure that fine play by the Clemson defense was responsible for a lot of it.

"Things really began to get scary in the third quarter when they ~~shuffled~~ narrowed the score to 14-9. It was a great time for (Gary) Faulkner to make his first ~~reception~~ interception as it came when it looked like they might have the momentum. I'd certainly have to say that that was the turning point for us.

"We did not have a good week of practice and played like I thought we would. But the defense stopped them when we needed it. That, and the big plays, was the difference."

BY COACH HOOTIE INGRAM OF CLEMSON

"Of the four games we have played, I am the most disappointed in this one. We didn't have the enthusiasm we had last week (against Oklahoma). We lost the game because Georgia Tech had the enthusiasm, the out hustle us and the outwit us.

"We didn't take advantage ~~of~~ of the good field position when we had it. That didn't bother Georgia Tech when they got in the hole, but we seemed to hang our heads. We have got to get the desire to go out and whip somebody. If we had ~~that~~ had that desire today, with our offense showing ~~it~~ some improvement, it might have been a different story.

"Pengitore's loss should have been an excuse for us to try a little harder, but I thought Fellers did a good job in there.

"Ness had a great day. ~~He~~ He's a real tiger and we need more like him." (This was Ness' first start).
