COACH'S QUOTES:

Paul Dietzel, South Carolina: "There was tremendous effort on both sides. We had our chances and didn't cash them in. They got one big explosive break and took advantage of it. They didn't do anything we didn't expect and I'm sure we didn't do anything they didn't expect.

"We probably could have kicked the point after touchdown, but I do not believe in playing for ties. We took Troup out and put Grossman in for that play because Dobby runs that play well. Its a rollout option and he was trying to throw to Tom Amrein, the fullback. There are three possible receivers on that play, Amrein, Haggard and Woolbright.

"I thought we could throw on them, but it wasn't the best day in the world for throwing. In fact, it wasn't the best day for either team to play football.

"It was a great win for Clemson, a bitter loss for us."

Coach Hootie Ingram, Clemson: Ingram told his team right after the game that : "it was a great victory. We did not make the mistakes, we made them k make the mistakes."

Wade Hughes was presented the game ball. At the beginning of the season, the seniors drew names out of the hat for the game ball. Hughes drew South Carolina.

Ingram said he started thinking about the two-point play Monday. "And we worked on it all week. Thursday we worked for 10 straight minutes on nothing but defensixng the tw o-point play. We worked every way possible on the two point play, not only on de- fense, but on offense. This is one of the few hunches this year that came out right.

"The amazing thing to me is how we handled the wet ball. Kenny did a great job handling the football. It's unbelievable how we protected the ball. I can't say enough for the poise of our team. We're not real happy with the season, but you've got to be happy when you beat your biggest rival."

Ingram revealed that Wade Hughes got hurt on the first offensive play of the game. "He ~~was~~ was okay as long as he was in there running, but at halftime, it tightened up on him and we knew then he was lost for the game. Smiley and Heide gave a great ef- fort. Sanders had to be the tirdest player on the field because he was either running or blocking on every play. Heide really got some big yards for us, a great way for a senior to close out."

COACH'S QUOTES:

Paul Dietzel, South Carolina: "There was tremendous effort on both sides. We had our chances and didn't cash them in. They got one big explosive break and took advantage of it. They didn't do anything we didn't expect and I'm sure we didn't do anything they didn't expect.

"We probably could have kicked the point after touchdown, but I do not believe in playing for ties. We took Troup out and put Grossman in for that play because Dobby runs that play well. It's a rollout option and he was trying to throw to Tom Amrein, the fullback. There are three possible receivers on that play, Amrein, Haggard and Woolbright.

"I thought we could throw on them, but it wasn't the best day in the world for throwing. In fact, it wasn't the best day for either team to play football.

"It was a great win for Clemson, a bitter loss for us."

Coach Hootie Ingram, Clemson: Ingram told his team right after the game that: "it was a great victory. We did not make the mistakes, we made them & make the mistakes."

Wade Hughes was presented the game ball. At the beginning of the season, the seniors drew names out of the hat for the game ball. Hughes drew South Carolina.

Ingram said he started thinking about the two-point play Monday. "And we worked on it all week. Thursday we worked for 10 straight minutes on nothing but defending the two-point play. We worked every way possible on the two point play, not only on defense, but on offense. This is one of the few hunches this year that came out right."

"The amazing thing to me is how we handled the wet ball. Kenny did a great job handling the football. It's unbelievable how we protected the ball. I can't say enough for the poise of our team. We're not real happy with the season, but you've got to be happy when you beat your biggest rival."

Ingram revealed that Wade Hughes got hurt on the first offensive play of the game. "He ~~was~~ was okay as long as he was in there running, but at halftime, it tightened up on him and we knew then he was lost for the game. Smiley and Heide gave a great effort. Sanders had to be the tiredest player on the field because he was either running or blocking on every play. Heide really got some big yards for us, a great way for a senior to close out."
