Lou Holtz, N.C. State: "In the second half, I thought we played very, very well. We started putting it all together. Our kicking game was good, although a little

erratic. Our offense did what it had to do and our defense played very, very well. Clemson is a good offensive team. I thought all of our four backs ran well. The open week helped us regroup and get things done that we wanted to do. The people at Anderson College helped us tremendously. This trip was fouled up from the beginning, and the Anderson folks gave us a place to relax and meet before the game. This really helped the attitude of the boys. I think we have improved a great deal over the last two weeks. We didn't throw as much as we might have but there will be times we will have to throw a lot in the future.

WHY SHAW PLAYED MORE THAN SUCKEY: ? I felt Shaw could do the things we wanted to do. He had a very fine week of practice. I don't know if he will be our starter next week or not. Charley Young had a great day. He got in a lot of hard nosed practice last week. He did not work at all in our two-a-day drills in pre-season work because of a pulled hamstring and he is just now starting to hit his form.

Yes, we probably were conservative, not by design, but we feel that we have a very strong running game. Playing Clemson down here is awful tough. They're quite enthusiastic and it's hard to hear the cadences."

Game balls went to: Howard Bradburn, Joe Grasso, and Kirby Shimp. This was State's 8th consecutive conference win and it was the lowest point total that State has held an opponent in 14 games, since blanking Duke 17-0 in 1972. It was the third 100-yard rushing game for Burden, and the first time that State has had two backs to go over a hundred yards in one game, since Holtz took over the coaching reins.

Coach Parker said that corner back Marion Reeves was out for the season with a knee injury and would be operated on either Sunday or Monday. This is the fourth player and third regular Clemson has lost this year. Jimmy Williamson and defensive tackle Tim Blackwelder were both lost in The Citadel game and Ricky Brown (defensive back) was lost in the Georgia Tech game. Williamson, Brown and Reeves were all starters.
