Coaches' Quotes

Coach Red Parker of Clemson

I thought we could move the ball on them, and we did. We played conservative in the second half with a 10-point lead, and that's probably the reason we didn't move the ball quite as well because they were looking for the run more.

I thought our defense played a great second half. They had two key interceptions and we kept a boy in bounds there at the last which helped out.

That ~~xxx~~ last drive of ours (before the fumble) was about as pretty as you would want to see. We're not a power oriented offense, but that's what we went to on the last drive.

But we worked a lot this week on that pass to Smiley Sanders. We hadn't run it this year (Sanders had one reception for minus 3 yards going into today's game) and with their secondary coverage, we thought it would be open. We hit one for a touchdown and another long gain set up another.

But this is a team victory. They deserve all the credit and they worked awfully hard for it. Six weeks ago, most people didn't give us a chance against North Carolina--but this was just a flat out team win.

Coach Bill Dooley of Carolina

I congratulate the Clemson team. They certainly played well and deserved to win the football game.

Pengitore did an outstanding job. He's very difficult to defend. And the big fellow Cunningham hurt us with his catches. Clemson hurt us too on passes to players coming out of the backfield.

I had planned to play both Vidnovic and Paschall. But Vidnovic seemed to have a hot hand and I decided to stay with him. He did a good job. This, however, doesn't mean in the slightest that I do not have complete confidence in Paschall. He has played very well for us this season.

Our defense came back to do a ~~gxxx~~ better job in the second half, but it was just too late. We had given them too much in the first half. It's awfully hard to overcome a 30-point half by the opposition. It's a mystery to me why we don't play better on defense. I simply don't know the reason why.

This has been a very disappointing season. It's hard to believe that we are 0-4 in the conference. But we can still keep it from being disastrous if we come back and play the last two like we are capable of playing. We've just got to get up off the floor.
