Wake Forest--Coach Al Groh

"I thought they played like a class football team. Obviously I felt this before the game and I feel it now. They are an extremely well coached football team. They played the way they're supposed to. When a football team plays like that I appreciate their efforts.

"One of the last things I told one of our coaches coming into the game was I was concerned whether we would ever be able to stop them. I guess I was correct in that prediction.

"There has been a few personnel losses during the course of the year. ~~xxxx~~ The three players that we put on the All-ACC nomination list in the beginning of the season did not even play today. Certainly that would have given us a little ~~xx~~ bit more strength and a bit more experience. All three of those guys were replaced by freshmen.

"It was our job to stop them, not their job to stop themselves. I thought they were more than gracious."

Clemson--Danny Ford

We're mighty, mighty proud of our total football team. Our coaches had the team well prepared, and they did an excellent job executing the game plan. We played everybody we had.

In defense of Wake Forest, and I mean this sincerely, they're on the right track in what they're trying to do. They must have brought 20 freshmen down here. And they have a lot of their skill players hurt. Al and his staff are doing the right thing. It'll just take him a little ~~xx~~ time to build. I think they did all they could do under the circumstances.

I'm glad we jumped into a quick lead because I still remember last year when we went into the ~~the~~ fourth quarter leading 35-7 and the final score was 35-33. They can score from anywhere on the field. If they had scored that first time, there is no telling which way the game might have gone.

This morning, I didn't know if our team was ready to play or not. It was a mental game getting ready for us. But I was pleased with our offense. They put points on the board a lot of times today. I just wanted to control the game, because with the quarterback Wake has and the number of fine receivers they have, they have the ability to move the ball.
