NO HAIL LIKE THE 1963 GAME WITH GEORGIA

Today's attendance is 81,000. This is the largest home crowd in Clemson history, surpassing the 71,500 which saw the Clemson-Western Carolina game here two weeks ago.

This is also the largest crowd ever to see a football game in the State of South Carolina. The previous high was 74,200 which saw the Georgia-South Carolina game in Columbia last year.

The crowd today is the 3RD largest ever to see Clemson play a football game. The games topping this crowd are the 82,112 last year in Athens at the Georgia game and the 82,000 which saw the Clemson-Louisiana State game in the 1959 Sugar Bowl in New Orleans. There were 80,000 in attendance at last year's Mirage Bowl in Tokyo.

Coach Dooley's Quotes

"I'm disappointed, and our football team is disappointed that we did not win and therefore did not fulfill our goal. However, I am very proud of the way we fought back and put ourselves in the position to at least have an opportunity to win.

"We came unglued in the last part of the second quarter and the early part of the third quarter. They took the game away from us during that period.

"But the important thing was that we did regain our composure in the final quarter. We finally became aggressive there at the end."

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON: It seems like we played several different ball games out there this afternoon. Georgia won the first quarter, we won the second and the third and the fourth belonged to Georgia.

I think everybody in our dressing room is disappointed at the outcome, but there was one thing we wanted to do when we took the field today, and that was to improve. And I don't think there's any doubt that we didn't do that.

The effort was there, the intensity was there and so was the emotion. We're at the same place we were this time last year (1-1-1), and we've just got to do the same thing we did last year and that's get better every week.

We're a young team. We started six freshmen today and they have got to get the experience as well as get better each week. But I don't think we can ask anymore of our players than they did today. Those two field goals never should have been blocked, but that is something that can be corrected.

It seemed like we played five hours out there, but we feel like we gave up some big plays on defense and I'm sure Georgia feels the same way. But we took a few chances...some paid off and some didn't.
