It made it awfully thrilling for everybody, but we went to sleep in the $\frac{2}{3}$ third quarter. Of course, Clemson's an outstanding football team. They have great personnel. Obviously, they really creased and we ~~we~~ couldn't do anything on offense. It's exactly the kind of horror story that you dread when you have a great team down. But to combine everything that we work on, the last couple of minutes there, to play the kicking game and get the ball down to the three-yard line and get it downed properly, snap the ball under great pressure. ~~Obviously~~ Obviously, we sucked it up. We stopped them. Forced them to kick the ball and then knock it in the end zone. That's ~~the~~ kicking game, defense and offense. I'm very thrilled with that. I'm thrilled first half. But I think this year, we are a little different than we have been in the past."
