Georgia head coach Vince Dooley:

"I'm very proud of our team for coming into Death Valley and overcoming several setbacks to win the ballgame. I think I have to pay tribute to our offensive line and to James Jackson who came in off the bench and really gave us a spark.

"I felt that we began to take control a little bit towards the end of the game. Jackson helped us to do that by being able to get out on the corner and run the option.

"Clemson is a very fine football team as it has been for the past several years. Their offense kept us off balance and that, combined with their always-tough defense, made it a great ball game.

"It's good to win because it helps us to take another step in overcoming our opening loss to Alabama. I hope our team grew up a little bit by being able to come from behind on the road and win. It's always tough to beat Clemson, but we maintained our poise and was able to do just that.

"I also want to pay tribute to John Little who made two key interceptions. He played a great game for us as a rover, punt returner, kick off team member and an overall quarterback on defense."

Clemson head coach Danny Ford:

I think we improved over last week, and that's one thing we asked of our players. We're disappointed that they lost, but they did what we asked them to do. We asked them to give their best and they did.

It was a typical Georgia game. We couldn't punch in there a couple of times, and they made the big play on us a couple of times. On the reverse, I believe we lost containment, but that was a big play for them.

Randy Anderson continued to improve and I thought he was pretty true with his passing. A couple of times he made mistakes and it hurt us, but he showed great poise out there any number of times before an onrushing Georgia defensive line.

We're real proud of this football team for the improvement they showed. We didn't help ourselves in the fourth quarter. We gave them too much on first and second down and that made the third down call very easy.
