Virginia Head Coach George Welsh following Clemson Game:

Questioned on possible out-of-bounds catch for TD: "I didn't hear any comments on the sidelines...Coach Tony Whittlesey told me that. I don't think they're (the officials) are in position to make that call. It looked to me like they were, but Tony saw it and said he was out of bounds."

On trick play -- "I think (Ryan ) Jackson got lost on the touchdown play. I thought he say it. I think he saw it. Everybody saw it. Too bad we didn't get him tackled before he threw it. The other one, the deep reverse, they've been running that. I don't know why we didn't stop it."

"I don't know...I like to think we could have better offense in the second half, but we don't seem to be able to generate it."

"They didn't let us bet them deep. We beat them twice."

On the Majkowski interception: "I don't think he should have thrown it. That's a run or pass. He should ave run it."

On Clemson jinx lasting: "I have no idea. Just one year at a time."

"We just need a little more on offense. I wouldn't change much on offense. I don know how many yards we have...We need another touchdown."

"I'd like to have played a little better on defense. They (Clemson) didn't turn the ball over today. The other ones...the other games they were too good for us. I don't think anybody took control of thisgame. If we had gotten the ball back with two and a half minutes..I'd of liked to have had that shot."

On calling a blocked punt: "they wanted to do it. ~~You have to get to the rush to the punter~~ I think you have to rush a punter once in a while. You shouldn't rough them though."

"I think we played the best football team we played this year today. They played well and I think we did alright."

Coach Danny Ford of Clemson

We're real happy to win and real pleased with the way the game turned out. We're still struggling some and definitely are not over the hump yet. We still have a lot of fundamental football to learn.

But I think the players created some good things today. We gave Coach (Frank) Howard the game ball. He came home and talked to the team earlier this week.

As it turned out, the roughing the kicker call was the big play in the game. It enabled us to keep possession of the ball. Rodney Williams did some things I didn't know he could do. He ran (out) the clock well. We helped him and Randy Anderson both by simplyfying some things. I'm real happy for our offensive line. Some bad things have happened to them in the past (this year) and we're just happy that their blocking opened up some things for us.

The Williams pass was a key completion and the Flowers run. I'm sure some others played good. I didn't think our defense played well the first couple of time. Virginia had the ball, but then they settled down some. But I don't think we stopped Virginia offensively all day. We gave up way too many points and way too many yards. But Virginia is a good offensive team and not many people are going to stop them all of the time.
