### Duke Coach Steve Sloan

"I want to congratulate Clemson on winning the game. They made some big plays and certainly ~~deserve~~ deserved to win the game. I feel like our team played well. I'm beginning to ~~not~~ feel like I'm doing a poor job coaching because we make so many little errors. We used to not be very good and not make many errors. Now we have a pretty good team but we make a lot of errors and that's poor coaching on my part.

"We'll go back and try to work on all the mistakes we made. All our players played hard we played pretty well, made a lot of good plays, but we just made too many errors to win a big game like that. We don't fall on the ball on a kickoff, we punt the ball poorly twice, we miss an extra point, we turn the ball over about three times, we just had too many errors to beat a team with the talent Clemson has.

"I thought our players came back hard in the second half, played hard, played well. It's a real disappointing loss because I felt before the game like we had a chance to win it.

"That first drive when we drove the length of the field and fumbled the ball hurt us pretty bad. I thought our players showed a lot of fight, a lot of character, came back good after the South Carolina. If I could just help 'em out a little ~~more~~ more we'd be a lot better off."

### Clemson Coach Danny Ford

"NEEDless to say we are delighted to win the football game. We had some very big plays, some very good runs, especially by Kenny Flowers. We had very good blocking from our offensive line. We really executed well in the first half. Defensively we let them move the football, but you have to credit Coach Sloan and his staff as they had a great game plan."
