All-American Boy

When you discuss Clemson's all-time student-athletes, Mike Eppley certainly comes to mind among contemporary Clemson fans. But, Tiger fans of the late forties recall Frank Gillespie, perhaps Clemson's all-time student-athlete. Gillespie is one of just two athletes in Clemson history to letter in football, basketball and baseball (Dewey Quinn is the other), and he won the McKelvin Award as the Southern Conference's top all-around athlete in 1948. Gillespie started in all three sports. In addition to all this, Gillespie had a 3.0 GPA in electrical engineering, and was president of the Clemson student body.

Kickoff Return Draught

The contemporary jinx of Clemson football seems to be the kickoff return. In fact, no player on the Clemson football team was even born the last time Clemson returned a kickoff for a touchdown. You have to go back to the 1962 Georgia game to find the last Clemson kickoff return for a touchdown. Hal Davis turned the trick with 98-yard return for a score. But that has been it. A total of 793 straight kickoff returns, six US presidents, and five Clemson football coaches have been in power since Davis scored the TD against a Bulldog team that had not even been yet coached by Vince Dooley.

You could not go for two in those days, so don't get on Peahead Walker's (Wake Coach) case for not going for two.
