

The Tigers' 43-19 win over Troy was an "A" in Head Coach Dabo Swinney's mind, despite his offense's first-half struggles, which led to a three-point deficit at halftime.

The Tigers got the win after outscoring Troy 30-3 in the second half. Trailing 16-13 at halftime, Clemson came out and scored on three straight possessions to grab a 33-19 lead. From there, the Tigers cruised, as they amassed 347 of their 468 total yards in the second half.

Tajh Boyd, who struggled in the first 30 minutes, bounced back by passing for 199 yards and two touchdowns while completing 14-18 passes in the second half. At one point, he completed 13 straight passes. His second-half touchdowns went to tight end Dwayne Allen for 54 yards and wide receiver Jaron Brown for seven yards.

Allen's touchdown gave the Tigers a 20-16 lead. Now settled in, Boyd extended the lead to 26-16 with 0:30 left in the third quarter on his seven-yard touchdown pass to Brown.

After Troy kicked a 20-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter, Mike Bellamy put his name in the recordbook with a 75-yard touchdown on his first career carry. That was the longest run on the first carry by a Tiger in history.

Chandler Catanzaro followed with his third field goal of 45+ yards and DJ. Howard added a one-yard touchdown run to close out the scoring. Catanzaro became just the second player in school history to boot three field goals of at least 45 yards in one game.

Sammy Watkins set a record for receptions (7) and receiving yards (81) by a freshman in his first game. He scored just 26 seconds into the contest, the earliest score by a first-year player in school history.

Tajh Boyd said he never really worried about losing Saturday's game, because he knew there was enough talent on the field for his Tigers to get the job done.

Though he was not worried, no one could blame the Clemson quarterback if he was a little nervous as he called for the ball on third-and-13 from his own 39, clinging to a one-point lead over the underdog Wofford Terriers. However, Boyd showed a lot of poise in a pressure situation, as he stood tall in the pocket and delivered a perfectly-thrown ball to DeAndre Hopkins along the sideline.

Hopkins corralled the pass for 13 yards to the Wofford 48, keying an eight-play, 58-yard drive that helped clinch the Tigers' 35-27 victory in Death Valley.

Clemson needed it and every bit more after the Terriers used their unorthodox offense to push the game to the brink in a contest many thought would be an easy victory for the Tigers.

The Terriers scored on two of their first three possessions, a 27-yard touchdown run by Mitch Allen and a 66-yard scoring pass from Allen to Brenton Bersin. Wofford led most of the first half and was within one point (28-27) heading into the fourth quarter.

Clemson got those points on a 42-yard Boyd-to-Martavis Bryant pass, a 74-yard Andre Ellington touchdown run, a 38-yard touchdown pass from Boyd to Sammy Watkins, a five-yard touchdown run by Boyd, and a 17-yard touchdown pass from Boyd to Hopkins. Watkins was named ACC Rookie-of-the-Week for his efforts.

And when Clemson needed it the most, it was usually one of the veterans or more experienced players who came through. The Tigers got big plays from tight end Dwayne Allen, wide receiver Jaron Brown, defensive end Andre Branch, defensive tackle Brandon Thompson, Ellington, and Hopkins.

That's exactly what Boyd proved when he stepped up into the pocket and fired that 13-yard completion to Hopkins.

Dabo Swinney understands the kind of pressure that comes with a long winning streak. He was a part of one himself when he was a player and coach at Alabama in the 1990s.

But, do not think for a second Swinney was feeling sorry for #19 Auburn after his Tigers snapped the SEC Tigers' 17-game winning streak with a 38-24 victory in Death Valley.

The nation's longest winning streak ended thanks to a 386-yard, four-touchdown afternoon from quarterback Tajh Boyd and 155 receiving yards from freshman-sensation Sammy Watkins, who was named ACC Receiver-of-the-Week and ACC Rookie-of-the-Week for his efforts. In all, the Tigers amassed 624 yards while outscoring Auburn 31-3 from the midway part of the second quarter on.

Trailing by 14 points on two different occasions, including 21-7 following Michael Dyer's second touchdown of the game in the second quarter, Boyd got Clemson rolling with a four-yard touchdown pass to DeAndre Hopkins, a six-yard score to tight end Dwayne Allen, who tight-roped the back of the endzone, and then 65 and 19-yard touchdown passes to Watkins in the third quarter.

Auburn had no answer for Boyd, as he completed 30-42 passes on his way to earning ACC Offensive Back-of-the-Week honors.

Once Boyd found his rhythm, Clemson did not miss a step, as it scored on six of seven possessions. The Tigers' 624 yards of total offense were third-most in history and just the eighth time a Clemson team topped the 600-yard mark in a contest.

Auburn had won 14 straight games over Clemson, including last year's dramatic 27-24 overtime victory at Auburn. However, there were no dramatics in front of the sellout crowd.

Some thanks also goes to a defense that for the third straight week did not allow a touchdown in the second half. Auburn amassed just 150 yards and three points in the second half after totaling 285 yards and three touchdowns in the first half.

Senior Rennie Moore had a sack on #11 Florida State's final offensive play and #21 Clemson ran out the clock to preserve a thrilling 35-30 victory. It was the highest-ranked team Clemson defeated at home since it beat #3 Florida State in 2003.

With the game hanging in the balance and the Seminoles facing a fourth-and-nine from their own 38, Moore plowed through the line and sacked Clint Trickett, sending the nearly 81,000 fans in Death Valley into a frenzy.

Clemson improved to 4-0 for the first time since the 2007 season thanks in large part to a big-play offense that racked up 443 total yards against one of the nation's best defenses. Meanwhile, the Tiger defense held the Seminoles to 29 rushing yards and made the necessary stops to win the game when it had to the most.

The Tigers had one another's backs all afternoon. After Florida State took its only lead on a Dustin Hopkins 32-yard field goal on its first drive, the Clemson offense responded with a 24-yard Tajh Boyd to Sammy Watkins touchdown and a 7-3 lead on its first series.

After Florida State scored a touchdown to cut Clemson's lead to four points, the Tigers again responded, as Boyd found tight end Dwayne Allen open for a 12-yard touchdown and a 21-10 lead with 11:31 remaining in the first half.

Clemson stood tall following a fluke touchdown that allowed the Seminoles to pull within four points (21-17) in the third quarter.

Boyd, who finished the afternoon 22-35 for 344 yards and three touchdowns while earning ACC Offensive Back-of-the-Week honors, did make those plays. First, he led the Tigers on an 11-play, 70-yard drive that ended with an Andre Ellington one-yard touchdown. Following another Seminole score, a 30-yard Trickett to Rashad Greene pass, Boyd hit Watkins in stride for a 62-yard touchdown that gave the Tigers a 35-23 lead with 13:06 left in the game.

That touchdown pass followed a key third-down conversion in which Boyd connected with Allen on a 12-yard strike on third-and-10 from the Clemson 20 to keep the drive alive.

The Clemson Tigers sent a message to the ACC and the rest of the college football world in Blacksburg, VA. That message...this is not the same ole' Tigers. Using a stifling defense and getting its customary big play or two from its revamped offense, #13 Clemson stunned #10 Virginia Tech by a score of 23-3 in front of 66,233 fans at Lane Stadium.

And what the 2011 Tigers accomplished had never been done in the history of the ACC. Thanks to their 20-point victory over Virginia Tech, the Tigers became the first ACC team to beat three-straight AP-ranked opponents in consecutive games during one season.

The Tigers changed Clemson by beating a ranked Virginia Tech team on its field while playing the same style Virginia Tech Head Coach Frank Beamer made famous...playing tough, physical, and simply outmuscling their opponent. The Hokies were held to 258 total yards, including only 133 on the ground.

Though the Tigers rushed for only 119 yards, 61 came in the fourth quarter when they took control of the game and ran time off the clock. Clemson used the running game to finish off the Hokies when freshman Mike Bellamy took a handoff and raced 31 yards for the game's final score.

Allen, who had four catches for a game-high 75 yards, added to that special night in the third quarter when, on the Tigers' first drive, he caught a 32-yard touchdown pass from Virginia-native Tajh Boyd, giving Clemson a 17-3 lead at the time. It was a big play in the sense that it sucked all the momentum out of Lane Stadium and put the pressure on a Virginia Tech offense that failed to show any consistency against the Tiger defense.

Clemson finished the game with 20 unanswered points after the Hokies tied the score 3-3 on Cody Journell's 24-yard field goal with 4:35 to play in the first half. Along with Branch's record-tying performance, Jonathan Willard added eight tackles and was named ACC Linebacker-of-the-Week.

After that, Boyd led Clemson on a nine-play, 48-yard scoring drive, capped by a one-yard Andre Ellington touchdown scamper. After the defense made a stop on Virginia Tech's first possession of the second half, Allen caught his 32-yard touchdown pass from Boyd.

And with that, the message was sent to every other team in the ACC.

Even though #8 Clemson earned a 36-14 victory over Boston College in front of a Homecoming crowd, the atmosphere around Death Valley appeared as if the Tigers had lost. That came with good reason, because Clemson lost its starting quarterback, at least for most of the second half.

Tajh Boyd went down with a hip injury on Clemson's first drive of the third quarter. Boyd, who passed for 283 yards, added 37 yards on the ground and was responsible for two touchdowns before leaving with an injury. He was taken to the locker room, where X-rays revealed there was no serious damage. Boyd later went to the hospital for an MRI for confirmation, and it too came back negative.

Cole Stoudt led the Tigers on two more scoring drives after Boston College cut the lead to 26-14 on a 24-yard touchdown pass from Chase Rettig to Bobby Swigert with 5:09 left in the third quarter.

Stoudt led a 13-play, 50-yard drive that ended with a 47-yard Chandler Catanzaro field goal that bounced off and over the crossbar with 39 seconds remaining in the third quarter. It was Catanzaro's fifth field goal of the game. The sophomore was named ACC Specialist-of-the-Week for his efforts.

On the scoring drive, Stoudt completed a nine-yard pass on third down to fellow first-year freshman Sammy Watkins and an eight-yard pass to Adam Humphries, another freshman, to set up Catanzaro's field goal. Watkins, who was named ACC Rookie-of-the-Week, had seven catches for a game-high 152 yards.

The rest of the Tigers followed his lead after that. The defense shut down the Eagles from there, limiting them to 258 total yards, while running back Andre Ellington put the game away with a 35-yard touchdown run on fourth-and-one. Ellington's score gave Clemson its 36-14 lead with 11:24 to play in the game.

Boyd had already thrown a three-yard touchdown pass to Jaron Brown and ran 14 yards for another score in giving the Tigers a 17-0 lead in the first quarter.

Even though they trailed by 18 points with 11:56 remaining in the third quarter at Maryland, the #8-ranked Clemson Tigers never thought they were going to lose. And when freshman cornerback Bashaud Breeland intercepted a pass by C.J. Brown and returned it 29 yards to the Maryland 15, they believed it even more.

Breeland's first career interception set up a 13-yard touchdown pass from Tajh Boyd to Sammy Watkins to pull the Tigers within 11 points, and from that point on, Clemson outscored the Terrapins 39-10 in rallying to a 56-45 win.

But Clemson kept fighting after trailing 14-3, as Andre Ellington scored on a three-yard run and DeAndre Hopkins caught a six-yard touchdown from Boyd to keep Clemson within striking distance at 28-17. The Tigers kept believing, even when Maryland took the opening drive of the third quarter and scored a touchdown thanks to a 22-yard pass from Brown to tight end Matt Furstenburg.

The Tigers also stuck with their running game, as they rushed for 306 yards on 42 carries, with Ellington leading the way with 212 yards and two touchdowns, including a 44-yard touchdown run with 3:55 left to seal the win. Ellington was named ACC Offensive Back-of-the-Week for his efforts.

Watkins, who was named ACC Receiver-of-the-Week and ACC Rookie-of-the-Week, turned in a night to remember. He broke C.J. Spiller's school record for all-purpose yards in a game with 345 while also scoring three touchdowns, including an 89-yard kickoff return for a touchdown that gave Clemson a 49-45 lead after Maryland had reclaimed the lead midway through the fourth quarter.

It was only fitting that on the day Clemson honored its 1981 National Championship team, the 2011 Clemson Tigers tied one of its records. The #8 Tigers tied a school record for points in a quarter with 35 in the third, while they also put on a 1981 workman-like effort by forcing six turnovers in a 59-38 win over North Carolina.

The 1981 team scored 35 points in the second quarter of its 82-24 victory over Wake Forest on Halloween of that year. The 2011 Tigers also joined the 1981 team as well as the 1948 and 2000 teams as the only squads to start a season with eight straight wins.

The Tigers were special in front of 79,000 fans and a national television audience. Clemson amassed 450 yards of offense, with 375 of those coming from quarterback Tajh Boyd, who tied a school-record with five touchdown passes while also tying another record with six touchdowns thanks to a one-yard rushing score.

Boyd, who passed for 367 yards, put the first touchdown of the third quarter up with a one-yard sneak. Following one of North Carolina's six turnovers, the Tigers scored their second touchdown of the quarter on a 12-yard Boyd-to-Brandon Ford pass.

The Tigers scored their fourth touchdown of the third quarter moments later on a nine-yard touchdown pass from Boyd to tight end Dwayne Allen. Less than two minutes later, defensive end Kourtnei Brown picked up a fumble that was caused by Rashard Hall and rumbled 26 yards for the record-tying points and a 59-24 lead with 14 seconds left to play in the third quarter.

Brown became the first defensive lineman since 1954 to score two touchdowns in one game. He had a 20-yard interception return in the second quarter that gave Clemson a 24-10 advantage.

Head Coach Dabo Swinney made no excuses following #6 Clemson's 31-17 loss to Georgia Tech in Atlanta.

Clemson's focus after the game was the missed opportunities it had during the course of the game, especially in the second half when it cut the Georgia Tech lead to 14 points at the start of the fourth quarter.

After entering the game with a +9 turnover margin on the season, Clemson lost the turnover battle 4-2, with two of those turnovers coming on promising drives in which the Tigers were in Georgia Tech territory.

Trailing 24-3 at halftime, the Tigers appeared poised for another comeback when Boyd connected with Sammy Watkins for a 48-yard touchdown on the opening possession of the third quarter. However, Georgia Tech quickly answered when Tevin Washington took a quarterback draw 56 yards on third-and-six, setting up an 11-yard touchdown scamper by David Sims for a 31-10 Yellow Jacket lead.

The Yellow Jackets rushed for 383 yards on 67 carries, as Washington led the way with 176 yards.

Even with that, Clemson narrowed the Yellow Jackets' margin to 14 points again on the first play of the fourth quarter when Brandon Thomas recovered a Boyd fumble in the endzone. That completed a 97-yard drive after Washington fumbled at the Clemson one yard line.

The Tigers amassed 226 yards of total offense alone in the third quarter, largely due to Boyd, who completed 9-12 passes for 179 yards.

The Tigers had two more chances to draw closer after the Thomas touchdown, but a promising drive bogged down at the Georgia Tech 47.

Later in the fourth quarter, after Hall returned an interception to the Georgia Tech nine yard line, the Tigers committed a costly turnover. Boyd and Watkins, who had a game-high nine receptions for 153 yards, failed to communicate on a fade in the endzone and Jemea Thomas intercepted the pass to thwart a Tiger scoring opportunity.

Chandler Catanzaro booted a 43-yard field goal as time expired to complete one of the best comebacks in Clemson history. It also clinched the ACC Atlantic Division Championship at the same time.

Catanzaro's game-winner lifted #9 Clemson to a 31-28 victory over Wake Forest, who led by 14 points following Brandon Pendergrass' 33-yard touchdown run with 5:32 left in the third quarter. It was the third time this season the Tigers rallied from 14 or more points to earn a win. Clemson had overcome a 14-point deficit to win just nine times in 115 previous seasons.

The Tigers were definitely that. Thanks to a 50-yard punt return for a score by Mike Campanaro and two turnovers that led to Pendergrass scores, Wake Forest built a 28-14 lead in the third quarter.

Tajh Boyd led the comeback by answering Pendergrass' second third-quarter score with a seven-yard touchdown pass to Brandon Ford, who had three receptions for 51 yards. That touchdown capped a 10-play, 68-yard drive that saw Boyd connect on 5-5 passes for 58 yards thanks in large part to the blocking of center Dalton Freeman, who was named ACC Offensive Lineman-of-the-Week.

It was a nice bounce-back for Boyd, whose interception on the previous drive set up Pendergrass' 33-yard score. Boyd finished the game 27-43 passing for 343 yards and two touchdowns.

Clemson's clutch plays consisted of a third-down pass to DeAndre Hopkins, then an eight-yard pass to Jaron Brown and a 20-yard pass to Ford, which set the Tigers up at the Wake Forest 12. Two plays later, Boyd connected with Brown for 10 yards over the middle for the equalizing score with 5:27 left in the game.

Clemson did all of this after Sammy Watkins, who became just the fourth Tiger to eclipse 1,000 receiving yards in a season, left the game with a shoulder injury in the third quarter.

With the score tied, it became the defense's turn to step up. After a third quarter in which it allowed Pendergrass to reach 100 yards in the game after his two touchdown runs, it held the Demon Deacons to only five yards of offense on their last two drives.

N.C. State scored 27 points in the second quarter and never looked back in beating #7 Clemson 37-13 at Carter-Finley Stadium in Raleigh, NC on November 19. The win ended Clemson's seven-game winning streak in the series, which dated to 2004.

Clemson was led by Tajh Boyd's 238 passing yards and two Chandler Catanzaro field goals of 24 and 32 yards. DeAndre Hopkins added five receptions for a game-high 124 yards for the Tigers, who mustered only 337 total yards in the contest.

Mike Bellamy's two-yard touchdown run with 1:22 left to play capped the game's scoring. His score was set up by a 50-yard pass from Cole Stoudt to Brandon Ford on fourth-and-18.

Mike Glennon had 253 passing yards and threw three touchdowns to lead N.C. State, who did not commit a turnover. N.C. State was aided in the second quarter by Tiger mistakes. Clemson turned the ball over four times and was penalized five times for 42 yards.

Following the Wolfpack's first touchdown, a Boyd fumble and Wolfpack return to the Clemson six set up a seven-yard touchdown pass from Glennon to Jay Smith to give N.C. State a 14-3 lead in the second quarter. On the next possession, Bellamy fumbled at his own 18, which led to a 21-yard field goal by Niklas Sade.

After the Wolfpack forced a three-and-out, T.J. Graham returned a punt 34 yards to the Clemson 11. Two plays later, Tony Creecy scampered four yards off the right side to give the Wolfpack a 24-3 lead with 4:58 remaining in the second quarter.

N.C. State opened up the second half with a third Sade field goal. On its next drive, Glennon connected with Tobais Palmer for a 43-yard touchdown. Palmer broke several tackles after hauling in the screen pass to give the Wolfpack a 31-point point lead.

Clemson had scored first on a 21-yard field goal from Catanzaro in the first quarter. However, N.C. State reeled off 30 consecutive points before Catanzaro's second field goal, this time from 32 yards, ended the streak in the third quarter.

Andre Ellington rushed for 66 yards and Tajh Boyd completed a nine-yard touchdown pass to Dwayne Allen, but it was not enough, as #13 South Carolina topped #17 Clemson 34-13 at Williams-Brice Stadium in Columbia.

The Gamecocks, who reached the 10-win mark for just the second time in school history, were led by quarterback Connor Shaw. The sophomore rushed for 107 yards and threw three touchdown passes, as South Carolina beat the Tigers for the third time in a row.

Shaw threw touchdown passes of 49, two, and 18 yards to Bruce Ellington, Rory Anderson, and Alshon Jeffery, respectively. He also finished 14-20 passing for 210 yards and no interceptions.

Trailing 10-0 in the second quarter, the Tigers charged back when Boyd capped a 12-play, 61-yard drive with his nine-yard touchdown pass to Allen with 11:32 left in the second quarter.

Clemson then tied the score after South Carolina failed to pick up a first down on its next possession. Gamecock punter Joey Scribner-Howard dropped the snap and Drew Traylor blocked the punt. Several plays later, Chandler Catanzaro kicked a 32-yard field goal to tie the score (10-10).

Shaw answered the Clemson rally with a nine-play, 60-yard drive. He capped it with a 15-yard touchdown run to give the Gamecocks a 17-10 lead with 1:55 remaining in the second quarter.

The Gamecocks started the second half like the first. They shut down the Clemson offense on its first possession, then Shaw led a five-play, 66-yard drive, capped by a two-yard touchdown pass to Anderson. That gave South Carolina a 24-10 lead with 9:52 left in the third quarter.

Catanzaro added a 40-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter, but the Gamecocks kicked another field goal and Shaw threw his third touchdown pass of the game following a Clemson turnover to put the game away.

South Carolina sacked Boyd five times and held the Tigers to 153 yards. Boyd finished with only 83 yards on 11-29 passing.

The Gamecocks finished with 420 total yards, including 210 yards on 53 carries.

Two weeks of frustration were cured in just over one quarter at Bank of America Stadium as #21 Clemson scored 28 points in the first 17 minutes of the second half to defeat #3 Virginia Tech by a score of 38-10 to win its first ACC Championship since 1991.

"We're a championship program and tonight we added to a great tradition," said Head Coach Dabo Swinney. "I think this was our 18th (conference title) overall and 14th ACC Championship.

"It's our first time to win 10 games in 21 years. It's our first time to win an ACC Championship in 20 years and our first time to go to the Orange Bowl in 30 years. It's great to be a Tiger and we're 10-3. We're excited about representing the ACC in the Orange Bowl."

With the game tied 10-10 at halftime, Clemson forced the Hokies to a three-and-out on their first possession of

the third quarter and then used a 10-play, 87-yard drive to regain the lead for good. Tajh Boyd, who was named game MVP, threw his second of three touchdown passes with an eight-yard pass to tight end Dwayne Allen to cap the drive.

Allen and Boyd hooked up for a 24-yard touchdown in the first quarter as well. Boyd finished the game 20-29 passing for 240 yards and three touchdowns against no interceptions. In the process, he set Clemson single-season records for total yards and passing yards.

It was a nice comeback for Boyd, who had struggled in the previous two games.

"Somewhere you've got to dig deep inside yourself and work through things," admitted Boyd. "I feel like that's one of the things that happened, and it happened for a reason, to let you know that all you can really do is believe in yourself and your family, which is my teammates. I'm just proud to be here."

Boyd was even more proud on the Tigers' next possession, as he connected with Sammy Watkins in stride for a 53-yard touchdown pass that gave Clemson a 24-10 advantage.

After another three-and-out forced by the Clemson defense, which held ACC Player-of-the-Year David Wil-

son to only 32 yards on 11 carries in the game, the Tigers scored again, this time on a 29-yard touchdown run by Andre Ellington. The Clemson running back finished with 125 yards on 20 carries.

Clemson finished the game with 217 rushing yards, while the Hokies were limited to 56 yards on the ground.

"I'm proud of Andre Ellington," stated Swinney. "He was big-time player tonight on a big stage. He was one of the big keys in the game for us, because we were able to run the football."

Boyd added his fourth touchdown of the night to cap the night's scoring with a one-yard plunge with 13:04 left in the game. From that point on, the celebration was on.

"Ladies and gentlemen, I would like to announce that I will be taking my Clemson talents to South Beach, baby," laughed Swinney in the press conference after the game. "I have wanted to say that. We're excited. It's a great time. We are excited about going to Miami.

"We played like a champion."

Geno Smith passed for 407 yards and six touchdowns as #22 West Virginia trounced #14 Clemson 70-33 in the Discover Orange Bowl at Miami Gardens, FL on January 4, 2012.

The play-of-the-game came in the second quarter with Clemson poised to regain the lead when Doug Rigg stripped the ball out of Andre Ellington's hands as he started to fall at the Mountaineers' one-yard line. Darwin Cook recovered the ball and raced 99 yards for a game-changing touchdown. It was the longest defensive touchdown in Orange Bowl history, which highlighted a 35-point second quarter for the Mountaineers.

The Tigers never recovered after Cook's touchdown. Although the Tigers moved within 28-20, West Virginia went on a six-play, 64-yard drive that was capped by Smith's seven-yard touchdown run that gave the Mountaineers a 35-20 lead with 2:29 left in the first half.

Trying to get some kind of momentum, Tajh Boyd, who threw for 250 yards, forced a pass on Clemson's next possession that was intercepted by Pat Miller. Three plays later, Smith connected with Tavon Austin for a three-yard touchdown pass and a 42-20 lead with 1:13 left in the first half.

On Clemson's next offensive play, Boyd scrambled for eight yards, but Bruce Irvin stripped him of the ball before he went down and the Mountaineers recovered at the Tiger 18.

For the third time, West Virginia took advantage of a Clemson miscue, as Shawne Alston recorded his second touchdown of the half when he rushed one yard for a touchdown with four seconds left. The Mountaineers led 49-20 at halftime.

The onslaught continued in the second half, as the Mountaineers scored on their first two possessions. Smith completed touchdown passes of six yards and 37 yards to Stedman Bailey and Austin, respectively, to build their lead to 63-20.

West Virginia's 35 unanswered points came to an end late in the third quarter when Boyd hit DeAndre Hopkins, who had a team-high 10 catches for 107 yards, on a 28-yard touchdown pass.

Clemson started the night with a bang when Ellington, who rushed for 116 yards on only 10 carries, sprinted 68 yards for the game's first score. After West Virginia tied the score with a four-yard touchdown run by Alston, the Tigers answered with Boyd's 27-yard touchdown pass to Watkins.

Austin tied the score 14-14 on West Virginia's next possession when he hauled in an eight-yard pass from Smith, who set an Orange Bowl and BCS bowl game record with six touchdown passes. The Miami-area native also set an Orange Bowl record with 407 passing yards on 32-43 passing and was named game MVP.

Clemson provided the final score of the night on a four-yard touchdown run by Roderick McDowell late in the fourth quarter.
