Orange Bowl Stadium

This game ~~is~~ carried by CBS-TV, 187 Stations coast to coast and CBS radio, with 200 stations throughout the United States. The temperature at 1:30 was announced as 75° and the wind at 5 miles per hour from the south.

Clemson's co-captains are quarterback Charlie Bussey and halfback Joel Wells. Tri-captains for Colorado are tackle Dick Stapp, end Jerry Leahy and end Wally Merz. Colorado won the toss and will receive from the west.

COLORADO VS. CLEMSON

STATEMENTS FROM THE COACHES

COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON: Frank Howard's threatened resignation during intermission inspired Clemson's comeback in the second half.

"I told them I was going to resign if they didn't play better in the second half. I told them I didn't want to be associated with any team that played like they did in the first half."

When Howard met Dal Ward at midfield, Ward asked him what was the matter with his team, Frank replied "I just don't know."

Later Howard explained that the Tigers just refused to block in the first half, but in the second half they got down to business. He had words of praise for John Bayuk, Colorado's big fullback, and said he was as good as any fullback that Clemson had faced all year, included Joe Brodsky of Florida and Don Bosseler of Miami.

Summing it up, Howard said "I'm glad we gave them a good game down here, after all we had to take."

COLORADO'S DAL WARD

A happy Dallas Ward begged off from talking to reporters until he had crossed to midfield and received congratulations from loser Frank Howard. Ward said, "I want to talk to Frank before I say anything." Immediately, the Colorado players hoisted their head coach to their shoulders and carried him to Howard, chanting, "Let's go see Howard."

Ward said, "There wasn't any big break in the game. But, I never was so tickled in my life as when they tried the onside kick the second time and gave up the ball at midfield. Of course, the first one they recovered hurt us, but the second one, with them leading, was our best break."

"Our kids thought they had the game at halftime and they let down in the ~~second~~ second half."

"We played as good in the first half as we did against Oklahoma, in fact, as good as we have all year. In the second half, we made as many mistakes as we have all year."

When asked to smile at a portable TV camera, Ward said, "You want me to smile at him . . . I feel like smiling right now."
