

Coaches' Statements

COACH FRANK HOWARD:

Naturally, I am disappointed at the outcome of the game. We worked awfully hard for this one, but like I said after the Presbyterian game last week end, we haven't been tested yet. We were today. Carolina's line out-charged ours most of the game and that was the difference in the outcome. I thought we were flat in nearly every phase of the game. But I still think that we have the makings of a good club and that we'll come along. The boys know now what it means to be knocked around. They were hit with pretty good authority today. Our sophomores need experience and I think we'll improve with each game. I'll say again--we'll end up with a pretty good squad.

COACH JIM TATUM:

"We rushed the passer well and also covered passes well. I thought this was especially effective since Clemson was supposed to have a fine passing attack."

I thought our defense was the best it has been since I've been at Carolina. It evened surpassed the play we received against Maryland last year."

Dave Reed came into his own today. I thought he played the best game of his career, especially on that pass play to Payne in the fourth period."

The difference between last week's game and this game I think was in the weather. It was 30 degrees colder this week and it seemed to be a tonic to our linemen."

I was especially pleased with the play of fullback Ed Lipski. He seemed to gain confidence everytime he carried the ball. We're expecting great things from him in the future."
