STATEMENT BY COACH BOB KING OF FURMAN

I thought we ran the ball well, we simply ran out of halfbacks. ~~But~~ Bradley Fowler might have made a difference. He's a good blocker, good pass receiver. I anticipated a pass play for every running play. I wonder how we did on that.

Campbell, I thought did a fine job running the ball. We might have moved the ratio of ~~back~~ passing-running down after seeing how well we did on the ground.

If we had picked up our players in the fourth quarter and told them to forget they were tired, we might have been in there to the final gun.

I thought we had a good chance to win when it was 21-14.

I called the onside kick and we felt that we had a chance to win the ball game at that point. We had halfway considered using the onside kick to open up the ball game.

I'd like to see the score come down and start all over again. Yest, we came over here to win this ~~is~~ one. We looked as good as our defensive play against Alabama in the first quarter.

Our ends and backs seemed a little nervous dropping those passes.

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

Coach Frank Howard didn't talk too much about the Furman game, ~~but~~ but about how much he was looking forward to the opening of spring practice March 24.

"I have never been happier to see a season end than this one, and I'm really looking forward to spring training," Howard said.

"This year I think our trouble was that we lacked football ability." Howard recalled the number of players he lost off last year's Bluebonnet Bowl team. "This year our defense wasn't what I wanted it to be, our offense did not click like I wanted it to and our record wasn't what I wanted it to be."

"I think the changes we made during the week helped out. I moved Pavila ck, Matthews and Osborne off the first to the second and they looked real good with the second bunch today, but they hadn't been playing any ball much with the first bunch."

"But I'm looking forward to a good spring practice and come next September I look for us to be on the pawl again."

Howard he said he thought Furman had a good little team and that they showed a lot of guts going for that two-point play after scoring its first touchdown.
