STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

When Coach Frank Howard of Clemson and Coach Bob King of Furman met at midfield, Howard said he thought it was a good game and the only comment King made, "You're just a little too tough for us."

Howard thought his team had played better ball in other games this year than today against Furman, "but I'll always take those victories."

~~But~~ "People today judge a team on its won-loss record," Howard said, "but that's not the way it ~~is~~ should be. The opposition has a lot to do with it. Furman has a good team, but really I don't think they're in the same league as us. I believe ~~is~~ if they'd played the same schedule we have, their won-loss record would be a lot different."

Howard continued. "I didn't think we look good today though. I tell you our boys got a little bit mad from all the nasty mail we received over here this week. Now, these letters and all were signed by Furman players, but I don't think they had anything to do with it, or that Coach King had any part of it. Furman probably got some just like we did, but I know none of my boys did anything like that and I certainly didn't do anything like that.

"But that kind of stuff should be stopped. Some people just don't ~~have~~ have much sense, or they either don't use it. I don't think it's good for the game.

"I don't think we played good football. It was kinda crude. But I think my boys want to play. They gave a good effort today, but they weren't as sharp as I like to see. I think we've given a good effort most of this year. They have ~~as~~ just as much desire as anyone.

"But I just think we have a g better team than Furman. It's not better coaching or anything like that. We just got better players."

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

When Coach Frank Howard of Clemson and Coach Bob King of Furman met at midfield, Howard said he thought it was a good game and the only comment King made, "You're just a little too tough for us."

Howard thought his team had played better ball in other games this year than today against Furman, "but I'll always take those victories."

~~It is~~ "People today judge a team on its won-loss record," Howard said, "but that's not the way it ~~must~~ should be. The opposition has a lot to do with it. Furman has a good team, but really I don't think they're in the same league as us. I believe ~~if~~ if they'd played the same schedule we have, their won-loss record would be a lot different."

Howard continued. "I didn't think we look good today though. I tell you our boys got a little bit mad from all the nasty mail we received over here this week. Now, these letters and all were signed by Furman players, but I don't think they had anything to do with it, or that Coach King had any part of it. Furman probably got some just like we did, but I know none of my boys did anything like that and I certainly didn't do anything like that.

"But that kind of stuff should be stopped. Some people just don't ~~have~~ have much sense, or they either don't use it. I don't think it's good for the game.

"I don't think we played good football. It was kinda crude. But I think my boys want to play. They gave a good effort today, but they weren't as sharp as I like to see. I think we've given a good effort most of this year. They have ~~sex~~ just as much desire as anyone.

"But I just think we have a g better team than Furman. It's not better coaching or anything like that. We just got better players."
