STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

"They don't get no tougher than ~~that~~ that," voiced Coach Howard after the game.

Howard spent about the first five minutes of his post-game interview praising the work that Coach Earle Edwards has done with his State team.

"Earle has done a fine job. Before the season I didn't think we'd have any trouble with them (State) but I think we're fortunate to win. 'Midnight' (Howard's nickname for Edwards) has a fundamentally sound club."

About his own club Howard said he told them at halftime to "save the game for us."

"Looks like we tried to give it (the game) to them and they didn't take it and when they tried to give it to us the last time, we took it."

"Bunton played a mighty fine game for us, and overall, I thought we played a little better this week than last."

Howard commented that no matter what changes he made in his lineup from week to week, the second team always plays the best. Last week Parker, Lam and Crain were in the first backfield and Anderson, Skiffey, Taylor and Howard were in the second. ~~Parker and Crain were in the first backfield and Anderson, Skiffey, Taylor and Howard were in the second.~~ Anderson's bunch looked the best. This week we put Anderson on the first team and Parker comes through. I can't say why this happens, but it always does.

Earle Edwards quotes following State-Clemson game
Sept. 29, 1962

"Naturally we are disappointed in losing. Clemson played well, and I thought we did also.

"We played well on defense, but didn't show any offensive punch. No points all day. That was the ball game.

Asked if he thought the fumbles and mistakes of this game, like against Carolina hurt: "Not many teams play without fumbles. We stopped ourselves when we got something going. Clemson stopped us on several occasions, but we stopped ourselves too much. That last fumble wasn't a good one.

"We had some great penalties, wonderful penalties. They amounted to more ground than we could make.

"We didn't do anything with our scoring opportunities and that was the ball game.

"I'm not critical of anybody, but we ~~are~~ just didn't play well enough to win. Koszarsky's runs didn't count.

"Our defense looked good, especially on their running. For a while it looked like they couldn't do anything until they passed.

"I'm proud of our effort, real pleased with the way they go about it.

"Rossi was rushed several times and couldn't get his passes off. That is a credit to Clemson.

"We substituted more this week, I believe. It was hotter today. The first boys at each position were kind of tired, so we put in the new boys.

"We still have to get some blocking. Koszarsky and Scarpati are good runners if we can ~~get them~~ give them some running room.
