STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD

This has been a most frustrating year for me.

I don't think I've seen a team get more tough breaks than we did. Those five interceptions and that fumble on the goal line is the whole story. We just didn't get any breaks—I guess you call 'em breaks.

We played all right ~~except~~ (on defense) and if I played 'em tomorrow, I'd do the same over again and I'd go into the game thinking we could win. I think we were more ready to play today than at anytime this year.

Parker's injury is still hurting us. When he's not passing, things are kinda glum. I don't know when he's going to be ready. He got hurt the Tuesday before the Wake Forest game and since then hasn't done hardly any passing.

I really don't think we played too badly. We had some opportunities, but didn't cash in on them. But ~~looks~~ ^{looks} like nothing is going good for us this year.

Someone asked Howard about those piling on and Howard said: "Looks like they called ~~that~~ piling on pretty close on us, but they don't call it on the other fella."

Howard asked the corps of sportswriters around him: "Boys, How can I win one?" This has really been a frustrating year so far."

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD

This has been a most frustrating year for me.

I don't think I've seen a team get more tough breaks than we did. Those five interceptions and that fumble on the goal line is the whole story. We just didn't get any breaks--I guess you call 'em breaks.

We played all right ~~average~~ (on defense) and if I played 'em tomorrow, I'd do the same over again and I'd go into the game thinking we could win. I think we were more ready to play today than at anytime this year.

Parker's injury is still hurting us. When he's not passing, things are kinda glum. I don't know when he's going to be ready. He got hurt the Tuesday before the Wake Forest game and since then hasn't done hardly any passing.

I really don't think we played too badly. We had some opportunities, but didn't cash in on them. But ~~looks~~ ^{looks} like nothing is going good for us this year.

Someone asked Howard about those piling on and Howard said: "Looks like they called ~~himself~~ piling on pretty close on us, but they don't call it on the other fella."

Howard asked the corps of sportswriters around him: "Boys, How can I win one? This has really been a frustrating year so far."

COACH BILL MURRAY OF DUKE

We are of course, real happy to win this one here in Death Valley. We had a number of bad breaks in the first half, but they were evened up in the second half.

We were fired up to play this game. We feel that we were in the best spiritual shape of the season. The reasons for this are three. First ~~it~~ it was a conference game and this always gets our boys up. Second, Clemson ~~is~~ was so anxious to beat us that our boys played that much harder. Third, ~~Frank~~ Frank threw that challenge at us early in the season and that made our boys want to show him that we could beat him.

(When asked about running to the left) It was ~~no~~ no particular concentration or plan of ours before the ballgame. It was simply a matter of the circumstances of the Clemson defense. It was not by design. We simply ran in areas ~~where~~ in which ~~defensive~~ defensive weaknesses were shown.

Yes we worked hard on pass defense the last two weeks. And today the interceptions won the ballgame for us along with our running.

Weidman and Putrell might well have played today, but we felt that it would be better to hold them out rather than take ~~any~~ a chance on getting them injured further.
