STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

I am very happy to beat Nugent's best team. His team played well, they are a good group of boys and I think they're well-coached. I don't have any special message for Nugent--I'm just happy to win.

Howard was asked about going for the touchdown instead of the field goal just prior to a five yard penalty, afterwhich Rogers was sent in and kicked the three-points which won the game.

Howard said that Crain being in motion might have won the game for Clemson. Frankly, I didn't much know what to do. He said he asked the quarterback if they wanted Rogers and they waved him off.

Asked about why Clemson didn't go for the two-point play after the second touchdown, Howard said that in 1959 everytime Clemson scored, they went for the two point play. Everytime Maryland scored, they went for the one. Maryland defeated Clemson that year, 28-25.

Howard said that this victory was not quite as sweet as some he had had in the past. He said that Maryland hates Clemson worse than Clemson hates Maryland.

Howard was asked if there was any reason why Clemson wasn't moving the ball too well in the first quarter. He said, "Yes, Maryland."

Just on first thought, without benefit of seeing any game movies, Howard singled out Jack Aaron, Ted Bunton, Lou Fogle, Don Chuy and Elmo Lam as playing outstanding on defense.

COACH NUGENT'S POST-GAME QUOTES:

I guess it was Frank's turn to win the close one.

They moved the football in the final five minutes...they had it when they needed it.

Congratulations to Frank and the Clemson team.

WHEN ASKED WHAT THE KEY PLAY WAS IN THE BALL GAME COACH NUGENT SAID:

I guess it was the pass interceptions...they have been the key to this year's season.
