EARLE EDWARDS, NORTH CAROLINA STATE:

"Glad to get it. It was a big one for both teams.

"They knocked us around. We came down here with the idea that we would not butt our heads about a solid wall. That was our game plan. They had us backed up badly throughout most of the game. Maybe we did everything wrong, except losing.

"It was the game we thought it would be. Tough.

"We had to make the substitution. Joe Scarpati was hurt. We had to get him out of there. We had no other choice. (On 3rd and one delay penalty at end).

"I told Jim not to throw late, but I'm not going to argue how it was done. We won over a good football team and are happy about it.

"Perhaps we should have run on their second unit more, but we just never got good field position. Everybody - on both sides - played hard and well. Happy we got the best of it.

"Barlow, Sullivan, DeAngelis, Montgomery, Williams, Wilder - just everybody played well. I think when we see the pictures we'll see that. They all worked hard.

WE HAD TO MAKE A GOOD GOAL-LINE STAND. THAT'S WHAT HELPED US. I GUESS THAT WAS THE BIG THING FOR US, ASIDE FROM THE TOUCHDOWN PASS.

"They dealt on us a lot. They made the mistake of trying to go outside. They could not take out Montgomery, and the rest of our ends and our corner men. They hurt us inside.

"I don't know where he (Barlow) came from. But I was glad to see him there.

"Clemson isn't a slouch ball club. They have played the nation's top team in Tech and Oklahoma. It was obvious from their play. It was a big game for both of us.

"Clemson got the measurements, and we didn't. That makes a big difference in a game."

COACH FRANK HOWARD

About the only bright thing I saw was our punting was a lot better. We just aren't blocking well.

I don't know what makes our backs fall down (referring to the Clemson back who fell down and left state receiver wide open for touchdown pass) but we did the same thing last week and Tech got a touchdown out of it. I don't think they would have scored if that back hadn't fell down.

At one time in the second quarter I thought we were gonna beat the devil out of them but we didn't throw the key punch.

That fumble in the third quarter down inside the 20 hurt, but when we intercepted right close to the end, that should have given us enough lift to win, but it didn't. We needed to win this one bad.

Other than us falling down on that pass, they didn't do much against us.

EARLE EDWARDS, NORTH CAROLINA STATE:

"Glad to get it. It was a big one for both teams.

"Perhaps we should have run on their second unit more, but we just never got good field position. Everybody -- on both sides -- played hard and well. Happy we got the best of it.

"Barlow, Sullivan, DeAngelis, Montgomery, Williams, Wilder -- just everybody played well. I think when we see the pictures we'll see that. They all worked hard.
