COACH HICKEY QUOTES:

"Clemson has a fine team. That wasn't a surprise. We knew they did. One of their big plays was a long pass on their drive. That wasn't a surprise, either, for we figured they would throw it. They simply made a fine play of it and it kept them marching for the big score.

"But the pass wasn't the back breaker. We had plenty of time to stop them after that. We didn't—and it meant the game.

"We had two scoring opportunities after our first touchdown and we didn't make the most of them. Clemson has a good, tough defense.

"I thought we played a miserable first half. We came back much stronger after intermission. I feel the big reason for this was calling a better game and throwing at the opportune time. It was a matter of getting the offense moving, rather than making a great deal of changes defensively.

"Their fullbacks run hard and exerted a good effort.

"The real disappointing thing was that we couldn't get the lead and make it stick. When we scored in the second half, we should have stayed ahead. Clemson made their winning margin the hard way—with a long drive.

"I don't think we have any real serious injuries—other than Center Glenn Ogburn. He wrenched his knees and it will be a matter of time to see how he reacts.

"It was a disappointing day for all of us—coaches and players. The first thing we have to do is forget this one and start getting ready for the next two (Miami and Duke)."

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD

"We're still making a lot of mistakes but when you make 'em and still win, you don't have any complaints.

"Actually, we oughta had three touchdowns in the first half. That pass was dropped (by Poole) when he was behind the defensive man; a penalty brought one back and a fumble stopped us again.

"North Carolina has a good team and Jim ~~as~~ has done a good job with his boys."

Howard praised the running of his fullbacks and said that Pat Crain was the best player in the Atlantic ~~East~~ Coast Conference.

"Crain and Swift both really ripped them up the middle, but ole Pat was running like a bull, bowling over everybody who was ~~breaking~~ in his way ~~on~~ blocking and he played that defense to the hilt. <sup>T</sup> Actually, I was afraid to put him out on defense last year, but not now."

Howard <sup>f</sup>also had flowing words for Ted Bunton, Clemson center. "Bunton ~~is~~ was all over the field...from sideline to sideline. He has a lot of territory to cover back there and he does his job well.

"We're mighty happy to win. We didn't do anything different, and I don't think they did. We did a poor job tackling of in the third period. Bunt we hitched our belts up and came back."
