

COACHES QUOTES FOLLOWING N.C. STATE 9-0 VICTORY OVER CLEMSON

EARLE EDWARDS: AND FRANK HOWARD MIDFIELD CONVERSATION:

Howard - "Midnight, you've got a lot better team than I thought."

Edwards - "Maybe we are."

Howard - "You've got a fine team. I don't see how, after losing all those boys."

Edwards - "Frank, you'll have to ask the boys about that. You still have a good team there too."

Howard - "We'll have to wait and see."

EDWARDS COMMENTS TO PRESS:

Things went well. We executed our plays well. They bang you around, but we challenged our kids to do the same thing.

The pitchouts worked well, and I didn't think that wingback reverse would be that effective. It worked better than we expected.

I think Clemson's quarterback (parker) made them a little more dangerous last year. But these boys are new and they are likely to get better.

"When you ~~talk~~ talk about centers in the ACC, you've got to include Lou DeAngelis. I don't think they come any better around here. We've played two good ones the last two weeks, but neither got the better of Lou. Also don't forget Pete Falzarano at fullback. He's a pretty good one."

Our linemen did the job on their ends.

Our North Carolina victory was totally unexpected by you people. This one grew more important as a result of that win.

I don't think we've ever played any better against Clemson.

Asked about if anything special was done to ~~stop~~ stop Crain:

"All we did was install a fear into them."

Clemson is dangerous with Crain, their sweeps and the long bomb. Our boys were pretty effective on all three, I thought.

Asked that now you've won first ~~two~~ ^{on defense} two you are expected to win the rest of them: "On that, you are liable to be as wrong as you have been so far."

We are, of course, pleased about it. I think some of the momentum from last year has carried over to this club. You can also gain momentum with failure.

We ran on them more than we expected. Never done that in past.

POST GAME STATEMENT OF COACH FRANK HOWARD)

We just got beat today. State has no soft sisters in that lineup.

Frankly, I think they have a better team than last year. When I was walked off the field down at Clemson last year, I didn't ta think the best team won. But it was a different story today.

My line still isn't as ~~far~~ good as its gotta be. We have 10 boys on the ~~first~~ first two lines who have never played before this year. But I got the best boys in there, and they're mine. I can't put any of them on waivers.

State is going to give all of them (remaining schedule) trouble. We didn't get outsmarted or anything like that today, we just got outhit. It was pretty gruelling out there, and they out gruelled us. I don't think that because they got such a good start on us had anything to do with the game. They were able to start like they did because they are in such good (Physical) shape.

They hit us hard. They are well coached and I'd say they surprised us. I expected to win, but it's not the first time I expected to win and didn't.

One of the sportswriters asked Howard if he thought State was underestimated before the season opened. Howard said: "It wasn't me who said that. Now you can say that State was underestimated, but when you write it, say the sportswriters underestimated Satato. It wasn't me or any of the other conference coaches."
