COACHES STATEMENTS

VINCE DOOLEY, Georgia: "First of all, it is good to win, and I'm really happy to win this one because of it being counted in the conference standings.

It should mean a lot to us, and I think it will help us. I thought we were ready to play the game, and our defense made some great plays. This, I thought, was very important in the game----our ~~keeping~~ have the good field position that we had during the game. ~~Our~~ Our quarterbacks are showing ~~improvement~~ improvement, and this was probably our best all-around game. Wayne Swinford did another great job as did so many others. Barry Wilson's interceptions was a terrific play. He made a great catch and then kept his balance to go on in and score. I'm still worried about some of the mistakes we made, and I'm sure there is good reason for me to worry after hearing the FSU-Kentucky score. But I'm real ~~pr~~ proud ~~amaz~~ of our effort today.

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD

Howard was probably in the most disgusted mood seen in a long time after the loss to Georgia. After talking to his players, he met the press.

We didn't play near as well today as we did last Saturday against Georgia Tech. But today Georgia was aggressive and they wanted to play. We couldn't have broken an egg.

It looks like we got kinda satisfied after playing pretty good against Tech. But, Gentlemen, we're plan to work next week and I mean work!!

We were standing around most of the afternoon doing nothing. Everytime we tried to pass, there was more of them back there (after our passer) than us. When you don't block, you can't do nothing. When you stand up and get hit and don't respond, you can't expect anything right to happen.

Georgia played a good game and we didn't. I just hate for a team of mine to play like this, but you can expect it every once and awhile. You don't t when it's coming, you just hope you don't have 'em too often.
