POST GAME COACHES QUOTES -- SOUTH CAROLINA-CLEMSON, NOVEMBER 21, 1963

MARVIN BASS, SOUTH CAROLINA: "The winter will be a lot shorter for us. It's great to wind up with three wins in a row. This renews the faith I have in this group of boys. They have always been a good bunch of football players. Our schedule was against us early in the season when we played some exceptionally strong and nationally ranked teams. However, we aren't in a position to dictate who we will play and we had to take them as they came. This experience helped us today and I feel the defense won the game for us, because if we hadn't stopped Clemson down on our goal line before we started our touchdown drive, one touchdown wouldn't have done us any good. We stopped them twice inside the one yard line and that's great defense. Pete DiVenere played his greatest game. I don't know how many tackles he made but he was all over the field. His parents were down from Connecticut and I'm glad Pete wound up his career in such great fashion.

I thought our entire team did a fine job. Clemson moved the ball well on the ground with Crain and Davis giving us lots of trouble, but when they got close we stopped them.

We had poor field position most of the first half and couldn't throw but Senter and Wilburn both told us they could get open and when Rogers had to go to the long pass he had J. R. out there. Wilburn said "I know we were going on in to score" when he caught that 45 yarder.

Rogers did a great job on his touchdown run but that's the kind of quarterback he is, a scrambler. This will mean a great deal to him next year. We're looking forward to having him back. We didn't consider putting Reeves in on the final drive because he reinjured his ankle on the fourth down fumble when we were stopped short and the doctors said not to use him. Rogers made us glad we didn't with a great drive of over 90 yards. We decided against the field goal on the play we fumbled on because we came up here to win, not to tie. We thought about taking the win if we won the toss but the boys told us they wanted the ball. They said they could move it and we played a hunch. It didn't look like we made a wise decision for about 57 minutes but Rogers came through for us

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

Boys, this was one we weren't supposed to lose. I don't think any group of boys wanted to win one any more than ours wanted this one.

I don't think they have as good a football team as we do, but when you miss two first downs by about this far (and he held two fingers about an inch apart), it's rough. This is really a game of inches and it was certainly proved today.

I thought Crain scored the second time he ran with the ball when we were down on the goal line, maybe he didn't. We'll have to look at the film. But whether he did, or whether he didn't, they (the officials) didn't say he scored, so there's nothing we can do about it.

On that touchdown run (of Rogers), we had him twice, but turned him loose. I think we played just about as good as we could.

(Howard's press conference was one of the shortest of the year. It was apparent that he felt his boys should have won, and had little to say).
