

(When Howard and Dodd met at midfiad, Dodd said, "I wanted this 150th victory, Frank, and when you get to 149, and if you are playing us, I'll try and let you get it.")

"I don't think we're that bad and I don't believe Tech is that good," Howard said. "We're doing the right stuff, I think, but it's just not working. I thought our offense moved the ball well, but everytime we got a drive going, we'd stop ourselves with a fumble, or something."

Howard wasn't satisfied with the defensive play of his line. "We just sit back and waited for them to come at us. We weren't aggressive. I'm really disappointed at the way we played. I thought we'd do better."

On the option play, Howard said, "That option play at an end without too much experience can be pretty rough" Howard was referring to the fact that both of Clemson's defensive ends are sophomores. "I just can't believe they beat us that bad," Howard said dejectedly.
