CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 24-6 home record, lost all three games at No. 12 Wake Forest last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 8.0 runs per game and hitting .293 with a .509 slugging percentage, .396 on-base percentage and 52 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.51 ERA, .240 opponents' batting average and 2.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .968.

BOSTON COLLEGE OVERVIEW

- Boston College, which has a 12-9 road record and is averaging 6.5 runs per game, is led by first-year Head Coach Todd Interdonato.
- The Eagles lost 4-3 at home to Georgetown on Tuesday. They are hitting .267 and have a 6.45 ERA and .980 fielding percentage.
- Kyle Wolff is hitting .314 with seven homers and 42 RBIs, Cameron Leary has 13 homers and 22 steals and Michael Farinelli has two saves.

QUICK HITS

- On Saturday at 11:30 a.m., Clemson will honor its senior players on Senior Day.
- Clemson has only allowed 24 steals in 37 attempts.
- Ten Tigers have had a double-digit on-base streak in 2024.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation by D1Baseball this week, its 14th weekly ranking in a row in 2024.
- Clemson has also been ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 14 weeks in 2024.

- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 22 weeks in a row.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Clemson's No. 2 ranking earlier this season was its best since Collegiate Baseball ranked the Tigers No. 2 in the nation on May 28, 2018.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,899 fans per home date (27), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 14).
- Entering 2024, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance for 30 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 17-10 ACC mark, ahead of Florida State (15-11) and NC State (15-11).
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in second place behind North Carolina (20-7).

20 ACC REGULAR-SEASON WINS

- Clemson has a 17-10 ACC regular-season record in 2024, good for first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings.
- Clemson had a 20-10 ACC regular-season record in 2023, its sixth season of totaling 20+ ACC regular-season wins, tied for third in the ACC.
- North Carolina (8) has the most ACC regular seasons of 20+ wins, while Florida State (7) is second and Miami (Fla.) (6) is tied for third.
- No ACC team has totaled 20+ ACC regular-season wins in back-to-back seasons during 30-game league schedules since 2017, 18 (North Carolina).
- In 2021, ACC teams were scheduled to play 36 ACC regular-season games due to COVID-19, therefore figures above exclude that season.
- A total of 28 times has a head coach had an opportunity to total 20 ACC regular-season wins in his first year at an ACC school since 1992.
- The figures in the note above exclude head coaches who started at an ACC school in 2020 (shortened season).
- Only two have totaled 20+ ACC regular-season wins in his first year as a head coach at a school, Jack Leggett (1994) and Erik Bakich (2023).
- Jack Leggett (1994,95) is the only head coach to total 20+ ACC regular-season wins in each of his first two seasons at a school.

- The ACC regular-season schedule expanded to 24 games starting in the 1992 season.
- The ACC regular-season schedule expanded to 30 games starting in the 2005 season.

SERIES SUCCESS

- Clemson won its first eight weekend series in 2024 and had a streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- The streak ended when NC State won two of three games at Clemson from April 12-14.
- Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- In the 14 three-game series, Clemson was 14-0 in series finales. Clemson had a streak of 19 straight wins in weekend series finales as well.
- Clemson has won three of its last four weekend series, therefore it has won 18 of its last 20 regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and won its first four in 2024. It had a streak of 11 ACC series wins in a row.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were three-game sweeps and seven were won 2-1.
- Clemson has won three of its last four ACC series, therefore it has won 14 of its last 16 ACC regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- Clemson is 35-13 in its last 16 ACC series.
- Clemson went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tournament. Therefore, Clemson is 39-12 in its last 51 games against ACC teams.
- Clemson had a streak of eight ACC road series wins in a row dating to 2023 until it was snapped at No. 12 Wake Forest from May 10-12.
- Clemson is 19-7 in its last 26 ACC road games.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

NOTES

COMEBACK TIGERS

- Clemson has 21 come-from-behind wins among its 37 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 25 of its 50 games and is 21-4 in those 25 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 16 times and is 10-6 in those 16 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning 12 times and has won five of those 12 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the ninth inning 12 times and has won three of those 12 games.
- Clemson is 30-2 when scoring seven or more runs in 2024.
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 win on Feb. 24.
- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.
- Clemson trailed Louisville 11-4 in the fifth inning and 11-8 in the ninth inning on the road before rallying for a 12-11 win on April 26.
- It marked the first time in Tiger history that an opponent scored 10 runs in an inning (4th) and Clemson still won the game.
- Clemson trailed Charlotte 12-10 on the road entering the ninth inning and 12-11 with two outs in the ninth inning before winning 14-12.

COMEBACK WINS AGAINST SEMINOLES

- Tiger fans experienced one of the most memorable series in program history when Clemson swept No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23,24.
- Clemson rallied from deficits of four runs (1st inning), seven runs (9th inning) and nine runs (6th inning) in the games, respectively.
- The Tigers ended the games on runs of 15-1, 8-0 and 12-1, respectively, against Florida State, who entered the series with a 19-0 record.
- Therefore in those three games, Florida State combined for leads of 23-3, but Clemson finished the games on a combined run of 35-2.
- In the first game, Florida State scored four runs in the first inning, but the Tigers scored in five of the seven innings to win 15-5.
- In the second game, Florida State led 8-1 entering the ninth inning, but 11 of the 12 Tigers reached base and Clemson won 9-8.
- Jacob Hinderleider, who hit a three-run homer earlier in the ninth, hit a walkoff single after Blake Wright hit a game-tying grand slam.
- In the third game, Florida State led 11-2 until the Tigers scored five runs in the sixth and six runs in the seventh to take the lead.
- Wright hit another grand slam in the seventh inning to give Clemson the lead for good.
- Clemson hit .346 with 38 runs, four doubles, seven homers, 23 walks, five hit-by-pitches and a .485 on-base percentage in the series.
- Wright totaled three homers and 12 RBIs in the series.
- It marked Clemson's first series sweep of the Seminoles since 2015 and its first home sweep of the Seminoles since 2010.

LONG BALL TIGERS

- Clemson has hit 92 home runs and has a .509 slugging percentage, its highest figure since 2002 (.533).
- The Tigers are averaging 1.8 homers per game, the second-highest mark in school history (1962, 2.0).
- Clemson has totaled 100+ homers in a season three times, 1991 (111), 2002 (112) and 2022 (100).
- Clemson has hit a home run in 40 of the 50 games and each of the last nine games.
- The Tigers have hit multiple homers in 29 (24-5 record) of the 50 games.

- The long balls are a big reason Clemson is averaging 8.0 runs per game, its highest figure since 2010 (8.6).
- Clemson hit a season-high six home runs in its 11-1 win over Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- Blake Wright leads the team with 19 homers, while Jimmy Obertop is second with 16 homers.

GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 23,24.
- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 30-for-81 (.370) with six grand slams, four doubles and 89 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

GRADUATES

- Five Tiger players received diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Littlejohn Coliseum on May 9.
- B.J. Bailey, Tristan Bissetta, Ty Olenchuk, Will Taylor and Blake Wright earned their bachelor's degrees.
- Bissetta and Taylor earned their degrees in only three years.
- Andrew Ciufu, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Alden Mathes and Jimmy Obertop earned their certificates.

CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .325 with 15 doubles, two triples, eight homers, 46 RBIs, 44 runs and a .398 on-base percentage in 48 games.
- He has 23 multiple-hit games, including seven three-hit games, and 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 29, as he was 9-for-20 (.450) with two homers, two doubles and six RBIs in four road games.
- In his career, he is hitting .360 with 31 doubles, five triples, 15 homers, 93 RBIs and 116 runs in 107 games.
- In his career, he has a .548 slugging percentage, .434 on-base percentage and 24 steals.

CIUFO STEADY AT SHORTSTOP

- Junior Andrew Ciuffo was the starting shortstop in the first half of 2024 until he suffered a season-ending injury at Notre Dame on April 6.
- He hit .280 with two homers, a triple, two doubles, 16 RBIs, 19 runs, a .378 on-base percentage and five steals in 27 games in 2024.
- He had five sacrifice bunts.
- He had a .955 fielding percentage, committing only five errors in 110 chances.
- He committed five errors in the first six games, but did not commit an error in his last 21 games of the season.
- He did not commit an error in 47 chances in 11 ACC regular-season games.
- Clemson had a 24-3 record in his 27 starts.
- He was 4-for-6 with nine RBIs with the bases loaded.
- He hit a walkoff solo homer in the 12th inning in Clemson's 5-4 win over No. 12 South Carolina at Segra Park in Columbia, S.C. on March 2.
- He also made several highlight-reel plays on defense against the Gamecocks to save runs late in the game on March 2.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina, as he was 4-for-10 at the plate.

DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 5-3 with a 4.24 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 35 strikeouts in 57.1 innings pitched over 15 appearances (eight starts).
- He has allowed only 12 walks.
- He has 88 groundball outs compared to 41 flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing five hits, no earned runs and no walks with five strikeouts to earn the win at Notre Dame on April 6.
- He pitched a complete game against NC State on April 13, the first by a Tiger since 2021.
- In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just seven hits, one earned run and no walks with five strikeouts in throwing 105 pitches (80 strikes).
- In his career, he is 8-5 with a 4.87 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 80 strikeouts in 112.2 innings pitched over 34 appearances.

GORDON CLOSING

- Junior righthander Austin Gordon started the season as a weekend starter, but has since become the pre-dominant closer in 2024.
- He is 0-2 with eight saves, a 5.28 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 38 strikeouts in 29.0 innings pitched over 16 appearances.
- In his 11 relief outings, he has a 2.51 ERA, .176 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against six walks in 14.1 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 3-6 with 10 saves, a 4.85 ERA and .246 opponents' batting average in 141.0 innings pitched over 49 appearances.
- He has 145 strikeouts against 46 walks in his career, good for a 3.15 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

HINDERLEIDER MAKING A MOVE

- Jacob Hinderleider transferred to Clemson for his final season in 2024 and has made a successful transition.
- Not only is he one of the team's top hitters, he was the primary starter at first base early in 2024 after never having played there before.
- He has since taken over starting duties at shortstop since early April with the season-ending injury to Andrew Ciuffo.
- He is hitting .319 with 12 homers, a triple, 14 doubles, 53 RBIs, 33 runs, a .396 on-base percentage and nine steals in 49 games.
- He has made 48 starts, 23 at shortstop, 21 at first base and four at third base.
- He is hitting .400 with two outs.
- He has 20 multiple-hit games and 17 multiple-RBI games.
- He is hitting .351 with eight homers, nine doubles, 33 RBIs, 21 runs and a .413 on-base percentage in 27 ACC regular-season games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April and a 14-game hitting streak from April to May.
- He had 10 assists as the shortstop without committing an error at Louisville on April 27. It was the most assists by a Tiger since 2007.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, double and six RBIs in Clemson's 17-7 win at Louisville in seven innings on April 28.

HUGHES OFFERING RELIEF

- Sixth-year senior and graduate righthander Rob Hughes has had some impactful moments on the mound in 2024.
- He is 1-1 with three saves, a 9.53 ERA and 12 strikeouts in 11.1 innings pitched over 13 appearances.
- He suffered an injury in 2022 that forced him to miss the entire season.
- In his three active seasons at Clemson, he is 2-2 with five saves, a 4.50 ERA and .237 opponents' batting average in 52.0 innings pitched.
- In his two seasons (2023,24) since returning from injury, he is 1-2 with five saves and a 4.71 ERA in 28.2 innings pitched over 25 outings.

JARRELL JOLTING LINEUP

- Sophomore catcher Jacob Jarrell has emerged as one of the team's best power hitters with his .612 slugging percentage in only 67 at-bats.
- He is hitting .328 with five homers, four doubles, 18 RBIs, 18 runs and a .420 on-base percentage in 20 games.
- He has made 18 starts, 15 at catcher and three as the designated hitter.
- He is hitting .351 with runners on base and .385 with runners in scoring position.
- He has 12 two-out RBIs among his 18 total RBIs in 2024.

- The Tiger freshman record for strikeouts in a season is 99, shared by Rusty Gerhardt (1969) and Ryan Mottl (1997).
- He is 3-1 with a 2.87 ERA, .190 opponents' batting average and 64 strikeouts against 15 walks in 47.0 innings pitched (eight ACC starts).
- He has a 2.96 ERA, .211 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against seven walks in 24.1 innings pitched over four road starts.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing two hits, no runs and one walk with 10 strikeouts to earn the win at Miami (Fla.) on March 30.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run and no walks with nine strikeouts at Notre Dame on April 7.
- He did not allow a hit until the seventh inning and earned ACC Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his efforts at Notre Dame.

- He pitched 5.2 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with eight strikeouts against Pittsburgh in the second game of a doubleheader on April 20.
- He did not allow a Panther baserunner to advance past second base.

MAHLSTEDT EFFECTIVE FROM THE SIDE

- Junior righty Lucas Mahlstedt transferred to Clemson from Wofford and has been one of the team's top relievers with his sidearm delivery.
- He is 4-1 with one save, a 4.57 ERA, .282 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against nine walks in 43.1 innings pitched.
- He leads the team in appearances (22), all out of the bullpen.
- He has not allowed a steal.

MARCHAL RANKING AMONG BEST

- Senior righthander Matthew Marchal, a graduate transfer from Wofford, has been among the team's best and most consistent pitchers in 2024.

- With the midseason injury to Tristan Smith, he made a start on the mound three straight weekends.
- He is 5-0 with a 4.32 ERA, .258 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against 13 walks in 33.1 innings pitched over 14 appearances.
- He is holding opponents to .150 with two outs.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in relief to earn the win at Louisville on April 26, a game the Tigers trailed 11-4.

MATHES PUTTING UP NUMBERS

- Senior outfielder Alden Mathes transferred in from Richmond and has made an immediate impact.
- He has become the predominant leadoff batter during the second half of the season.
- He is hitting .328 with eight homers, a triple, 11 doubles, 27 RBIs, 51 runs and a .457 on-base percentage in 49 games in 2024.
- He is riding a 30-game on-base streak.
- He has a team-high seven outfield assists.
- He hit a grand slam in his first plate appearance as a Tiger against Xavier on Feb. 16.
- He hit two homers against Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- He had a 10-game hitting streak from April to May.
- He was 8-for-16 (.500) with three doubles, two RBIs, four runs and a steal in Clemson's series win at Louisville from April 26-28.
- He has made several highlight-reel catches in the outfield, including one in each of Clemson's close wins at No. 3 Duke in March.

NAWROCKI HITTING HARD

- He is 2-0 with a 4.14 ERA, .234 opponents' batting average and 51 strikeouts against 25 walks in 37.0 innings pitched over nine starts.
- Clemson has an 8-1 record in his nine starts.
- He allowed only three hits, one run and one walk with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched against No. 12 South Carolina on March 2.
- He allowed just four hits, one earned run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.

- Senior infielder Blake Wright is having his best season as a Tiger.

- The co-captain has split time as the starter at third base (35 starts) and second base (15 starts) in 2024.
- He is hitting .327 with 19 homers, two triples, eight doubles, 66 RBIs, 58 runs and a .654 slugging percentage in 50 games.
- He is hitting .364 with runners on base and .397 with runners in scoring position.
- He has a team-high 27 two-out RBIs.
- He has 18 multiple-hit games, including seven three-hit games and two four-hit games.
- He has 16 multiple-RBI games.
