CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 5-0 home record and 2-1 neutral record, defeated Winthrop 20-7 in seven innings at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on Tuesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 9.1 runs per game and hitting .312 with a .460 slugging percentage, .441 on-base percentage and 14 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 5.56 ERA, .230 opponents' batting average and 2.76 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .982.

SOUTH CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- South Carolina has an 8-0 home record, a 1-0 road record, is averaging 8.7 runs per game and is led by first-year Head Coach Paul Mainieri.
- The Gamecocks beat Gardner-Webb 14-4 in seven innings on Tuesday. They are hitting .304 and have a 2.25 ERA and .980 fielding percentage.
- Ethan Petry is hitting .452, while former Tigers Nathan Hall (.433) and Nolan Nawrocki (.350) are both hitting at least .350.

STORIED RIVALRY

- South Carolina is Clemson's most-common opponent, as the two have played 335 times dating to 1899.
- The two have met at least once every year since 1945, with the exception of 1984. Therefore, the two have met each of the last 40 years.
- The season matchups went to a three-game, weekend-series format in 2010 after the two teams played four midweek games for decades.
- South Carolina leads the series 8-7 in regular-season, neutral-site contests since 2010.
- Clemson leads the series 57-29 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium (opened in 1970).
- South Carolina leads the series 6-5 at Fluor Field.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 7 in the nation by Baseball America and Perfect Game this week.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 18 weeks in 2024. It has a current streak of 21 top-10 rankings in a row.
- Clemson has a current 29-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least poll dating to the 2023 season.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.
- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference preseason poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.

- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciuffo, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .462 with two doubles, 13 RBIs, 11 runs, eight walks, four hit-by-pitches and a .615 on-base percentage in eight games.
- He is the only Tiger to start all eight games.
- He has hit safely and has at least one RBI in all eight games as a Tiger.
- He has only struck out one time.
- He is hitting .643 with runners on base and .727 with runners in scoring position.

MAHLSTEDT SOLID ON & OFF THE FIELD

- Senior and sidearm righthander Lucas Mahlstedt has been one of the team's best relievers since transferring to Clemson for the 2024 season.
- He is 0-0 with two saves, an 0.00 ERA, .125 opponents' batting average and six strikeouts against no walks in 4.2 innings pitched in 2025.
- In two years as a Tiger, he is 4-1 with a 4.34 ERA and .261 opponents' batting average in 58.0 innings pitched over 30 relief outings.
- He also has 45 strikeouts against 15 walks and three saves in his two years at Clemson.
- On Feb. 26, he became a Weaver-James-Corrigan-Swofford Postgraduate Scholarship Award recipient.
- He was one of only 35 ACC student-athletes and three ACC baseball players to receive the 2025 award.
- He became the first Tiger baseball player to receive the accolade.
