Quick Hitters

- Indiana has opened its season with a 10-3 record with its only losses coming to FIU and No. 12 Texas Tech. The Hoosiers went 4-0 in the Puerto Vallarta Challenge in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico.
- Indiana returns seven of its nine starters in the field from 2024 with a plethora of new talent coming in, including eight new freshmen and two transfer from Power-4 schools.
- Melina Wilkison, a redshirt junior outfielder from Greensburg, Ind. joins the Hoosiers after spending three seasons at Ohio State. Wilkison was a two-year starter for the Buckeyes, including being an NFCA All-Region and All-Big Ten performer in 2023. She missed almost all of 2024 due to injury.
- The eight freshmen make up the No. 28 ranked recruiting class on Extra Innings Softball for the class of 2024.
- Brianna Copeland, Taylor Minnick and Avery Parker were all named to the Big Ten's preseason Players to Watch List.

Last Time Out

- Last weekend, Indiana split its four-game set in the Jeannine McHaney Memorial Classic in Lubbock, Texas. The Hoosiers defeated UIC, 7-4, and beat UTEP in a 12-2 run-rule over five innings.
- After trailing 1-0 early against UIC, Indiana exploded for six unanswered runs to go up 6-1 after five innings. Avery Parker and Taylor Minnick both hit a solo home run in that stretch.
- Indiana's bats were on fire against UIC, with three home runs in five at bats between Alex Cooper, Melina Wilkison, and Avery Parker in the third inning to build a commanding 4-0 lead off the bat.
- Both of Indiana's losses last weekend came to host school and No. 12 Texas Tech. Tech won 8-0 over five innings in game one and won 7-2 in the second battle. Indiana led 1-0 through 4.5 innings in the second game before Texas Tech put up seven runs in the bottom of the fifth.

Scouting the Opponents

- Indiana's opponents this weekend of Clemson, East Carolina and Lafayette have all varied results through the first three weekends of play.
- Clemson comes into their second consecutive home weekend with a 10-6 record. The Tigers own notable victories over Ohio State and Georgia along with close losses to Ole Miss, Auburn and Kentucky.
- A year ago, Clemson posted a 35-19 mark in 2024 and reached the NCAA Tuscaloosa Regional before being eliminated.
- East Carolina is 9-5 to open the 2025 season and has won four of its last five games. The Pirates took two wins over No. 22 Boston in the Pirate Clash at ECU. Two of their losses were to Virginia (4-2) and South Carolina (1-0) who both received votes in the top 25 polls.
- Lafayette is 0-8 to open the season after a 5-37 campaign a year ago.

Series History Notes

- Indiana and Clemson played last year in the NFCA Leadoff Classic when Clemson won 3-2 in Clearwater, Fla. The game against East Carolina will be the first time the programs have played since 2012. Indiana and Lafayette will meet for the first time ever on Friday.

RETURNING TALENT

- After a majorly successful 2024 season that saw Indiana go 40-20, the Hoosiers return the majority of the team's key pieces to have another strong year.
- Indiana brings back seven starters from a season ago, including two NFCA All-Americans, four NFCA All-Region performers and four all-Big Ten standouts.
- Brianna Copeland and Taylor Minnick were both NFCA All-Americans in 2023. Both were All-Region performers along with Aly VanBrandt and Avery Parker.
- In addition to Minnick and VanBrandt, Sarah Stone and Alex Cooper each had All-Big Ten recognition in 2024, as well.
- Of its starting spots, Indiana will only need to replace starters at one of the infield spots on the left side and in the outfield.

BUILDING ON SUCCESS

- Year-by-year, Shonda Stanton and the Indiana Softball program continue to raise the bar for the program's standards and expectations
- In back-to-back years in 2023 and 2024, the Hoosiers have reached the NCAA Tournament, won 40-plus games and made a Big Ten Tournament Final appearance.
- The back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances had not been done since the 1985-1986 seasons and the team is seeking three-straight appearances for the first time in program history.

REVAMPED PITCHING STAFF

- Indiana returns ace Brianna Copeland for her senior season and adds three new arms to the rotation in transfer Taylor Hess and freshmen Jenae Berry and Jasmine Reyes.
- Copeland had an excellent 2024 campaign with a 2.88 ERA, a 20-12 record, 174 strikeouts and held opposing batters to a .220 batting average.
- Berry has been lights out for the Hoosiers. The freshman has a 5-0 record with a 0.55 ERA while only allowing 13 hits and two earned runs while striking out 13.
- Hess comes to Bloomington after spending two seasons at Kentucky. The junior is the only lefty arm in the circle for the Hoosiers.
- For Indiana, Hess is 1-0, with a 2.92 ERA in 12.0 innings pitched across six appearances.
- Reyes is 3-1 with a 2.90 ERA in seven appearances.

FAB FRESHMEN

- Indiana has eight stout freshmen who are new to the roster this season including Hannah Haberstroh, Madalyn Strader, Jasmine Reyes, Alli Gavin, Jenae Berry, Sydney Burko, Josie Bird and Peyton Drummond.
- Three of the freshmen are from Indiana (Haberstroh, Gavin and Drummond), two of them are from West Virginia (Burko and Bird), Strader is from Texas, Berry is from Arizona and Reyes is from California.
- The recruiting class was ranked as the No. 28 recruiting overall signing class by Extra Innings Softball in the class of 2024.
- Burko (No. 20), Strader (No. 23), Drummond (No. 71) and Reyes (Top 100) were all ranked in Extra Innings Softball's class of 2024 player rankings.
- Drummond was named the 2024 New Balance/Golden Shoe Award Winner for the nation's top baserunner among all high school prospects.
- Four Hoosier Freshmen were named to Softball America's Freshmen to Watch List, which included Burko, Reyes, Strader and Berry.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- Banging the fences and stealing bases is what Coach Shonda Stanton and Indiana prides itself on.
- In 2024, the Hoosiers had the most explosive offense in the Big Ten: Runs (364), Hits (495), HR (69), RBI (325), AVG (.311), OBP

(.398), SLG (.505), OPS (.903), SB (107) and TB (804).

- With seven of nine bats in the starting lineup returning for 2025, Indiana is well-positioned to replicate its success from the 2024 season.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Indiana's roster has racked up numerous preseason accolades in the buildup to the 2025 season.
- Three Hoosiers were selected for the Big Ten's Players to Watch List including Taylor Minnick, Brianna Copeland and Avery Parker.
- Brianna Copeland (No. 51) and Taylor Minnick (No. 56) were ranked in the D1Softball's Preseason Top 100 Player Rankings.
- Brianna Copeland (No. 54), Avery Parker (No. 85) and Taylor Minnick (No. 95) were all selected to Softball America's Preseason Top 100 Player Rankings.
- A number of Hoosiers were slotted in D1 Softball's Position Rankings: Brianna Copeland (No. 2 Dual Threat Utility), Avery Parker (No. 7 Catcher), Aly VanBrandt (No. 12 Second Base), Taylor Minnick (No. 22 Outfielder).
- Brianna Copeland was named to USA Softball's Collegiate Player of the Year Top 53 Watchlist.

ROSTER BALANCE

- Indiana's roster presents a nice assortment of different numbers in its graduating classes.
- The 19-woman roster features eight freshmen, three sophomores, four juniors and four seniors.
- The team is led by four highly experienced seniors in Taylor Minnick, Brianna Copeland, Kinsey Mitchell and Sarah Stone.
- All four of the seniors have been contributing to the team's success since their freshman year in the 2022 season.
- In that mix, also includes another player who is on her fourth year of college softball but only her third season of eligibility in Melina Wilkison.
- Wilkison is a redshirt junior for the Hoosiers after playing two seasons at Ohio State (2022, 2023) and receiving a medical redshirt for 2024 after she got injured in mid-February.

52 YEARS

- Indiana Softball is celebrating 52 years as a varsity sport this season. In fall 2022, the program hosted a celebration, inviting alumni to celebrate 50 years of Indiana Softball and its storied history and bright future of the program.

STAYING WARM & AN INTERNATIONAL TRIP

- Indiana will play its first four weekends of the season in the south, including a trip outside of the United States.
- The Hoosiers opened play at FIU's Felsberg Invitational in Miami where the team went 4-1 to begin the year.
- Then, the team will go across the border as it is set to compete in the Puerto Vallarta Challenge in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. The Hoosiers will compete in Session II of the prestigious non-conference event that will include games against North Dakota State, Illinois State, Boise State and BYU (Feb. 13-16).
- In the weekend to follow, Indiana will head to Texas Tech in Lubbock, Texas, to face off in the Jeannine McHaney Memorial Classic (Feb. 21-23). Texas Tech is a consensus top-25 team this year, headline by the 2024 National Player of the Year and Stanford transfer NiJaree Canady.
- The final piece of the opening non-conference portion of the schedule features the Tiger Invitational hosted by Clemson (Feb. 28-March 2).

NEW COMPETITION

- New to the 2024-25 school year, the Big Ten Conference added four new institutions to the league, including UCLA, USC, Washington and Oregon.
- USC does not have softball, but the other three members will be part of the Big Ten for the first time this softball season.

Stanton is entering her eighth season as Indiana's head coach in 2025.

In 2024, Stanton led the program to back-to-back NCAA Regionals, 40-win seasons and Big Ten Tournament Final appearances. The Hoosiers went 40-20 on the year with a 12-11 conference mark, reached the final of the Big Ten Tournament and earned a spot in the NCAA Columbia Regional.

Indiana boasted the Big Ten's most explosive offense, leading the conference in runs (364), hits (495), home runs (69), RBI (325), batting average (.311), OBP (.398), SLG (.903), stolen bases (107) and total bases (804).

The team had four players earn NFCA All-Region honors in Taylor Minnick (First Team), Brianna Copeland (Second Team), Avery Parker (Second Team) and Aly VanBrandt (Second Team). There were also four All-Big Ten selections with Sarah Stone (First Team), Taylor Minnick (Second Team), Aly VanBrandt (Second Team & Freshman Team) and Alex Cooper (All-Defensive Team & Freshman Team).

2023 proved to be a historic year for the Indiana Softball program in Coach Stanton's sixth season. The Hoosiers posted a 44-18 record while going 18-5 in Big Ten play, 14-4 at home and 16-5 on the road. It was Indiana's first 40+ win season since 1994.

Indiana won six of their eight Big Ten series, including sweeps of No. 22 Maryland, Purdue, Ohio State, Rutgers, Michigan and Michigan State. The strong regular season earned the team a second-place finish in the Big Ten regular season standings. From March 5 to April 7, the team won 23 consecutive games, the longest win streak in program history. In the Big Ten Tournament, Indiana defeated No. 7 seed Penn State, 5-4, on a walk-off home run in the ninth inning from Sarah Stone. In the semifinals, Indiana beat No. 3 seed Minnesota, 5-3. The Hoosiers fell just short in the final to No. 1 seed Northwestern, 2-1. Indiana earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament as the No. 2 in the Knoxville Regional. It was Indiana's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2011. The Hoosiers defeated No. 3 seed Louisville twice before falling to No. 1 seed Tennessee in the regional final.

The Hoosiers collected a number of awards after their fantastic 2023 season. Taryn Kern won Big Ten Player of the Year and Big Ten Freshman of the Year. Kern and Taylor Minnick were named All-Big Ten First Team. Cora Bassett, Avery Parker and Sarah Stone were honored on the conference's Second Team. Parker, Kern and Kettleman were named to the Big Ten's All-Freshman Team. Kern, Minnick and Brianna Copeland were named NFCA First Team All-Region. Parker was named to the NFCA's Second Team while Bassett and Stone landed on the Third Team. Kern was a top-three finalist for TUCCI/NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year. She also was named a First Team All-American and Freshman Team All-American by DI Softball. The NFCA named Kern a Second Team All-American while Copeland and Minnick were recognized as Third Team All-Americans. The entire Indiana coaching staff was named the ATEC/NFCA Midwest Region Staff of the Year.

In Indiana's 2022 season, the Hoosiers went 27-22 including an 11-3 record in neutral site games. The Hoosiers also swept their series against Rutgers and Purdue and No. 23 Ohio State, 17-5, on March 25 in Columbus. Cora Bassett earned First Team All-Big Ten honors while Taylor Minnick and Heather Johnson were named to the Big Ten's All-Freshman Team. Minnick was also named to the Big Ten's Second Team and Grayson Radcliffe earned NFCA All-Region Second Team.

In the 2021 season the Hoosiers won or split nine of their 12 Big Ten series. They finished fifth in the Big Ten standings and were one game out of fourth. Gabbi Jenkins set the career record for stolen bases with 96 and Emily Goodin finished with 583 career strikeouts, rankings fourth best in program history. Jenkins and Grace Lorusung earned All-Big Ten First Team honors and Goodin and Grayson Radcliffe earned Second Team honors. Four Hoosiers (Jenkins, Goodin, Radcliffe and Bella Norton) earned NFCA All-Region honors. In the classroom the team had a 3.69 GPA, 12 Academic All-Big Ten selections and Jenkins and Radcliffe earned CoSIDA First Team All-District honors.

In her third year at Indiana, Stanton guided the Hoosiers to an overall record of 12-9 over 21 games prior to the premature cancellation of the rest of the season due to the COVID-19 pandemic in spring 2020. Indiana won nine of their last 12 ballgames on the season and earned an initial NCAA RPI ranking of 52 prior to the season's cancellation.

Emily Goodin picked up a conference weekly award for IU winning Big Ten Co-Pitcher of the Week after tossing her second career no-hitter against Bucknell on Feb. 21. She was the senior ace of the staff going 10-7, held a 1.76 ERA, registered 111 strikeouts and became the sixth IU pitcher to record multiple no-hitters.

In her second campaign at the helm of the Hoosiers, Stanton built upon the success of her inaugural season as the Hoosiers opened the year with a 14-0 mark, the best start in IU program history. Thanks to the hot start, Indiana earned a spot in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll, the first ranking for the team since 1996. IU would spend six straight weeks ranked, picking up wins against two top-10 teams in No. 6 Georgia (Feb. 10) and at No. 10 LSU (March 1), the first time that has been done at Indiana.

IU's final record of 36-21 was the best for the Hoosiers since the 2011 season, while the team's non-conference record (26-8) was the best since 1986. The team impressed on the basepaths, setting the single-season IU record with 141, which is also good for the third-most by a Big Ten team in history.

For the second year in a row, pitcher Tara Trainer earned First Team NFCA All-Midwest Region honors as well as All-Big Ten accolades after leaving IU as one of the most decorated pitchers in Indiana history. This season, Trainer posted career-best numbers with a 1.82 ERA, 231 strikeouts and a 26-11 record. Trainer graduates second all-time in strikeouts (803), appearances (170) and games started (130). In addition, she is third in career wins (68) and innings pitched (742.0) and fourth in shutouts (19). Trainer became just the fourth Hoosier to be drafted in the National Pro Fastpitch league when she was selected 21st overall by the Aussie Peppers on April 15.

Sophomore Maddie Westmoreland also earned All-Region honors for the second year in a row, as well as becoming the first Hoosier since 1997-98 to be named First Team All-Big Ten in two straight years. Joining Westmoreland and Trainer on the All-Big Ten list was sophomore shortstop Grayson Radcliffe. Indiana placed 11 on the Academic All-Big Ten list.

In her first season in Bloomington in 2018, Stanton led the Hoosiers to a 26-30 overall mark, including a 17-6 conference record, the most Big Ten wins in a single season since 2011. Indiana finished third in the conference, clinching a first-round bye in the Big Ten Tournament. The Hoosiers swept five teams on their way to the third-place finish - No. 18 Ohio State, Michigan State, Maryland, Penn State and Purdue - the most conference sweeps since 2011. After defeating Illinois in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals, Indiana advanced to the tournament semifinal for the first time since 2006.

Stanton tallied her 600th career victory at Michigan State on March 31 with a 5-1 victory against the Spartans. Another 2018 highlight was the Hoosiers collecting 112 stolen bases, the third-most in program history and the most since the 1987 season.

For their efforts in 2018, three Hoosiers earned NFCA All-Midwest Region - Tara Trainer (First Team), Gabbi Jenkins (Third Team) and Maddie Westmoreland (Third Team). In addition, Trainer and Westmoreland were also named First Team All-Big Ten, while Jenkins and Rebecca Blitz earned Second Team honors. Blitz also earned a spot on the Big Ten All-Defensive Team as the conference's top centerfielder. Westmoreland and Taylor Lambert were named to the conference's All-Freshman squad. Off the field, 12 were honored with Academic All-Big Ten accolades and 11 earned NFCA All-America Scholar Athletes.

During her tenure, Stanton guided the Thundering Herd to two NCAA Tournament appearances, five conference championship games and led the team to two Mid-American Conference championships (2003 and 2005), a Conference USA regular season championship (2017) and Conference USA Tournament title (2013). In addition, the Thundering Herd posted 12 seasons with 30 or more wins during Stanton's time in Huntington.

Under Stanton's guidance, Marshall was known for its speed as her teams ranked in the top 10 in stolen bases more than any other program since Stanton took over in 2000, including every year from 2009-17. For the third time since 2000, the Thundering Herd led the nation in stolen bases in 2017 with 162 on the year. Marshall saw two win the Golden Shoe Award for leading the nation in stolen bases under Stanton - current Indiana graduate student manager Morgan Zerkle in 2015 and Elicia D'Orazio in 2017. Six finished their Marshall careers with 100 or more stolen bases under Stanton, led by Zerkle's program record-setting 160 swiped bags.

This past season, Stanton guided Marshall's return to the NCAA Tournament as the Thundering Herd earned an at-large bid and posted a program-record 42-12 mark. During the season, Marshall posted a 17-game winning streak in 2017 and a 20-4 conference record leading to Stanton and her staff of Kendall Fearn and Chanda Bell being picked as the Conference USA Coaching Staff of the Year. In addition, Marshall saw Zerkle win C-USA Player of the Year honors and Jordan Dixon win C-USA Pitcher of the Year. Both Zerkle and Dixon also earned NFCA All-American accolades.

In addition to the team's impressive base-stealing numbers, the team finished with a batting average of .300 or better for the third straight season as Marshall climbed as high as No. 23 in the national rankings.

Stanton recorded her 500th career win on March 23, 2016 in an 8-3 victory against UTEP.

In 2013, Marshall's Conference USA Tournament title led to the Herd's first ever trip to the NCAA Tournament in Lexington, Ky. Marshall picked up its first NCAA tournament win, 3-1, over Notre Dame on May 18.

Under Stanton's tutelage, Marshall saw 76 all-conference selections, nine conference Player, Pitcher or Freshman of the Year accolades, 34 NFCA All-Region picks and a four-time All-American in Rachel Folden. Zerkle was named to the Top 50 Watch List for USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year and played for the USA Softball National Team this past summer. In addition, Zerkle was the seventh player under Stanton's guidance to reach the National Pro Fastpitch League.

OTHER COLLEGIATE COACHING EXPERIENCE

Prior to joining Marshall, Stanton served as the head coach at IUPUI in 1998-99, where she led the Jaguars to a 27-25 mark in their first season as a Division I team. After graduating college, Stanton served as a graduate assistant for Ashland University, where she received her Master's of Education in Sports Science. During her time, the softball program set a school record for victories in a season (53), won a second consecutive Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) title and earned a second straight NCAA Division II playoff berth. In the 1997-98 season, the Eagles finished 53-6, won the conference championship and hosted its regional tournament. That season, the entire coaching staff was selected as the coaching staff of the year in the GLIAC. All in all, Ashland compiled a 94-23 record en route to successive bids to the NCAA National Tournament.

NATIONAL PRO FASTPITCH

Stanton spent the 2007 and 2008 summers coaching the Akron Racers of the National Pro Fastpitch league. Stanton guided the Racers to a regular season second place finish in 2007 with a 26-17 overall record. Stanton managed the Racers leading hitter Norrelle Dickson to a .387 batting average, a league best. Additionally, Akron's second baseman, Veronica Wootsen snagged the 2007 Nokona Gold Glove Offensive Player of the Year Award.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanton (maiden name Spagnola) was a four-year starter at UNC Greensboro and led the team to back-to-back Big South Conference championships. In addition, Stanton scored 66 runs during her senior campaign in 1995, good for eighth in the nation and most all-time in a single season at UNC. She sits third in UNC history in career runs scored (143) and ninth in stolen bases (41). Off the field, Stanton earned her Bachelor of Arts in History at UNC and helped start the Spartan Heroes program at UNC, which worked to increase community service initiatives.
