### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 10-0 home record, swept Davidson in three home games last weekend and has won 13 games in a row.
- The Tigers are averaging 8.8 runs per game and hitting .306 with a .471 slugging percentage, .441 on-base percentage and 20 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.98 ERA, .210 opponents' batting average and 3.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .977.

### LIBERTY OVERVIEW

- Liberty, which has a 4-2 road record and is averaging 7.3 runs per game, is led by first-year Head Coach Bradley LeCroy.
- The Flames swept Central Michigan in three home games last weekend. They are hitting .263 and have a 3.86 ERA and .978 fielding percentage.
- Landon Scillely is hitting .339, Jaxon Sorenson and Nick Barone both have five homers and former Tiger Camden Troyer (2022) has three homers.

### QUICK HITS

- Liberty Head Coach Bradley LeCroy was a player (1997-00) and assistant coach (2003-05, 11-22) at Clemson.
- Clemson's 13-game winning streak is its longest since it won 17 in a row from April 29 to June 2 in 2023.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 10-0 record, seven saves, a 3.72 ERA, .217 opponents' batting average and 92 strikeouts in 75.0 innings pitched.

### POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation by Perfect Game this week.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 18 weeks in 2024. It has a current streak of 23 top-10 rankings in a row.
- Clemson has a current 31-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least poll dating to the 2023 season.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

### ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,029 fans per home date (10), the 11th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 9).
- In a 5-3 win over South Carolina on Feb. 28, Clemson set a school record with 6,891 fans in attendance at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

• Entering 2025, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 31 straight seasons.

## SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.
- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference coaches pre-season poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.
- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

## TIGERS SWEEP RIVAL GAMECOCKS

- Clemson swept South Carolina in three games at three different sites by a combined score of 18-6 from Feb. 28 to March 2.
- The Tigers won 5-3 at Clemson, 5-1 at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C. and 8-2 at South Carolina.
- Clemson never trailed in the series.
- Clemson had a 1.69 ERA, .160 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against nine walks in 27.0 innings pitched in the series.
- A Doug Kingsmore Stadium record crowd of 6,891 saw the Tigers outlast the Gamecocks 5-3 on Feb. 28.
- Ethan Darden received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series.
- Darden pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win on March 1.
- Jarren Purify was 4-for-8 with a homer, double, three RBIs, a .636 on-base percentage and two steals in three games.
- It marked the third time in four years the Tigers swept South Carolina, as they won all three games in 2022 and both games in 2024.
- It upped Clemson's winning streak in the series to five, while the Tigers have won 10 of the last 12 meetings.
- Clemson has won eight of the last 11 series dating to 2015.

## CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciufu, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaack and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).

• Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

## DARDEN HAVING HIS BEST SEASON

- Junior lefthander Ethan Darden is having his best season as a Tiger.
- A majority of his appearances in each of his three seasons as a Tiger have been in a starting role.
- He is 3-0 with a 1.64 ERA, .167 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against nine walks in 22.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He has not allowed a home run in his four appearances, all starts.
- Clemson has a 4-0 record in his four starts.
- He is holding opponents to .139 with runners on base, .053 with runners in scoring position and .136 with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal and has 28 groundball outs compared to 13 flyball outs.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 5-1 win over South Carolina on March 1.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors and received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina.
- In his career, he is 11-7 with a 4.75 ERA, .266 opponents' batting average and 107 strikeouts in 144.0 innings pitched over 42 appearances.

## LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .360 with five doubles, 20 RBIs, 18 runs, 14 walks, eight hit-by-pitches and a .541 on-base percentage in 16 games.
- He is the only Tiger to start all 16 games.
- He has only struck out seven times.
- He is hitting .429 with runners on base and .458 with runners in scoring position.
- He began his Clemson career on a 12-game hitting streak and nine-game RBI streak.
- He is reached base in all 15 of his games with a plate appearance.
- He is in his sixth year of college and has started all 219 of his teams' games during those six seasons.

## MAHLSTEDT SOLID ON & OFF THE FIELD

- Senior and sidearm righthander Lucas Mahlstedt has been one of the team's best relievers since transferring to Clemson for the 2024 season.
- He is 0-0 with four saves, an 0.82 ERA, a .158 opponents' batting average and 13 strikeouts versus one walk in 11.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He is holding opponents to .083 with two outs.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no hits, no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to record the save against South Carolina on Feb. 28.

- In two years as a Tiger, he is 4-1 with a 4.06 ERA and .254 opponents' batting average in 64.1 innings pitched over 33 relief outings.
- He also has five saves and 53 strikeouts against 16 walks in his two years at Clemson.
- On Feb. 26, he became a Weaver-James-Corrigan-Swofford Postgraduate Scholarship Award recipient.
- He was one of only 35 ACC student-athletes and three ACC baseball players to receive the 2025 award.
- He became the first Tiger baseball player to receive the accolade.

## PURIFY EMERGING AT THE PLATE

- Sophomore Jarren Purify has always been stellar on defense and one of the team's best leaders and energetic teammates.
- In 2025, he has become one of the team's top offensive threats.
- He is hitting .447 with three homers, two triples, four doubles, 17 RBIs, 16 runs and an .809 slugging percentage in 15 games in 2025.
- He also has a .500 on-base percentage and team-high nine steals along with a .959 fielding percentage at second base.
- He is hitting .545 with runners in scoring position and .500 with two outs.
- He is riding a nine-game hitting streak and is 17-for-30 (.567) with three homers and 12 RBIs during the streak.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 10, as he was 12-for-20 with two homers, two triples, a double and nine RBIs in five games.
- In his career, he is hitting .292 with 11 doubles, three triples, six homers, 45 RBIs, 48 runs and 20 steals in 69 games (62 starts).
