CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 24-5 home record, won two of three home games against No. 17 Louisville last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.5 runs per game and hitting .277 with a .446 slugging percentage, .419 on-base percentage and 55 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.43 ERA, .227 opponents' batting average and 2.60 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .975.

GEORGIA OVERVIEW

- Georgia, which has a 6-7 road record and is averaging 9.1 runs per game, is led by second-year Head Coach Wes Johnson.
- The Bulldogs were swept in three games at Vanderbilt last weekend. They are hitting .299 and have a 4.97 ERA and .982 fielding percentage.
- Ryland Zaborowski is hitting .398 with 16 homers and 55 RBIs, and Robbie Burnett is batting .341 with 17 homers, 55 RBIs and 12 steals.

QUICK HITS

- Except for the shortened 2020 season, Clemson and Georgia have played at least one game every year from 1959 to 2024.
- Clemson's highest-scoring inning is the first inning, when it has scored 60 runs, 20 more than any other inning.
- Clemson is 31-0 when allowing less than two homers in a game.

- Clemson is ranked No. 2 in the nation by all five polls this week.

- Clemson has a current 37-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least poll dating to the 2023 season.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,895 fans per home date (29), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of April 20).
- In a 5-3 win over South Carolina on Feb. 28, Clemson set a school record with 6,891 fans in attendance at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- Entering 2025, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 31 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in second place in the ACC standings with a 13-5 league mark, behind first-place Florida State (11-4).
- Clemson has won all six of its conference series, including series wins over No. 11 Wake Forest, No. 19 Georgia Tech and No. 17 Louisville.
- Clemson is the only ACC school to win all of its conference series in 2025.

SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.
- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference coaches pre-season poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.
- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

TIGERS SWEEP RIVAL GAMECOCKS

- Clemson swept South Carolina in three games at three different sites by a combined score of 18-6 from Feb. 28 to March 2.
- The Tigers won 5-3 at Clemson, 5-1 at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C. and 8-2 at South Carolina.
- Clemson never trailed in the series.
- Clemson had a 1.69 ERA, .160 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against nine walks in 27.0 innings pitched in the series.

- A Doug Kingsmore Stadium record crowd of 6,891 saw the Tigers outlast the Gamecocks 5-3 on Feb. 28.
- Ethan Darden received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series.
- Darden pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win on March 1.
- Jarren Purify was 4-for-8 with a homer, double, three RBIs, a .636 on-base percentage and two steals in three games.
- It marked the third time in four years the Tigers swept South Carolina, as they won all three games in 2022 and both games in 2024.
- It upped Clemson's winning streak in the series to five, while the Tigers have won 10 of the last 12 meetings.
- Clemson has won eight of the last 11 series dating to 2015.

17-GAME WINNING STREAK

- Clemson had a 17-game winning streak that started with a 6-2 win over VCU on Feb. 21 and ended with a 7-3 loss to Notre Dame on March 16.
- The 17-game winning streak was Clemson's longest since it won 17 games in a row during the 2023 season.
- The 17-game winning streak tied for the fourth longest in school history.
- Seven of the 17 wins during the winning streak were comeback victories.
- Clemson hit .290 with a .480 slugging percentage, .439 on-base percentage and 8.3 runs per game during the winning streak.
- Clemson had a 2.84 ERA, .186 opponents' batting average and 184 strikeouts against 57 walks in 149.0 innings pitched in the winning streak.
- Clemson held opponents to .145 with runners in scoring position during the winning streak.

TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

- Clemson batters have been hit by a pitch 79 times in 42 games (1.9 per game) in 2025.
- The Tiger record for hit-by-pitches in a season is 80, set by the 2021 team.
- The 79 hit-by-pitches along with its 269 walks (6.4 per game) are a big reason Clemson has a .419 on-base percentage.
- Dominic Listi leads the team in hit-by-pitches with 18, third in a season in school history.
- Jarren Purify is second on the team in hit-by-pitches (12).

BULLPEN SUCCESS

- Clemson's bullpen has been a big reason the Tigers have won the majority of their close games in 2025.

NOTES

- The bullpen has a 24-1 record, 18 saves, a 3.78 ERA, .228 opponents' batting average and 243 strikeouts in 207.1 innings pitched.
- Tiger relievers have allowed 88 walks and have a 2.76 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- The bullpen is a big reason Clemson opponents have just one comeback win in 2025, an 8-6 Louisville win on April 19.
- Lucas Mahlstedt leads the bullpen with a 2-0 record, 14 saves and a 1.11 ERA in 17 relief appearances
- Reed Garris is 3-0 with two saves, an 0.83 ERA and a .167 opponents' batting average in 13 relief appearances.
- Joe Allen has only allowed one of 16 inherited baserunners to score in his 14 relief appearances.

CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciuffo, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

BAILEY BACK

- Senior lefty B.J. Bailey missed all of 2024 due to injury after pitching 15.2 innings in 2023, but has become one of Clemson's top pitchers.
- He is 2-1 with a 3.07 ERA, .217 opponents' batting average and 41 strikeouts against 17 walks in 44.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He has made nine relief appearances and three starts, as he joined the weekend rotation for the first time at Georgia Tech in late March.
- He leads the team in pickoffs (2).
- He is holding opponents to .203 with runners on base and .139 with runners in scoring position.
- He allowed one run with eight strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched in the second game of a doubleheader at No. 19 Georgia Tech on March 29.
- It was his first start as a Tiger, as he allowed just four hits against a team that entered the game averaging 9.9 runs per game.
- The only run he allowed came on a two-out balk, as he struck out the next batter.
- In two active years as a Tiger, he is 4-3 with a 3.32 ERA and .236 opponents' batting average in 59.2 innings pitched over 29 appearances.
- He has 61 strikeouts against 23 walks in his two active years as a Tiger.

CANNARELLA RACKING UP HITS

- Junior outfielder Cam Cannarella continues to accumulate hits in his third season as a Tiger.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .306 with two homers, a triple, 11 doubles, 27 RBIs, 43 runs, a .466 on-base percentage and four steals in 40 games in 2025.
- He has more walks (39) than strikeouts (31).
- He is riding a 23-game on-base streak.
- He went 5-for-5 with an RBI and two runs in Clemson's 6-4 win over The Citadel on March 18.
- In his career, he is hitting .350 with 224 hits, 43 doubles, seven triples, 20 homers, 134 RBIs, 173 runs and 28 steals in 157 games.
- In his career, he has a .533 slugging percentage and .446 on-base percentage.

GAFFNEY AT HOME

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Luke Gaffney has found a home at Clemson after transferring from Purdue following a standout 2024 season.
- He is hitting .294 with four homers, six doubles, 31 RBIs, 20 runs, a .388 on-base percentage and steal in 40 games (38 starts) in 2025.

GARRIS PROVIDING RELIEF

- Senior righthander Reed Garris has been a steadying influence on the bullpen for three years.
- He's 3-0 with two saves, an 0.83 ERA, a .167 opponents' batting average and 26 strikeouts versus five walks in 21.2 innings pitched in 2025.
- In his career, he is 9-1 with two saves, a 2.85 ERA, .192 opponents' batting average and 90 strikeouts in 75.2 innings pitched.
- He has made 60 relief appearances in three seasons as a pitcher after playing his first season (2022) at Clemson as a catcher.

JARRELL POSTING POWER NUMBERS

- Junior catcher Jacob Jarrell has been one of the team's top power hitters in 2025.
- He leads the team in homers with 10, including eight in the last 14 games.
- He is hitting .256 with 10 homers, four doubles, 25 RBIs, 33 runs and a .400 on-base percentage in 39 games (37 starts) in 2025.
- He is hitting .290 with six homers, four doubles, 12 RBIs, 17 runs and a .609 slugging percentage in 18 ACC regular-season games.
- He has two two-homer games in 2025, at Georgia Tech on March 28 and against Gardner-Webb on April 9.
- In his career, he is hitting .251 with 14 doubles, 21 homers, 67 RBIs, 69 runs and a steal in 102 games (90 starts).

KNAAK PILING UP STRIKEOUTS

- Sophomore righty Aidan Knaak is continuing where he left off in 2024 by piling up strikeouts in 2025.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is 6-0 with a 3.86 ERA, .195 opponents' batting average and 74 strikeouts against 16 walks in 56.0 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- He has an 11.89 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in 2025.
- Clemson has a 10-0 record in his 10 starts in 2025.
- In six ACC regular-season starts, he is 4-0 with a 3.13 ERA, .180 opponents' batting average and 42 strikeouts in 37.1 innings pitched.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with 12 strikeouts against one walk to earn the win against Notre Dame on March 14.
- He allowed two hits, one run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 21.
- He was named Perfect Game National Pitcher-of-the-Week and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts.
- He was named ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts, as it was the third time in his career he earned that accolade.
- He is one of only seven Tigers in history to be a three-time ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week (first awarded in 1989) in a career.
- In his career, he is 11-1 with a 3.55 ERA, .211 opponents' batting average and 182 strikeouts in 139.1 innings pitched over 25 starts.
- Clemson has a 23-2 record in his 25 career starts.
- His 11.76 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is second in Clemson history.

LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .291 with two homers, nine doubles, 36 RBIs, 41 runs, 46 walks, 18 hit-by-pitches and a .518 on-base percentage in 42 games.
- He is the only Tiger to start all 42 games.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 38 of his 40 games with a plate appearance in 2025.
- His 18 hit-by-pitches are third in a season in Clemson history. The school record is 21, set by Khalil Greene in 2001.
- He is hitting .348 with runners on base and .385 with runners in scoring position.
- He began his Clemson career on a 12-game hitting streak and nine-game RBI streak.
- He is in his sixth year of college and has started all 245 of his teams' games during those six seasons.

MAHLSTEDT SOLID ON & OFF THE FIELD

- Senior and sidearm righthander Lucas Mahlstedt has been one of the team's best relievers since transferring to Clemson for the 2024 season.
- He was one of 55 players named to the National Pitcher-of-the-Year Watch List in April.
- He is 2-0 with 14 saves, a 1.11 ERA, a .202 opponents' batting average and 46 strikeouts against five walks in 32.1 innings pitched in 2025.
- He leads the nation in saves (through games of April 20).
- His 14 saves are tied for second in a season in Clemson history. The school record is 15, set by Nick Glaser in 2000.
- He has only allowed three extra-base hits.
- He is holding opponents to .163 with two outs.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no hits, no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to record the save against South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 23.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no runs and no walks with five strikeouts to record the save against Stanford on April 12.
- In two years as a Tiger, he is 6-1 with a 3.36 ERA and .246 opponents' batting average in 85.2 innings pitched over 45 relief outings.
- He also has 15 saves and 85 strikeouts against 20 walks in his two years at Clemson.
- On Feb. 26, he became a Weaver-James-Corrigan-Swofford Postgraduate Scholarship Award recipient.
- He was one of only 35 ACC student-athletes and three ACC baseball players to receive the 2025 award.
- He became the first Tiger baseball player to receive the accolade.

PURIFY EMERGING AT THE PLATE

- Sophomore Jarren Purify has always been solid on defense and one of the team's best leaders and energetic teammates.
- In 2025, he has become one of the team's top offensive threats.
- He is hitting .319 with three home runs, three triples, eight doubles, 27 RBIs and 43 runs in 40 games in 2025.
- He also has a .461 on-base percentage and team-high 21 steals.
- He had a 21-game on-base streak from February to March.

- He had a 13-game hitting streak from February to March, as he was 22-for-41 (.537) with three homers, 14 RBIs and a .632 on-base percentage.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 10, as he was 12-for-20 with two homers, two triples, a double and nine RBIs in five games.
- He went 1-for-3 with four walks and four steals against No. 17 Louisville on April 19.
- In his career, he is hitting .280 with 15 doubles, four triples, six homers, 55 RBIs, 75 runs and 32 steals in 94 games (87 starts).

TITSWORTH FILLING VARIETY OF ROLES

- Sophomore righty Drew Titsworth has been a valuable asset to the Tiger bullpen as a long reliever and made his first career start in April.
- He is 4-0 with two saves, a 2.86 ERA, .214 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts in 28.1 innings pitched over 14 outings (one start).
- He has only allowed seven walks and has a 4.57 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He pitched 4.1 perfect innings in relief with seven strikeouts to earn the win against Gardner-Webb on April 9.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in his first career start to earn the win against No. 17 Louisville on April 18.
- He did not allow a baserunner past second base and faced three batters over the minimum, earning ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors.
- In his career, he is 8-0 with a 2.98 ERA, .180 opponents' batting average and 58 strikeouts in 48.1 innings pitched over 33 appearances.
- He also has two saves in his career.

FOUR TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2025

- Four former Tigers, Carson Spiers, Spencer Strider, Eli White and Justin Wroblecki, have played in an MLB game in 2025.
- Spiers, who had a 2.47 ERA at Clemson from 2017-20, made his MLB debut as a starter with the Cincinnati Reds on Sept. 3, 2023.
- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, was a 2023 MLB All-Star Game selection.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Wroblecki, who played one season (2019) at Clemson before transferring, made his MLB debut with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 7, 2024.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2021 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 70 years (streak started in 1956).
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 52 years (streak started in 1974).
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
