**CLEMSON OVERVIEW**

- Clemson, which has a 7-7 road record, won one of three home games against Duke last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.0 runs per game and hitting .270 with a .438 slugging percentage, .405 on-base percentage and 60 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 5.02 ERA, .251 opponents' batting average and 2.51 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .976.

**PITTSBURGH OVERVIEW**

- Pittsburgh, which has a 12-7 home record and is averaging 7.1 runs per game, is led by seventh-year Head Coach Mike Bell.
- The Panthers defeated Penn State 15-1 on Tuesday. They are hitting .276 and have a 6.32 ERA and .967 fielding percentage.
- Luke Cantwell is hitting .348 with a .504 on-base percentage, Ryan Zuckerman has 12 homers and 46 RBIs and Ethan Firoved has eight saves.

**QUICK HITS**

- The series at Pittsburgh marks Clemson's first games playing on a field-turf infield since the opening weekend of the 2025 season.
- Clemson's highest-scoring inning is the first, when it has scored 70 runs, 28 more than any other inning.
- Clemson has a .976 fielding percentage, just behind the school record of .977, set by the 2023 team.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

• The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

### ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,940 fans per home date (33), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 13).
- In a 5-3 win over South Carolina on Feb. 28, Clemson set a school record with 6,891 fans in attendance at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- Entering 2025, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 31 straight seasons.

### ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in seventh place in the ACC standings with a 15-12 league mark.
- Clemson has won six of its nine ACC series, including series wins over No. 11 Wake Forest, No. 19 Georgia Tech and No. 17 Louisville.
- Clemson's six ACC series wins are tied for most in the conference.

### SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an official RPI of No. 14 (through games of May 13).
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-15 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 15 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 95 in the nation, and the Tigers were 23-3 in regular-season non-conference games.

### TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

- Clemson batters have been hit by a pitch 91 times in 53 games (1.7 per game) in 2025.
- Clemson has set the Tiger record for hit-by-pitches in a season, breaking the 2021 team's mark of 80.
- The 91 hit-by-pitches along with its 316 walks (6.0 per game) are a big reason Clemson has a .405 on-base percentage.
- Dominic Listi leads the team in hit-by-pitches with a school-record 23.
- Andrew Ciuffo and Jarren Purify are tied for second on the team in hit-by-pitches (12).

### BULLPEN SUCCESS

- Clemson's bullpen has been a big reason the Tigers have won the vast majority of their close games in 2025.
- The bullpen has a 26-4 record, 20 saves, a 4.40 ERA, .249 opponents' batting average and 299 strikeouts in 257.2 innings pitched.

- Tiger relievers have allowed 111 walks and have a 2.69 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Lucas Mahlstedt leads the bullpen with a 2-0 record, Tiger-record-tying 15 saves and 2.06 ERA in 22 relief appearances.
- Reed Garris is 3-0 with three saves, a 1.33 ERA and .178 opponents' batting average in 17 relief appearances.

### CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciuffo, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

### GRADUATES

- Four Tiger players received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Littlejohn Coliseum on May 8,9.
- Jay Dillard, Lleyton Lackey and Lucas Mahlstedt earned their bachelor's degree.
- Dillard and Lackey earned their degrees in only three years.
- Andrew Ciuffo earned his master's degree.
- Tristan Bissetta, Reed Garris and Josh Paino earned their certificates.

### ALLEN ALL IN THE BULLPEN

- Junior righthander Joe Allen has been a reliable reliever for the Tigers during his career.
- He is 3-0 with a 1.82 ERA, .207 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts in 24.2 innings pitched over 18 relief appearances in 2025.
- He has only allowed three extra-base hits, including only one homer.
- He has only allowed three of 21 inherited baserunners to score.
- He has not allowed an earned run in 8.2 innings pitched over nine relief appearances in ACC games.
- He pitched 3.0 hitless and scoreless innings in relief with six strikeouts to earn the win at South Carolina on March 2.
- In his career, he is 7-0 with one save, a 3.97 ERA, .237 opponents' batting average and 86 strikeouts in 77.0 innings pitched.
- He has made 47 appearances (four starts) in his career.

# NOTES

## CANNARELLA RACKING UP HITS

- Junior outfielder Cam Cannarella continues to accumulate hits in his third season as a Tiger.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He's hitting .314 with two homers, two triples, 16 doubles, 38 RBIs, 48 runs, a .461 on-base percentage and four steals in 51 games in 2025.
- He has more walks (46) than strikeouts (35).
- He is riding a 34-game on-base streak.
- He is riding a 12-game hitting streak.
- He went 5-for-5 with an RBI and two runs in Clemson's 6-4 win over The Citadel on March 18.
- He hit a two-run triple and scored the go-ahead run on the play in the eighth inning in Clemson's victory over No. 5 Florida State on May 3.
- In his career, he is hitting .349 with 239 hits, 48 doubles, eight triples, 20 homers, 145 RBIs, 178 runs and 28 steals in 168 games.
- In his career, he has a .531 slugging percentage and .446 on-base percentage.

## CIUFO FIELDING AT SHORTSTOP

- Senior infielder Andrew Ciufu missed the last half of the 2024 season due to injury and returned for his sixth year in college in 2025.
- The starting shortstop is hitting .247 with six homers, seven doubles, 29 RBIs, 29 runs and three steals in 50 games (49 starts).
- He has 10 sacrifice bunts in 2025, tied for seventh in a season in Tiger history.
- He has committed only seven errors and has a stellar .963 fielding percentage.
- In his two years as a Tiger, he is hitting .259 with nine doubles, a triple, eight homers, 45 RBIs, 48 runs and eight steals in 77 games.
- In his two years as a Tiger, he has committed only 12 errors and has a .960 fielding percentage.

## GARRIS PROVIDING RELIEF

- Senior righthander Reed Garris has been a steadying influence on the bullpen for three years.
- He's 3-0 with three saves, a 1.33 ERA, .178 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts versus seven walks in 27.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He is 2-0 with two saves, a 1.76 ERA and 18 strikeouts against five walks in 15.1 innings pitched (11 outings) in ACC regular-season games.
- In his career, he is 9-1 with three saves, a 2.89 ERA, .194 opponents' batting average and 94 strikeouts in 81.0 innings pitched.
- He has only allowed 26 walks and hit three batters in his career.
- He has a 3.62 strikeout-to-walk ratio in his career.
- He has not thrown a wild pitch in his career.
- He has made 64 relief appearances in three seasons as a pitcher after playing his first season (2022) at Clemson as a catcher.

## JARRELL POSTING POWER NUMBERS

- Junior catcher Jacob Jarrell has been one of the team's top power hitters in 2025.
- He was named to the Buster Posey Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .247 with 11 homers, five doubles, 31 RBIs, 39 runs and a .385 on-base percentage in 50 games (48 starts) in 2025.
- He leads the team in homers.
- He is hitting .270 with seven homers, five doubles, 18 RBIs, 23 runs and a .530 slugging percentage in 27 ACC regular-season games.
- He has two two-homer games in 2025, at Georgia Tech on March 28 and against Gardner-Webb on April 9.

- In his career, he is hitting .247 with 15 doubles, 22 homers, 73 RBIs, 75 runs and a steal in 113 games (101 starts).

## KNAAK PILING UP STRIKEOUTS

- Sophomore righthander Aidan Knaak is continuing where he left off in 2024 by piling up strikeouts in 2025.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is 7-1 with a 4.56 ERA, .226 opponents' batting average and 88 strikeouts against 24 walks in 71.0 innings pitched over 13 starts.
- He has a 11.15 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in 2025.
- Clemson has an 11-2 record in his 13 starts in 2025.
- In nine ACC regular-season starts, he is 5-1 with a 4.30 ERA, .228 opponents' batting average and 56 strikeouts in 52.1 innings pitched.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with 12 strikeouts against one walk to earn the win against Notre Dame on March 14.
- He allowed two hits, one run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 21.
- He was named Perfect Game National Pitcher-of-the-Week and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts.
- He was named ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts, as it was the third time in his career he earned that accolade.
- He is one of only seven Tigers in history to be a three-time ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week (first awarded in 1989) in a career.
- In his career, he is 12-2 with a 3.91 ERA, .223 opponents' batting average and 196 strikeouts in 154.1 innings pitched over 28 starts.
- Clemson has a 24-4 record in his 28 career starts.
- His 11.43 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is second in Clemson history.
- His 3.70 strikeout-to-walk ratio in his career is eighth in Clemson history.

## LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .289 with three homers, a triple, 13 doubles, 38 RBIs, 52 runs, 51 walks and a .500 on-base percentage in 53 games.
- The last Tiger with a .500 on-base percentage in a season was Seth Beer in 2016, when he had a .535 on-base percentage.
- His 23 hit-by-pitches are most in a season in Clemson history.
- He is the only Tiger to start all 53 games in 2025.

- He is 2-0 with 15 saves, a 2.06 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average and 54 strikeouts against six walks in 39.1 innings pitched in 2025.
- He is second in the nation in saves (through games of May 13).
- His 15 saves are tied for the Tiger single-season record, shared with Nick Glaser in 2000.
- He has only allowed two homers.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no hits, no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to record the save against South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 23.

### PRIEST SLUGGING

- Sophomore infielder Collin Priest has put up solid power numbers in his first season as a Tiger in 2025 after transferring from Michigan.
- He is hitting .245 with 10 homers, 11 doubles, 41 RBIs, 32 runs and 39 walks in 49 games (47 starts) in 2025.
- He also has a .503 slugging percentage and .416 on-base percentage.
- He had a 12-game hitting streak from April to May.
- He is hitting .264 with eight homers, five doubles, 26 RBIs, 16 runs and 22 walks in 26 ACC regular-season games.
- He has a .598 slugging percentage and .431 on-base percentage in ACC regular-season games.

### PURIFY EMERGING AT THE PLATE

- Sophomore Jarren Purify has always been solid on defense and one of the team's best leaders and energetic teammates.
- In 2025, he has become one of the team's top offensive threats.
- He is hitting .293 with four homers, three triples, 10 doubles, 30 RBIs and 45 runs in 47 games in 2025.
- He also has a .424 on-base percentage and team-high 23 steals.
- He had a 21-game on-base streak from February to March.
- He had a 13-game hitting streak from February to March, as he was 22-for-41 (.537) with three homers, 14 RBIs and a .632 on-base percentage.

- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 10, as he was 12-for-20 with two homers, two triples, a double and nine RBIs in five games.
- He went 1-for-3 with four walks and four steals against No. 17 Louisville on April 19.
- In his career, he is hitting .271 with 17 doubles, four triples, seven homers, 58 RBIs, 77 runs and 34 steals in 101 games (94 starts).

### TITSWORTH FILLING VARIETY OF ROLES

- Sophomore righty Drew Titsworth has been a valuable asset to the Tiger bullpen as a long reliever and made his first career start in April.
- He was named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Watch List in the preseason.
- He is 4-1 with two saves, a 4.31 ERA and .266 opponents' batting average in 39.2 innings pitched over 17 appearances (four starts).
- He has 41 strikeouts and has only allowed 13 walks, good for a 3.15 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He pitched 4.1 perfect innings in relief with seven strikeouts to earn the win against Gardner-Webb on April 9.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in his first career start to earn the win against No. 17 Louisville on April 18.
- He did not allow a baserunner past second base and faced three batters over the minimum, earning ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors.
- In his career, he is 8-1 with a 3.92 ERA, .223 opponents' batting average and 67 strikeouts in 59.2 innings pitched over 36 appearances.
- He also has two saves in his career.

### FIVE TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2025

- Five former Tigers, Carson Spiers, Spencer Strider, Eli White, Weston Wilson and Justin Wroblewski, have played in an MLB game in 2025.
- Spiers, who had a 2.47 ERA at Clemson from 2017-20, made his MLB debut as a starter with the Cincinnati Reds on Sept. 3, 2023.
- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, was a 2023 MLB All-Star Game selection.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Wilson, who hit .260 with 94 RBIs at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Philadelphia Phillies on Aug. 9, 2023.
- Wroblewski, who played one season (2019) at Clemson before transferring, made his MLB debut with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 7, 2024.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2021 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 70 years (streak started in 1956).
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 52 years (streak started in 1974).
