CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 13-0 home record, lost to Georgia Southern 6-1 at North Augusta, S.C. on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.9 runs per game and hitting .316 with a .519 slugging percentage, .424 on-base percentage and 21 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 2.17 ERA, .169 opponents' batting average and 3.80 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .961.

GEORGIA TECH OVERVIEW

- Georgia Tech, which has a 2-0 road record and is averaging 13.4 runs per game, is led by first-year Head Coach James Ramsey.
- The Yellow Jackets beat West Georgia 14-0 at home on Tuesday. They are hitting .410 and have a 3.60 ERA and .967 fielding percentage.
- Alex Hernandez is hitting .526, Vahn Lackey is batting .467 and Jake Lankie and Caden Spivey each have one save.

QUICK HITS

- Thursday's game marks Clemson's first home night game of the 2026 season.
- Clemson has not played and is not scheduled to play a game in Florida, Georgia or North Carolina (outside of Charlotte) in 2026.
- Junior lefthander Noah Samol was a member of the Georgia Tech pitching staff in 2023.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

• The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,309 fans per home date (11), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 10).
- Entering 2026, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 32 straight seasons.

CAPTAINS

- Joe Allen, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the third time, while Knaak and Purify were voted a team-captain for the second time.
- Talan Bell, Luke Gaffney, Ty Marshall, Tryston McCladdie and Noah Samol were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Jason Fultz Jr., Tyler Lichtenberger, Dane Moehler, Danny Nelson and Nate Savoie were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

PITCHING IN CONTROL

- Clemson's pitching staff has gotten off to a strong start in 2026 under Pitching Coach Jimmy Belanger.
- The staff has a 2.17 ERA, .169 opponents' batting average and 171 strikeouts against 45 walks in 141.0 innings pitched.
- The staff has a 3.80 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 10.91 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark.
- The staff has surrendered only 30 extra-base hits, including only nine home runs.
- The staff is holding lefthanded batters to .105.
- Since allowing 10 hits in the season opener against Army West Point, it has not given up more than eight hits in a game in the last 16 games.
- In the series win against South Carolina from Feb. 27 to March 1, the staff allowed only four hits in each of the three games.

ALLEN SOLIDIFYING BULLPEN

- Senior righthander Joe Allen has been a reliable pitcher in the bullpen for four seasons, including 2026 as a late-inning pitcher.
- He is 2-0 with one save, a 1.42 ERA, .136 opponents' batting average and nine strikeouts against one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- He has made five relief appearances.
- He has not allowed an extra-base hit.
- In his career, he is 11-0 with two saves, a 3.68 ERA, .228 opponents' batting average and 99 strikeouts in 88.0 innings pitched.
- He has made 57 career appearances (four starts).

GAFFNEY RESURGING

- Junior Luke Gaffney has rebounded in 2026 to become one of the team's top offensive threats.

- He is hitting .351 with two homers, five doubles, 13 RBIs, eight runs and a .544 slugging percentage in 17 games in 2026.
- He has a .449 on-base percentage thanks to nine walks and two hit-by-pitches against only four strikeouts.
- In his two years as a Tiger, he is hitting .290 with 12 doubles, seven homers, 52 RBIs, 34 runs and two steals in 71 games (68 starts).

KNAAK KEEPING WINNING WAYS

- Junior righthander Aidan Knaak has been a mainstay in the Tiger rotation for three years and has been a big part of wins for the program.
- He has a 2.77 ERA, .156 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts versus seven walks in 13.0 innings pitched over three starts in 2026.
- He has not allowed an extra-base hit.
- In his career, he is 14-3 with a 3.71 ERA, .213 opponents' batting average and 240 strikeouts in 186.2 innings pitched over 34 starts.
- Clemson has a 28-6 record in his 34 career starts.
- His 11.57 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is second in Clemson history.
- His 3.69 strikeout-to-walk ratio in his career is ninth in Clemson history.
- He is one of five Tigers with multiple 100-strikeout seasons and the only Tiger with a 100-strikeout season in each of his first two years.
- Harold Stowe (1958,59), Rusty Gerhardt (1970,71), Brian Barnes (1987-89) and Billy Koch (1995,96) are the others with multiple seasons.
- He is one of only two Tigers in history to be a four-time ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week (first awarded in 1989) in a career (Kris Benson (6)).

McCLADDIE EMERGING

- Junior infielder and outfielder Tryston McCladdie has emerged as a consistent offensive presence near the top of the lineup in 2026.
- He has split time playing in center field and at third.
- He is hitting .400 with five homers, two doubles, 21 RBIs, 20 runs, a .683 slugging percentage and eight steals in 17 games in 2026.
- He has a .514 on-base percentage thanks to 14 walks against only four strikeouts.
- He is 5-for-5 with the bases loaded.
- He has a team-high nine multiple-RBI games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak, which included his last two games of 2025 and the first nine games of 2026.
- He has hit safely in 16 of the 17 games in 2026.
- He was 7-for-14 with a homer, seven RBIs, nine runs, a .632 on-base percentage and three steals in the series against La Salle (March 6-8).
- In his career, he is hitting .322 with six doubles, a triple, 10 homers, 43 RBIs, 47 runs and 18 steals in 66 games (46 starts).
- In his career, he has a .544 slugging percentage and .438 on-base percentage.

NOTES

PURIFY LEADING THINGS OFF

- Junior Jarren Purify has been a mainstay at second base and as the leadoff batter in 2026.
- He is hitting .377 with two homers, five doubles, 11 RBIs, 22 runs, a .467 on-base percentage and eight steals in 17 games (16 starts).
- He has a team-high nine multiple-hit games.
- He was 9-for-13 with two homers, two doubles, seven RBIs, 11 runs, five walks and four steals in the series against La Salle (March 6-8).
- In his career, he is hitting .290 with 22 doubles, four triples, 11 homers, 74 RBIs, 108 runs and 48 steals in 128 games (120 starts).
- In his career, he has a .398 on-base percentage.

SAVOIE OFF TO HOT START

- Sophomore catcher and outfielder Nate Savoie is in his first season at Clemson after transferring from Loyola Marymount.
- He is hitting .397 with five homers, five doubles, 25 RBIs, 17 runs, a .472 on-base percentage and two steals in 17 games in 2026.
- He has a .714 slugging percentage and is hitting .560 with runners in scoring position.
- In his first three games as a Tiger against Army West Point on Feb. 13,14, he was 8-for-11 (.727) with a homer, double and seven RBIs.
- He was 7-for-13 (.538) with a homer, two doubles, 10 RBIs, six runs and a .667 on-base percentage in the series versus La Salle (March 6-8).

SHARMAN FILLING ROLE

- Senior lefthander and transfer Michael Sharman filled in in the rotation during the opening weekend and has been in the rotation since.
- He is 4-0 with an 0.72 ERA, .115 opponents' batting average and 26 strikeouts against one walk in 25.0 innings pitched over four starts.
- He has allowed two one extra-base hits (both doubles).
- He retired the first 17 batters and allowed one hit and no walks with eight strikeouts to earn the win against Army West Point on Feb. 14.
- He pitched a complete game, the first by a Tiger since 2024, in the 4-1 win over South Carolina at Columbia, S.C. (Segra Park) on Feb. 28.
- He allowed four hits, one run and no walks with four strikeouts in 9.0 innings pitched, as he threw only 78 pitches (67 strikes).
- He did not throw more than 11 pitches in any inning, while only two batters saw a two-ball count and no batters saw a three-ball count.
- He was named Golden Spikes Award x D1Baseball National Player-of-the-Week and Perfect Game National Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts.
- He also was named ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week and received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the three-game series.
