

## RED HANDFLARE "CHIMI2" ITEM Nº 9990701

Used to signal distress and pinpoint location by day and night. Designed to withstand exceptional environmental exposure and to perform reliably even after immersion in water. Featuring an improved grip and operation by pull wire ignitor. Produces hot red flame for 60 seconds at 15.000 candela.




### Application

For use by day or night, the Oroquieta red handflare "Chimi2" is a short-range distress signal used to pinpoint position when rescuers is sighted. Ideal for use on yachts, dinghies, RIBs or canoes.

### Operation

1. Unscrew cap and point away.
2. Pull ball out sharply to fire.
3. Hold at arms length. Point downwind. End plug ejects after 2 seconds.

### Storage


Should be stored in either KIT in a dry, easily accessed location at ambient temperature.
