IMPORTANT NOTICE

COVID-19 RAPID ANTIGEN TESTING NOW PROVIDED IN-RESORT ON A CONCIERGE BASIS FOR RETURNING US AND UK GUESTS

We are pleased to advise that, beginning **26 January 2021**, the following Antigua resorts will be providing **in-house Rapid Antigen Covid-19 Testing** on a concierge basis for returning **US and UK guests**:

- *St. James's Club & Villas, Antigua*
- *Pineapple Beach Club Antigua*
- *Hammock Cove Antigua*
- *Galley Bay Resort & Spa, Antigua*

Testing will be provided in a convenient location at the resort within **72 hours** of guest departure, as required by US and UK health and immigration authorities.

Tests will be administered by a medical professional, who will provide nasal swab rapid antigen testing. Test results will be available the **same day**, and guests will receive a **written printout of their test results** to present at the Antigua airport for departure.

Guests will be charged **US\$60 per test**, payable locally at the resort with cash or credit card.

In the unlikely event that a guest tests positive for Covid-19 and is required to quarantine in Antigua (assuming the guest does not require hospitalization), the resort will accommodate the guest and one travel companion in a dedicated quarantine guest room at the resort.

In such cases, the resorts will accommodate quarantined guests for up to 14 nights at the discounted all-inclusive rates of **US\$350** per room, per night at St. James's Club and Pineapple Beach Club, and **US\$550** per room, per night at Hammock Cove and Galley Bay, payable locally at the relevant resort.

The cost of any necessary doctor's visits or medications for quarantined guests will remain the responsibility of the guest(s). Guests can usually recover out-of-pocket medical expenses from their health and travel insurers.

****PCR testing, as required by Canada, is not available at the resorts at this time.***
