How to STOP therapy with Optune Gio




Press TTFields button

Tips and Tricks on how to fit Optune Gio® into your life



Sleeping

- Connect power supply
- Wear a net bandage
- Ensure good ventilation of arrays



Showering

- Turn off the device as equipment is not water resistant
- Ensure arrays to not get wet during showering or remove arrays for the process



Outdoors

- Protect arrays and device from direct sun and rain
- Wear light, breathable head cover
- Take charged batteries for trips over 2 hours



Travel

- Travel with Optune Gio is possible
- Air and Ship travel may require some preparation. Contact us for support.

Some helpful tips for taking care of your skin and arrays

Tips for taking care of your skin



Good Hygiene

Wash your hands before application and removal of arrays and clean the shaver after every use.



New Shaver

Replace your electric shaver regularly.



Rotate Arrays

Rotate the placement of arrays during exchanges as indicated.



Ventilation

Ensure proper ventilation of arrays.



Good Contact

Change arrays at least twice a week or when array-to-skin contact decreases.



Seek medical advice if you are experiencing skin irritations.



Array Change Routine

Proper array change routine plays an important role in minimizing irritation.



Remove arrays gently with baby oil or warm water and examine skin for signs of damage.



Wash your scalp with a mild fragrance-free shampoo or dandruff shampoo.



Shave. Ensure a close shave with a clean razor.



Take a short break. Moisturize your skin regularly with fragrance-free, water-based moisturizer.



Clean again. Remove any residue before array placement.



Place new arrays. The polymer needs direct skin contact. Open wounds, shunts, screws or plates should be avoided.

Ordering & Disposal of Arrays



Do not throw used arrays in the trash. Place in the re-sealable bag to ship back to Novocure. Do not include any trash or other items in the used transducer array bag.

Call MyNovocure Support Center when 8 arrays of each color, or 16 arrays, remain. Contact details can be found on Page 2.

Troubleshooting

Don't worry – alarms will occur. Use this quick guide to check common alarm causes.

For a more complete set of information, or in case you have doubts or questions, please always refer to the Optune Gio User Manual

If the TTFields light is flashing and alarm tone sounds, your Optune Gio® was switched on for around 10 minutes without the TTFields button on.

If it is a 3-2 beep Alarm, it is array related.

- Reinforce array contact with netting or tape.
- Adapt surroundings. Move to shade or cooler place.
- Allow arrays to cool off before restarting treatment.


MyLink™

Upload your Optune Gio® data to MyLink regularly or when in need of technical assistance.





Plug MyLink into the wall socket, then **turn MyLink on** with the switch in the back. The top **U** light will blink, then turn solid green.




Start with your device off. **Connect** the gray MyLink cable to the top of your device.





Turn on the device to start the download step. The middle <u>u</u> light will blink while downloading.



Once download is complete, the middle 🖭 light will turn solid green & MyLink will beep.

Unplug the gray MyLink cable from your device.






When the bottom <u>•</u> light is blinking, that means data is uploading to Novocure's system. This can take up to 15 minutes.

Once all three lights are solid green, the upload was successful. **You can turn off MyLink.**
