The program accepts household pharmaceutical wastes, which may include nicotine medications (patches), however they would not accept vape cartridges (not a medication). They also restrict disposal of any schedule one controlled substances (THC vape cartridges) through their programs.

Maybe then an info sheet would be utilized if it was focused on how schools can prepare their vape waste for the locally organized vape waste disposal.






