



All adults – gambling & problem gambling (PG)






Adults who gambled – gambling & PG




PGSI = Problem Gambling Severity Index (modified scoring protocol R. Volberg et.al.)

Gambling means betting money or possessions, either in person or online, including video poker, phone apps, e-sports, etc.


In the past 12 months, has YOUR gambling ever caused problems at home, school or with your friends?

HYS 2021 Results - All Youth


N = 20,575

- Impact of findings on Problem Gambling Task Force recommendations
- New legislation just passed (SB 5634)
- ▶ Plans for 2023-2025 & beyond...
 - Year-round Prevention
 - Increase Outreach to higher-risk populations
 - Workforce development Certified Gambling Counselors for unserved/underserved areas and communities
 - ► Increased funding for problem gambling treatment srvcs starts 1/1/24
 - ► Problem gambling treatment coverage under Medicaid starts 1/1/24
