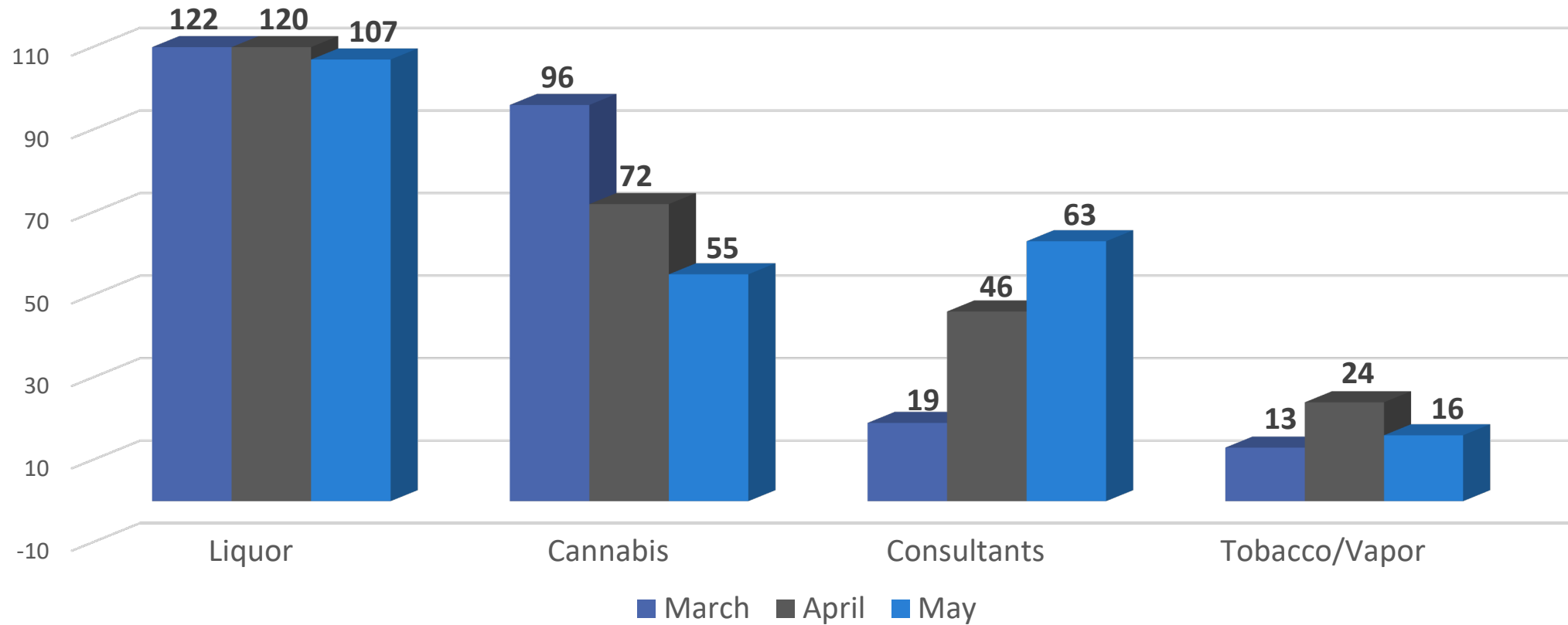

Number of Complaints by Unit



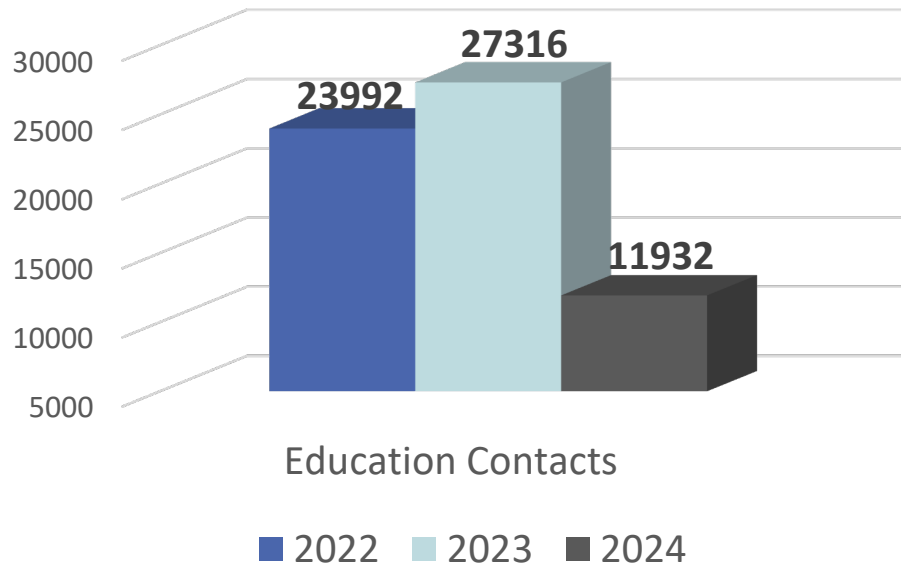

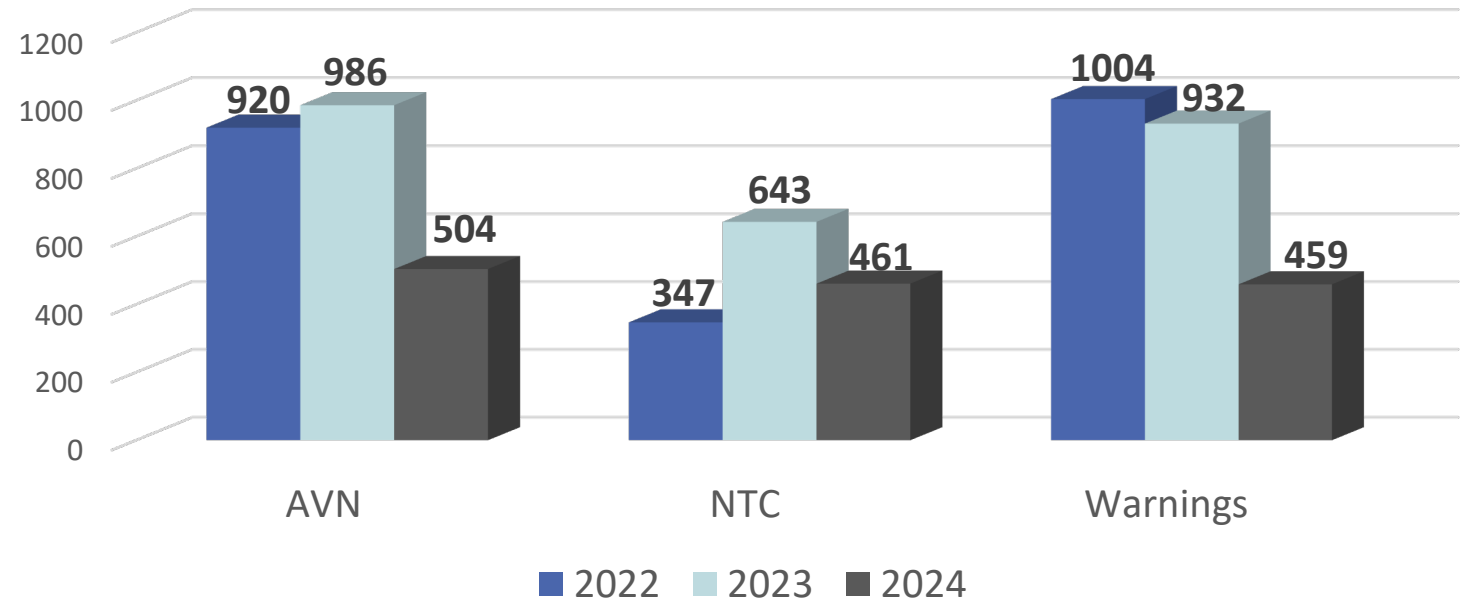

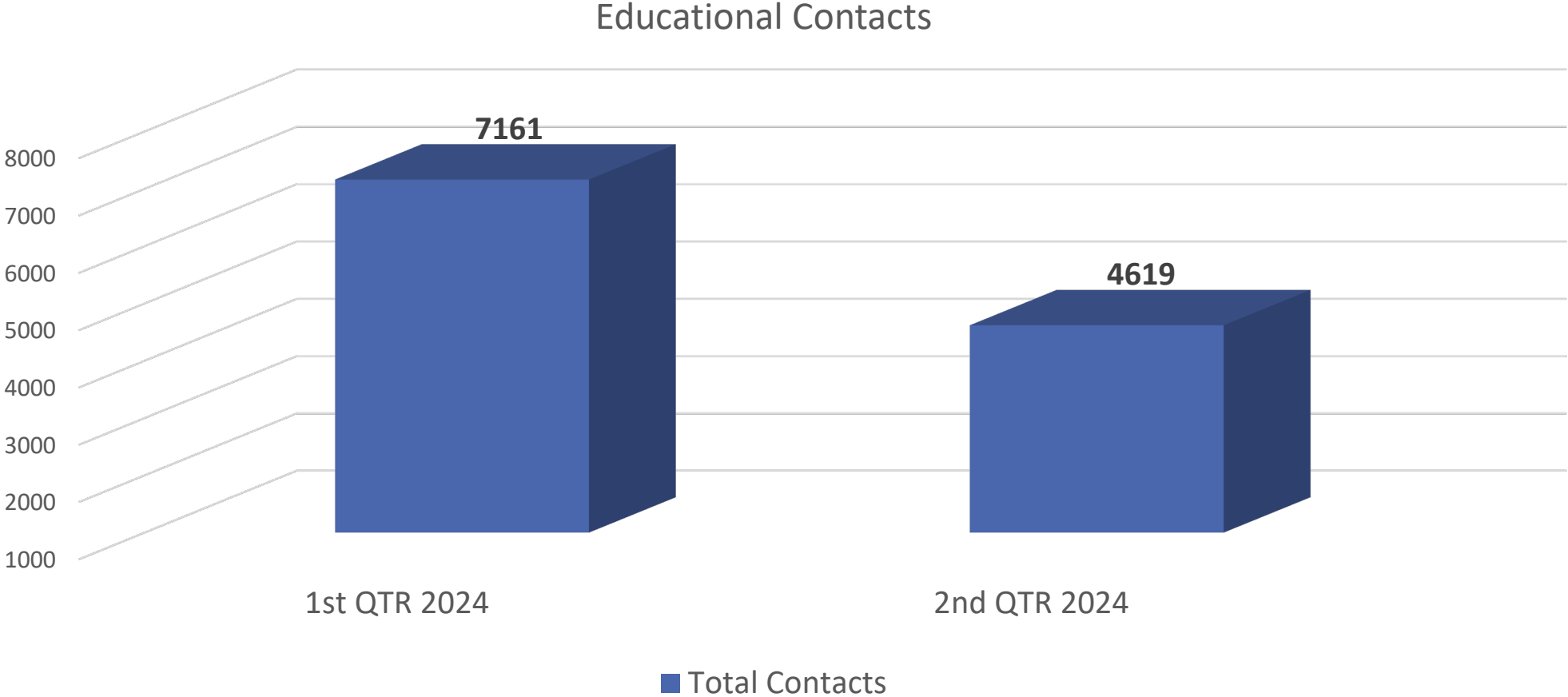

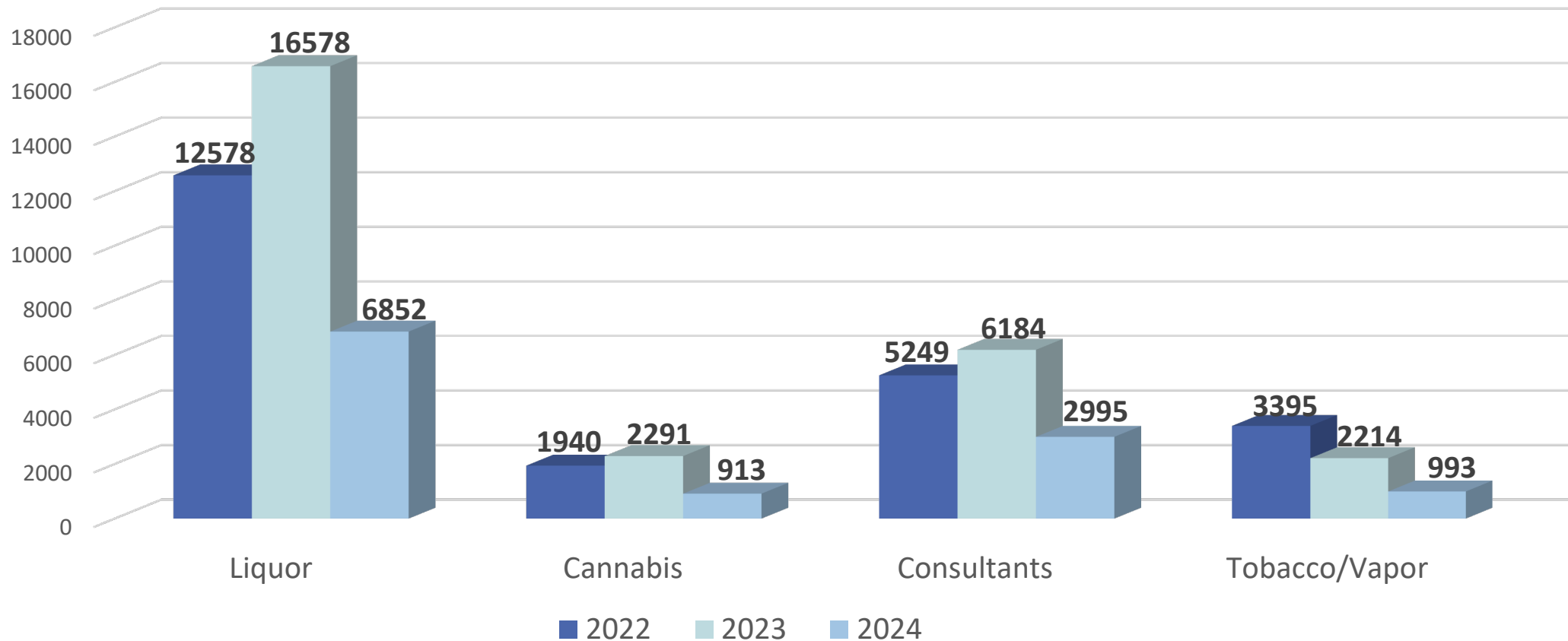


Licensee Education



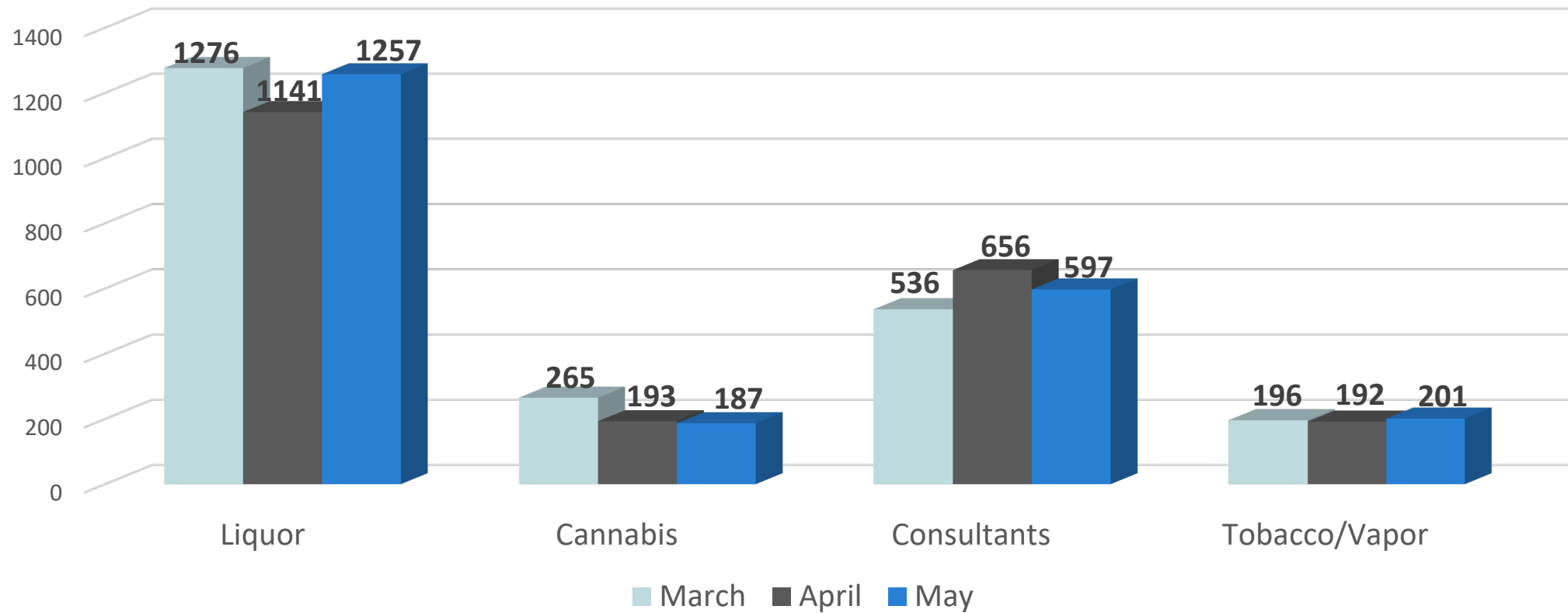
Education Contact Breakdown

Year to date



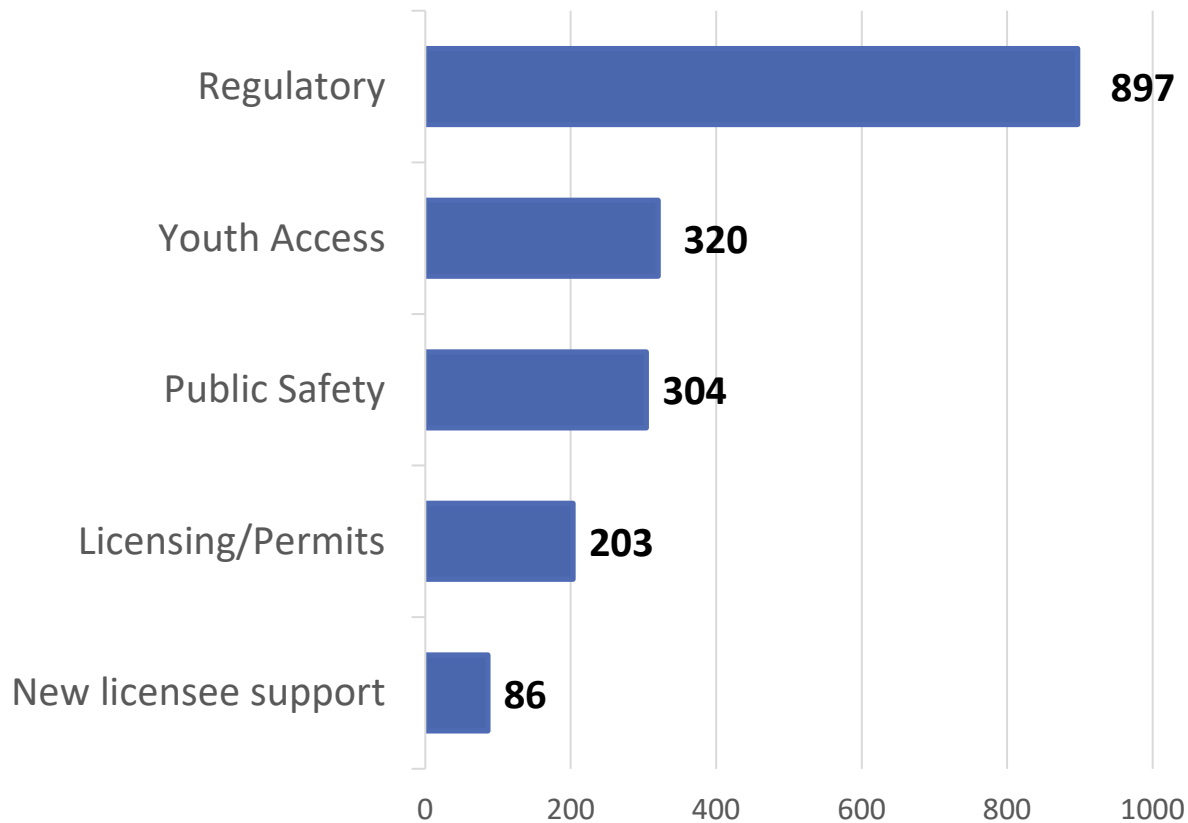

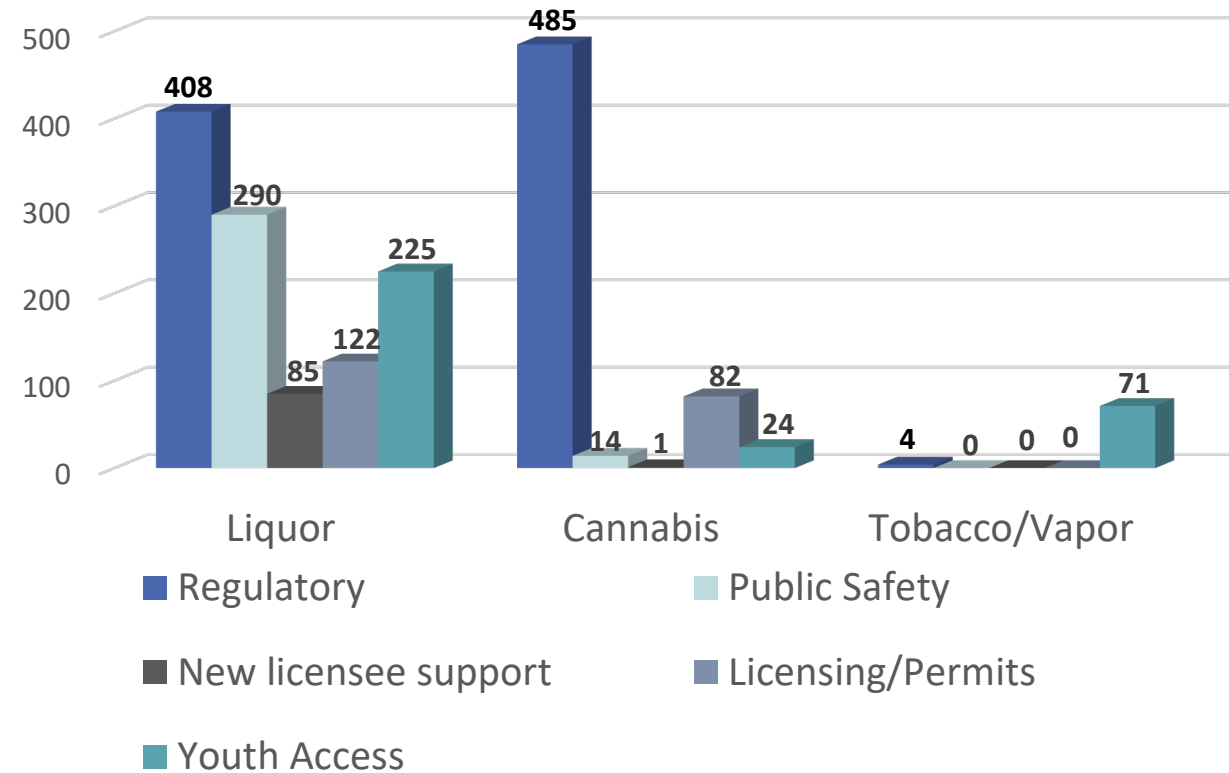

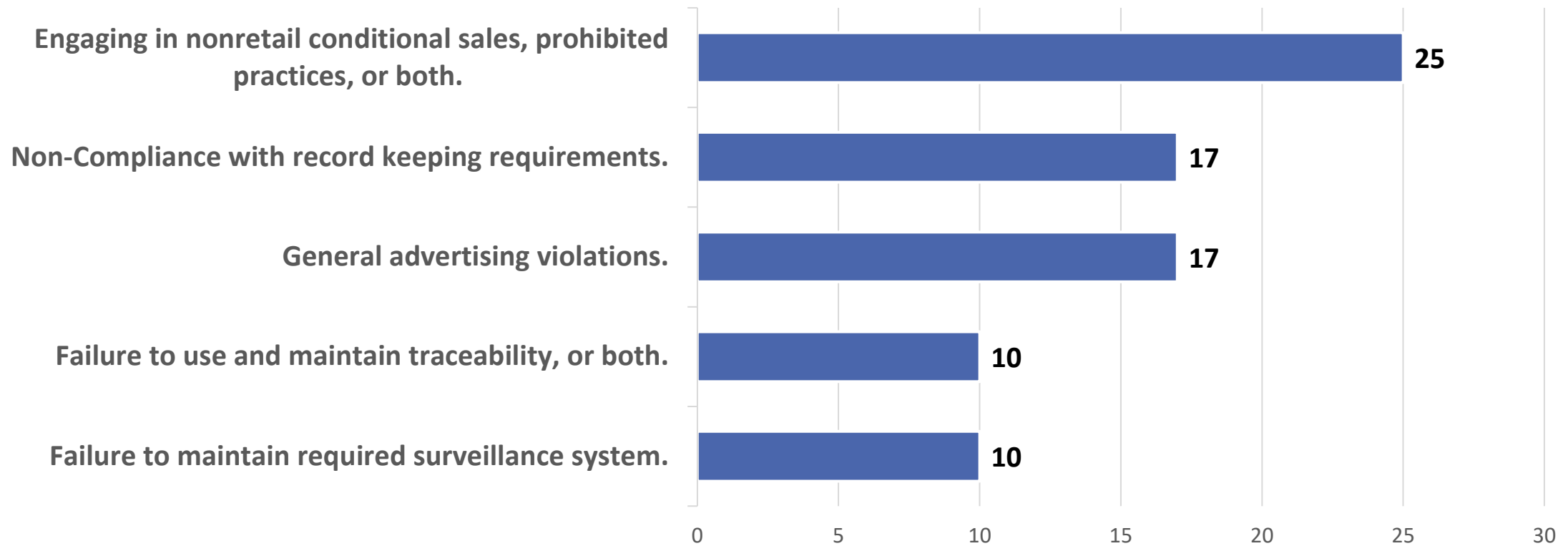


Education Topics by Industry

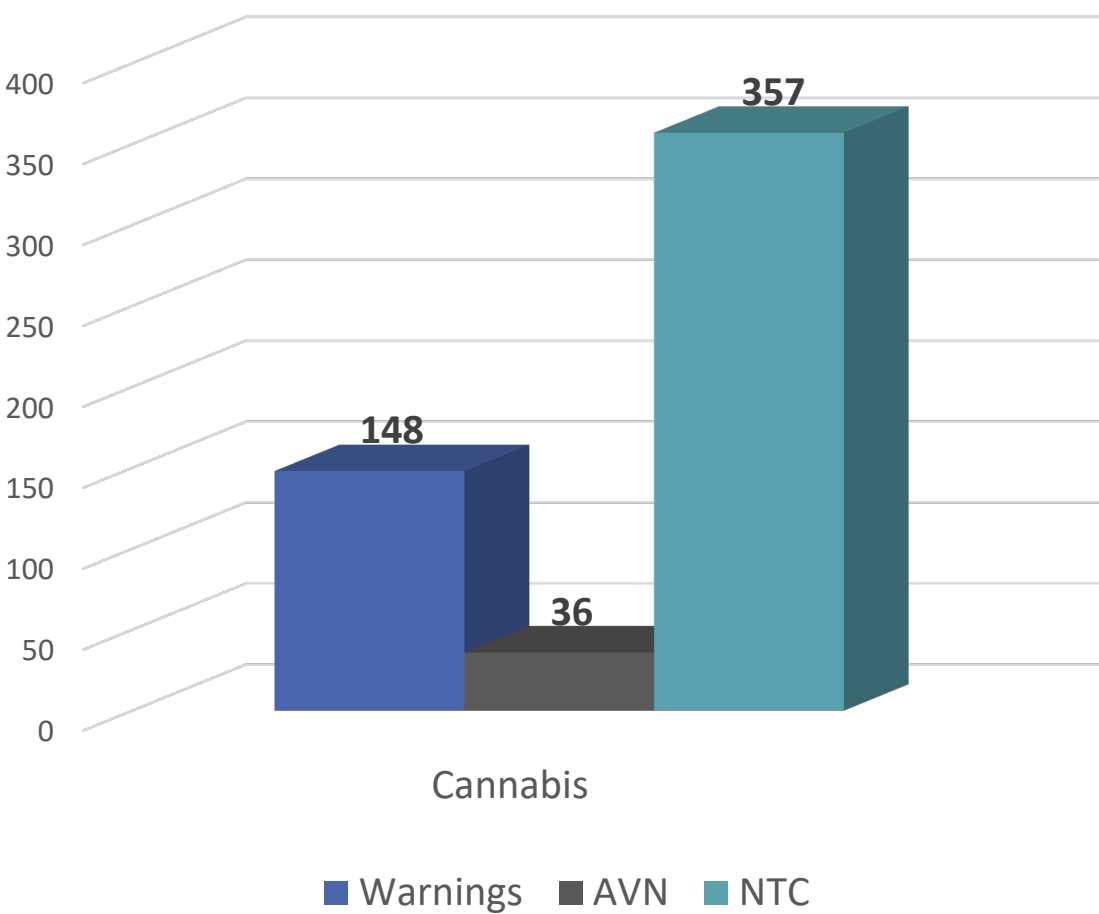
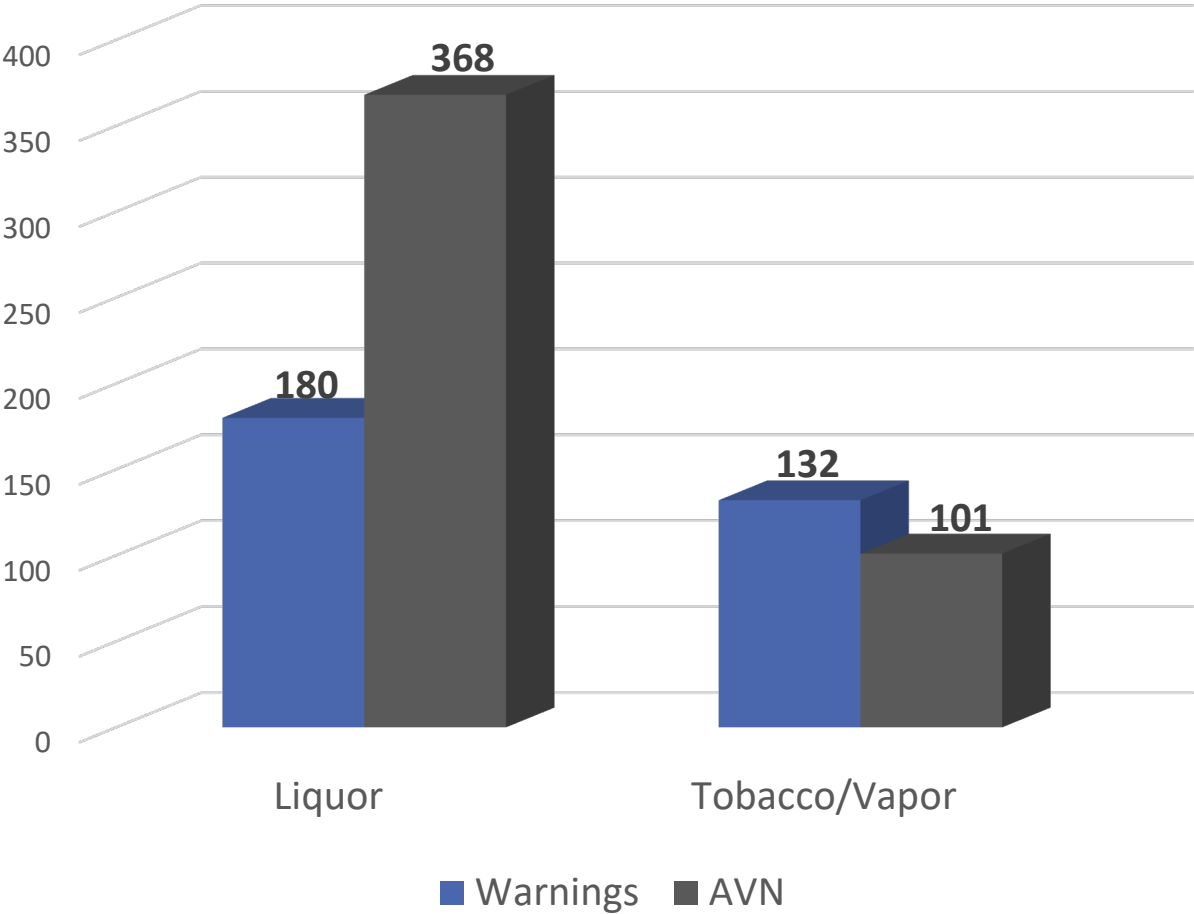

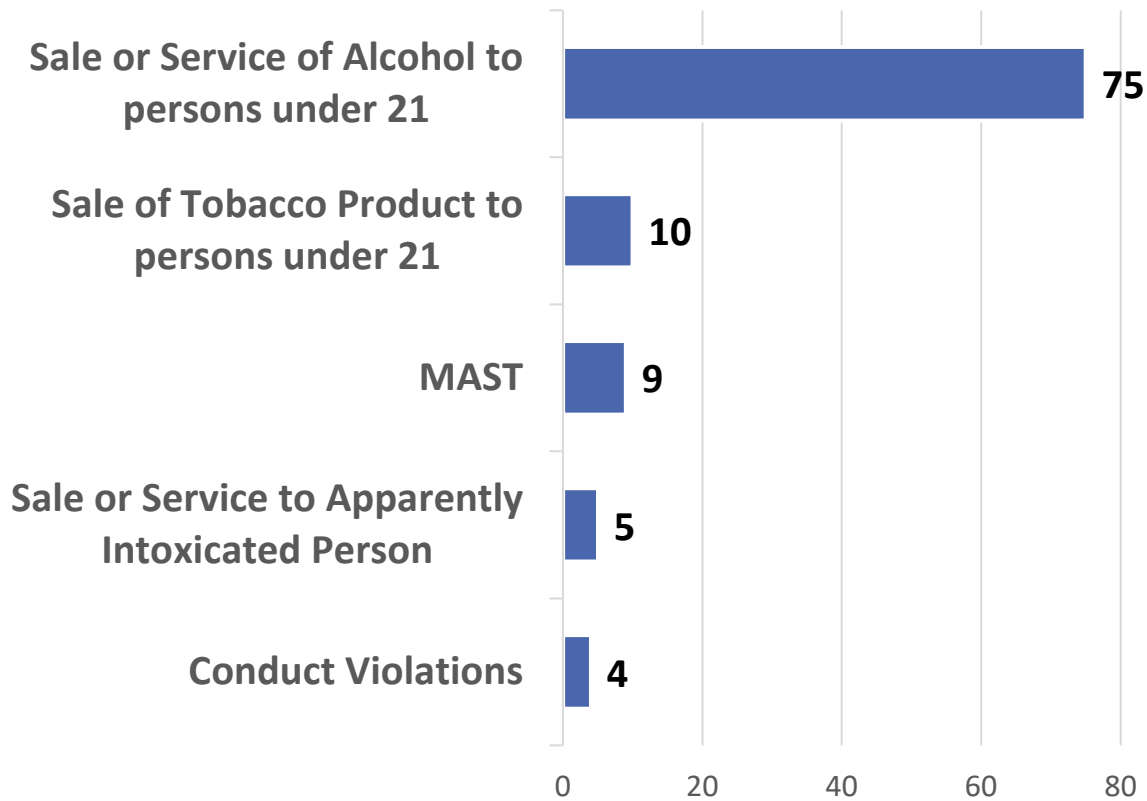


Violation Breakdown CY2024

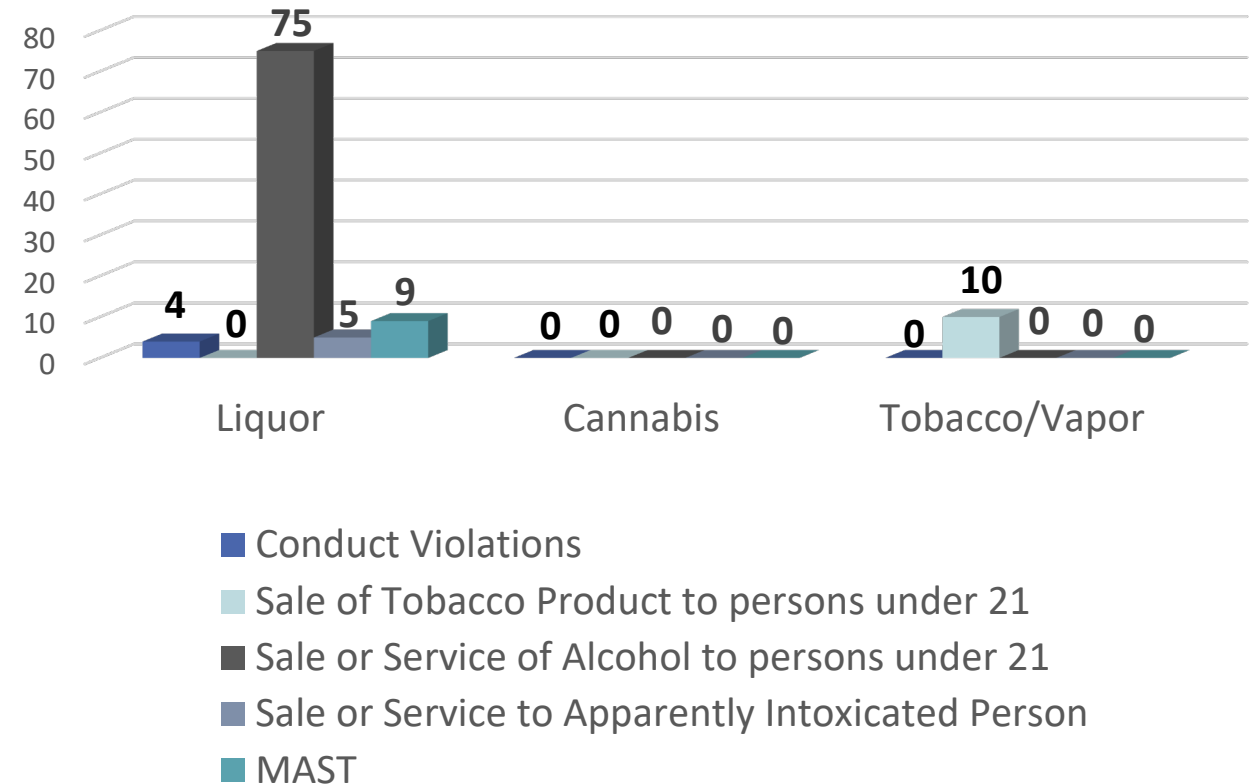


Administrative Violations Notices (AVN) May 2024

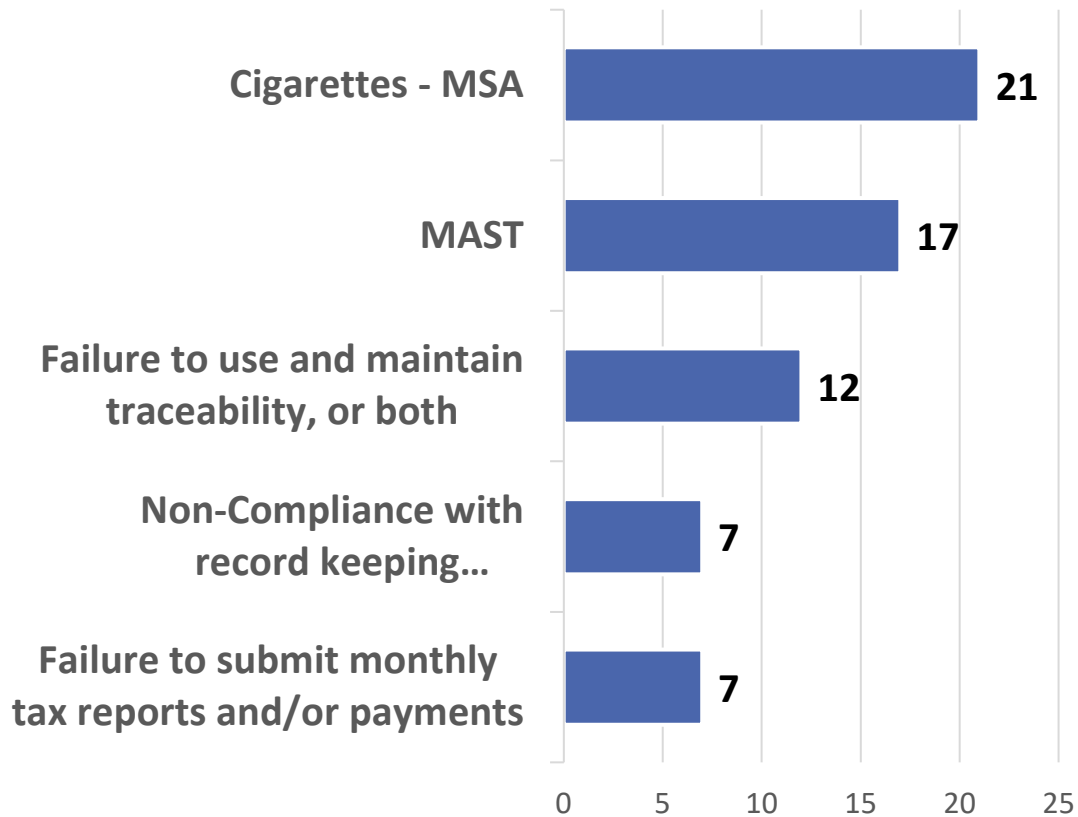


AVN by Industry

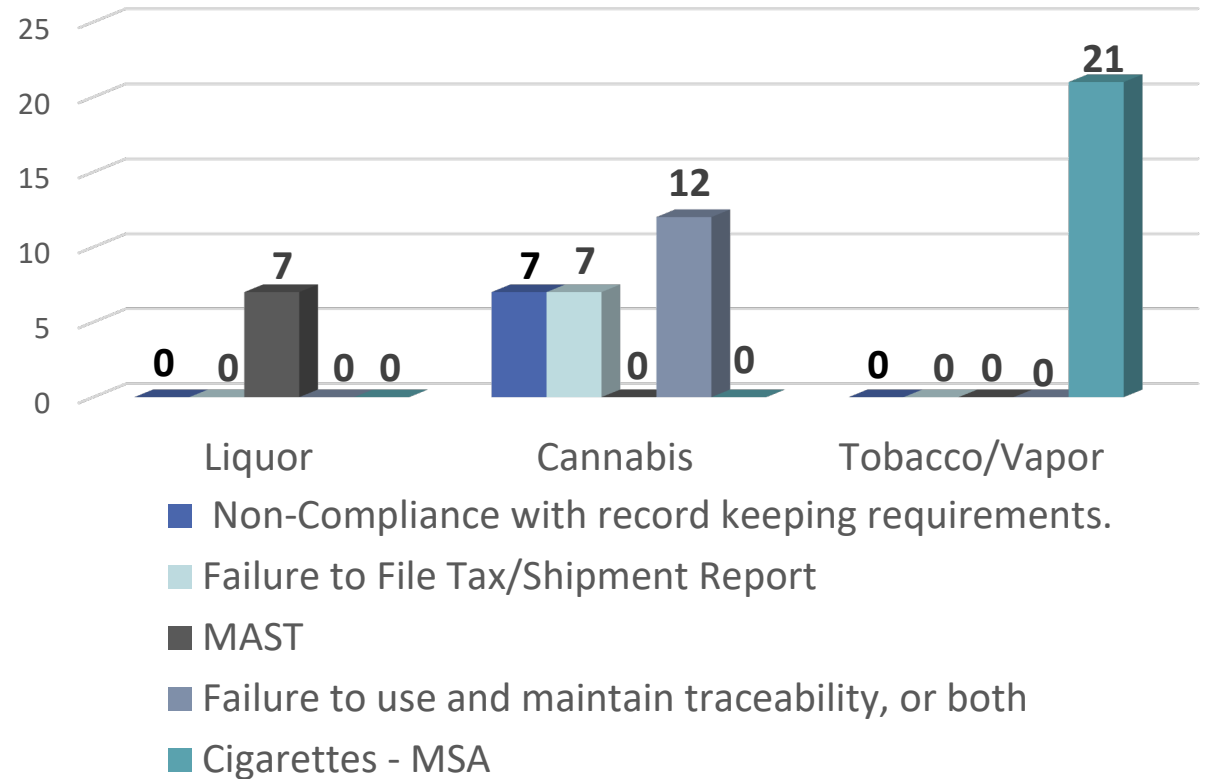


Warning Topics May 2024

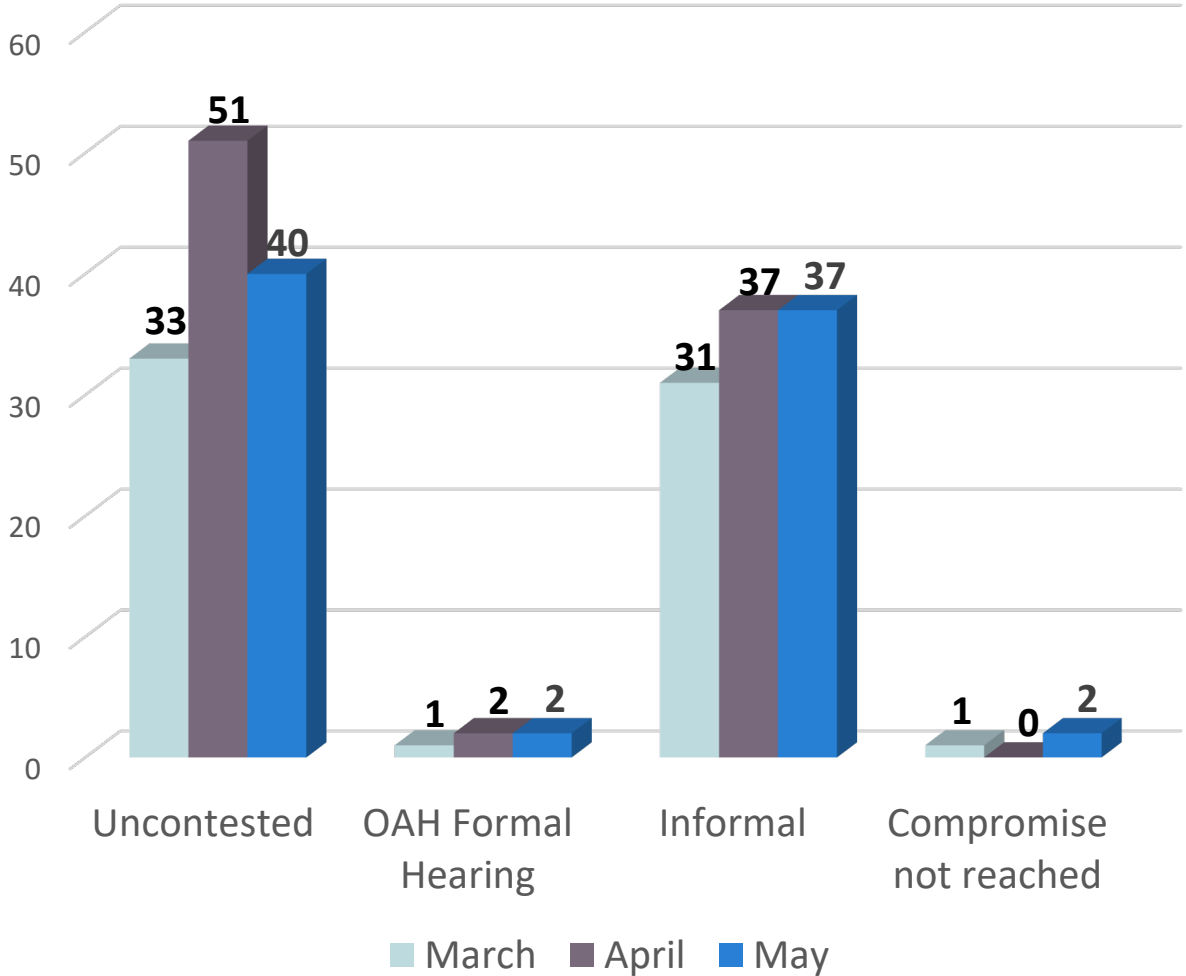


Warning Topics by Industry

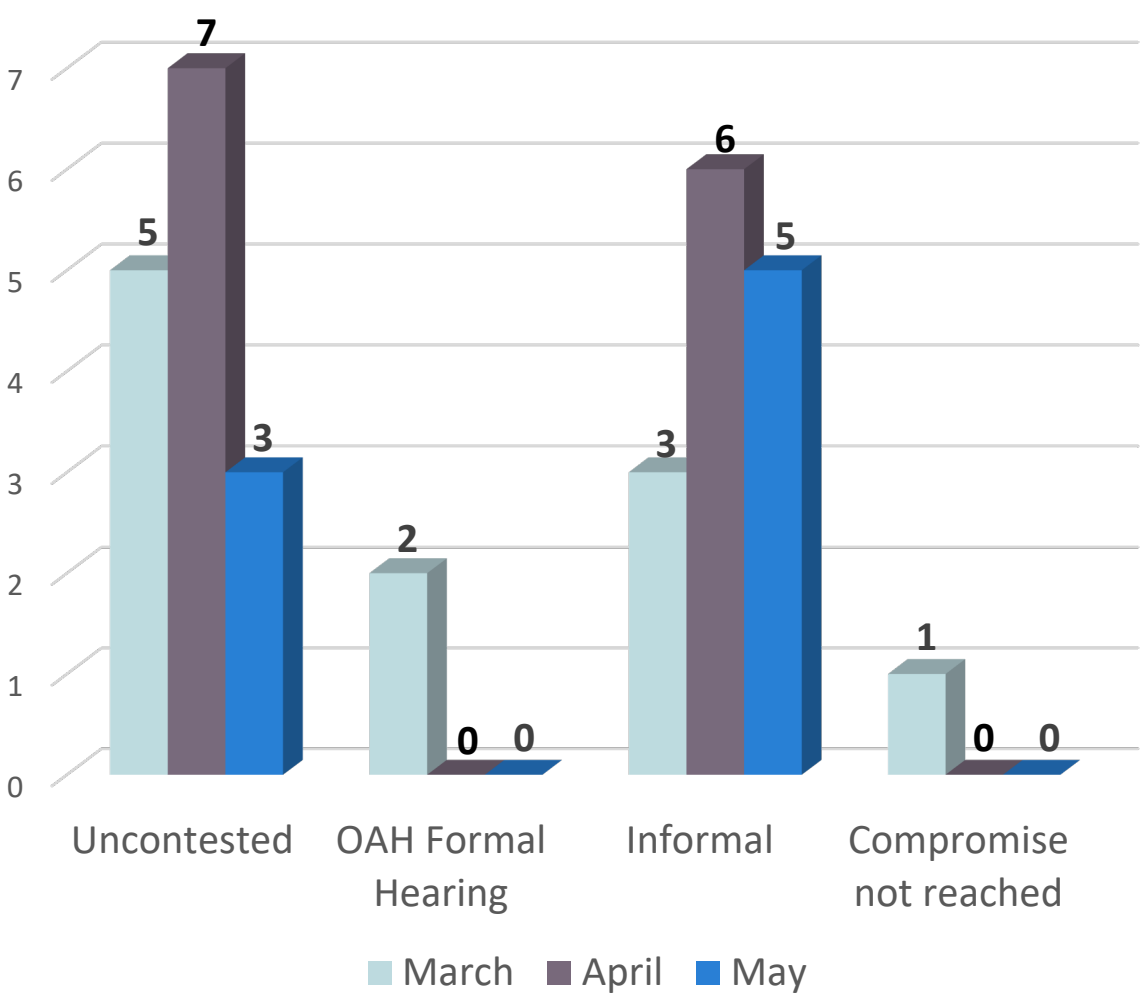

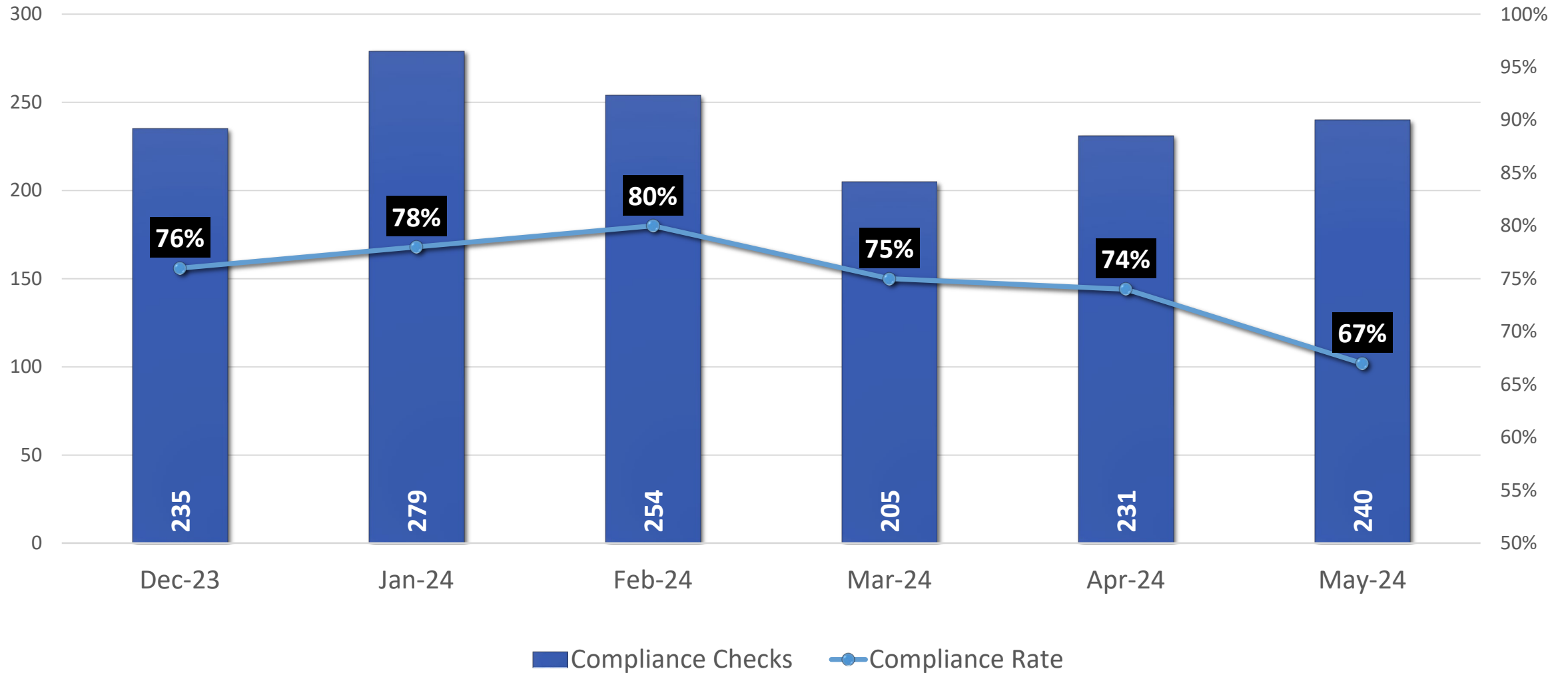

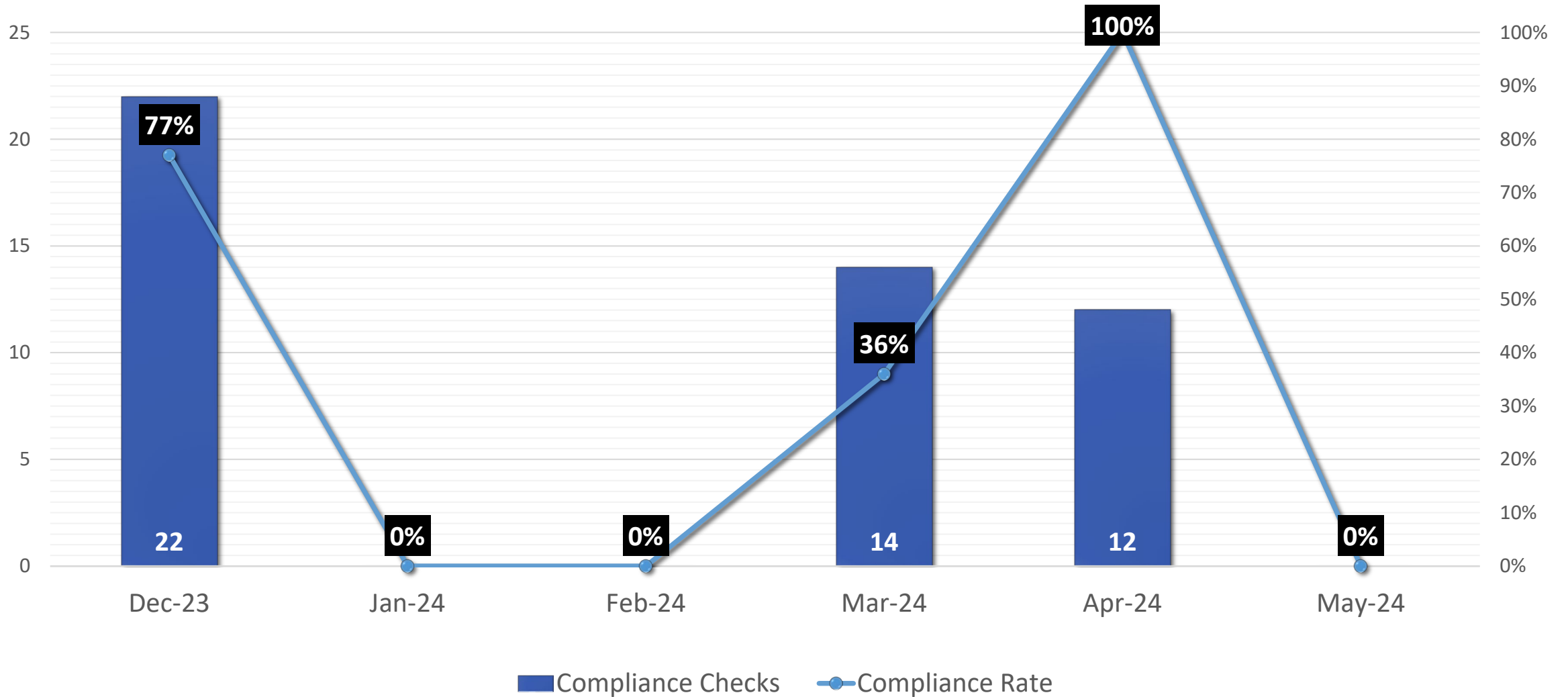

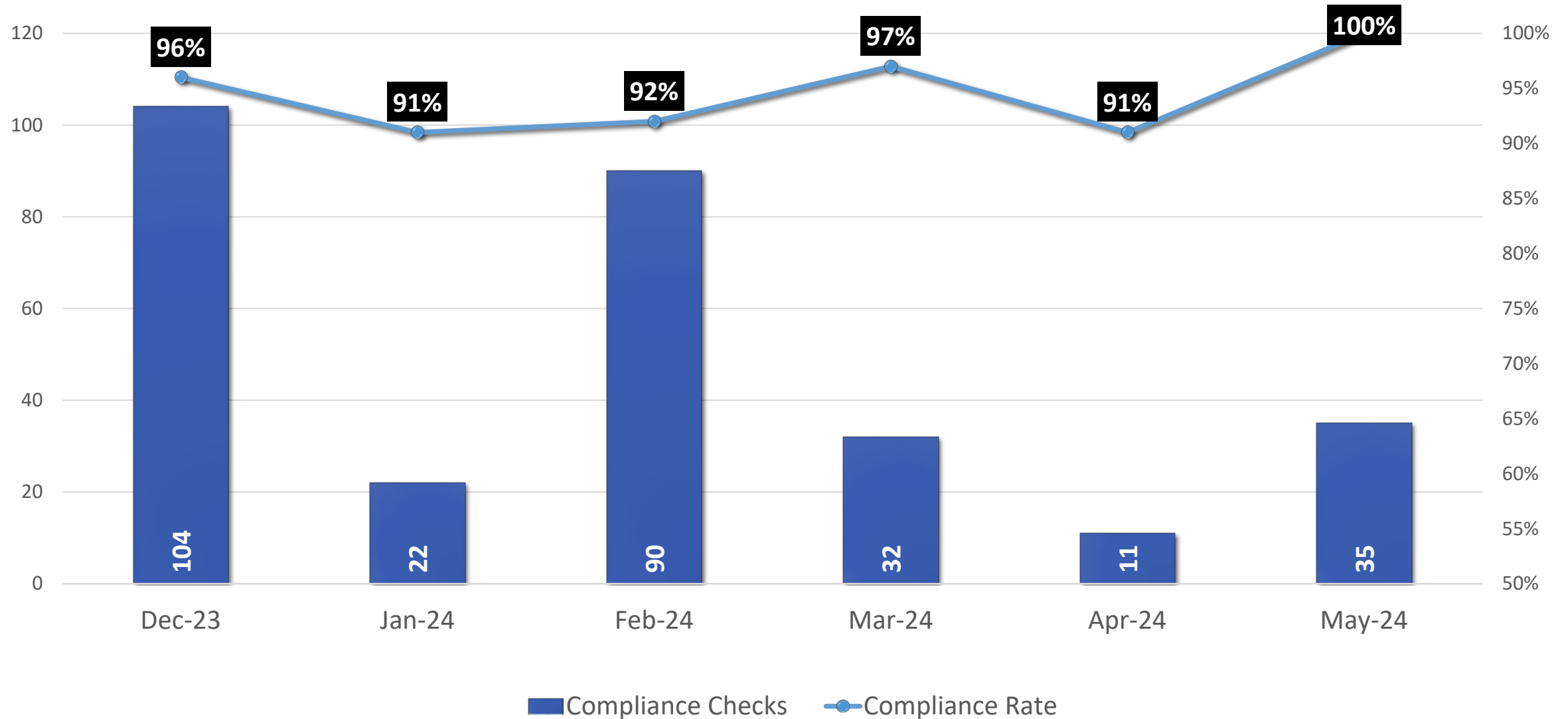
Liquor Compliance: Youth Access



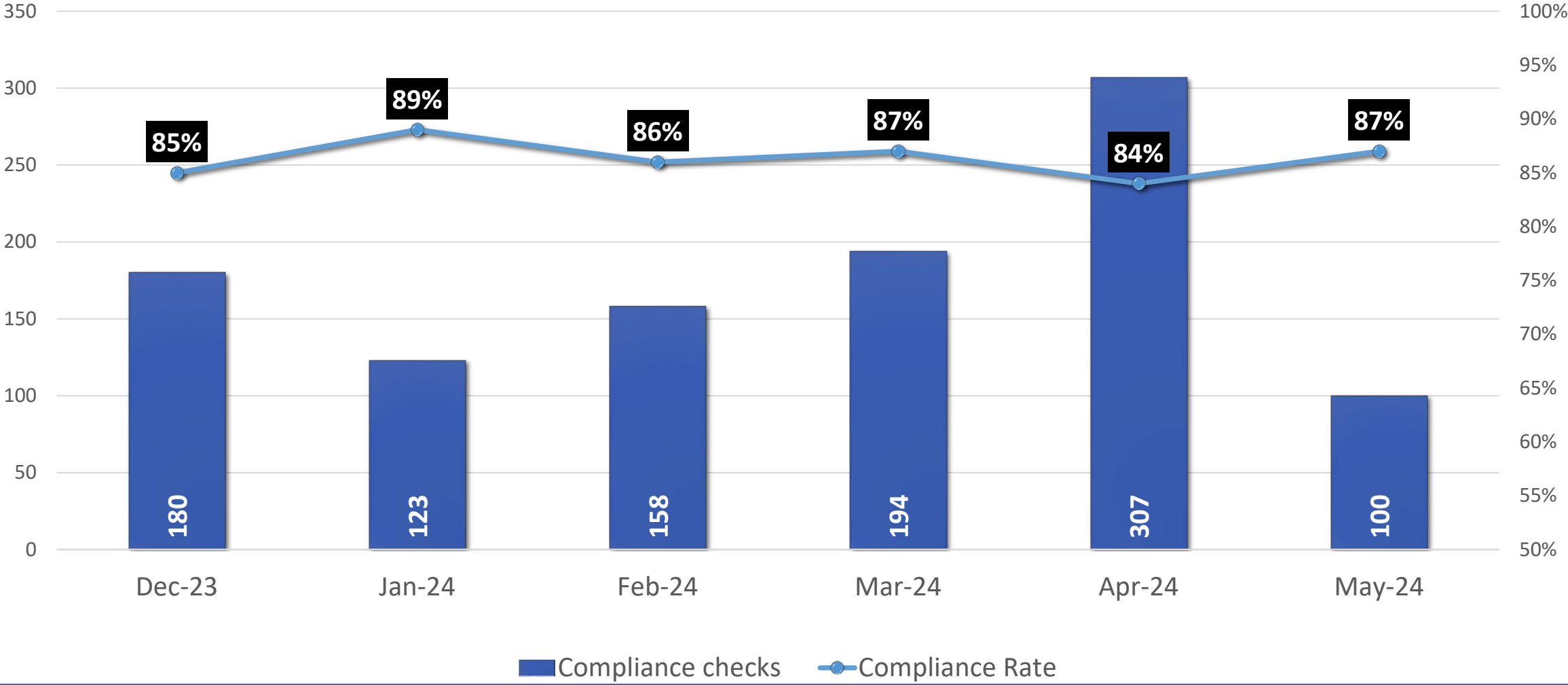
Delivery /Curbside/Pickup Compliance: Youth Access



Cannabis Compliance: Youth Access

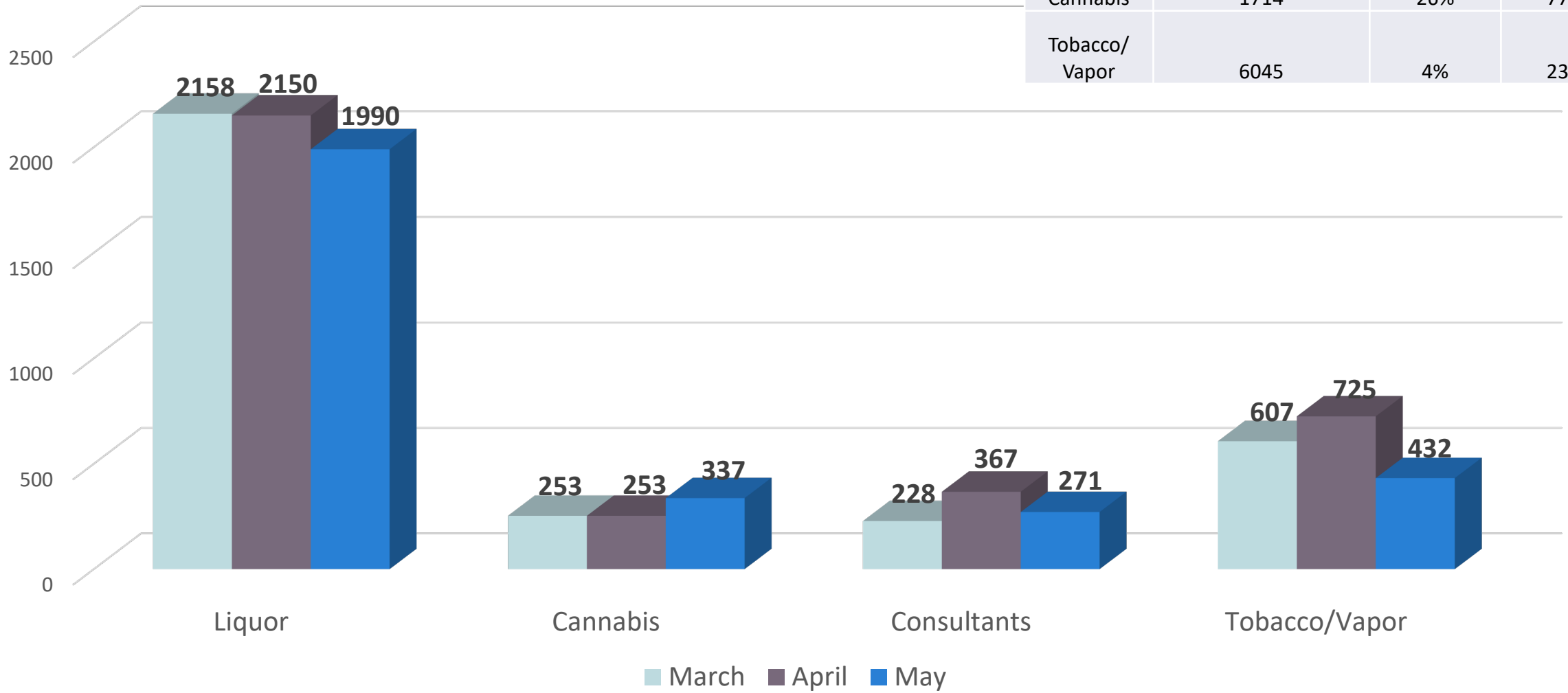


Tobacco and Vapor Compliance: Youth Access

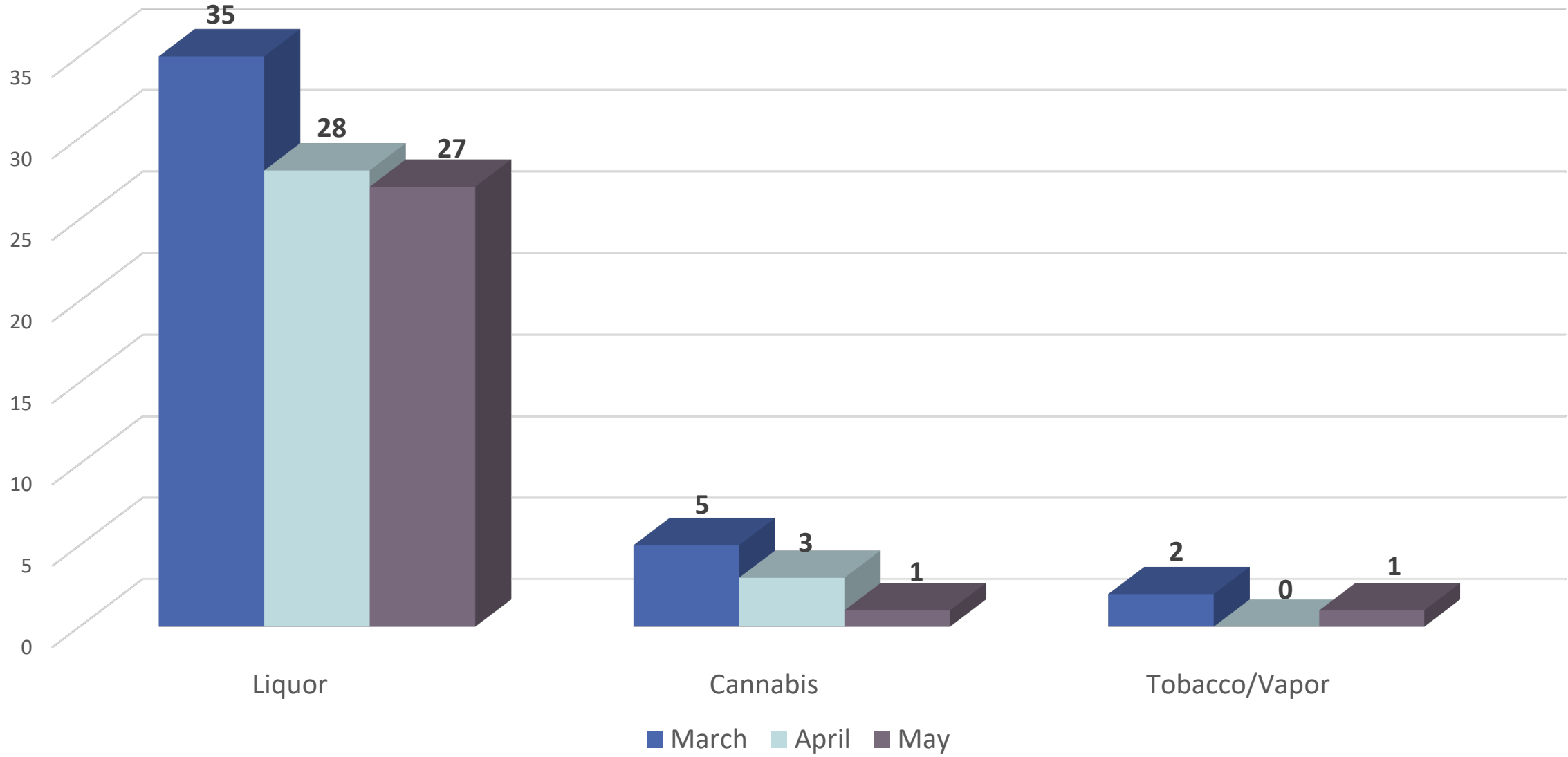

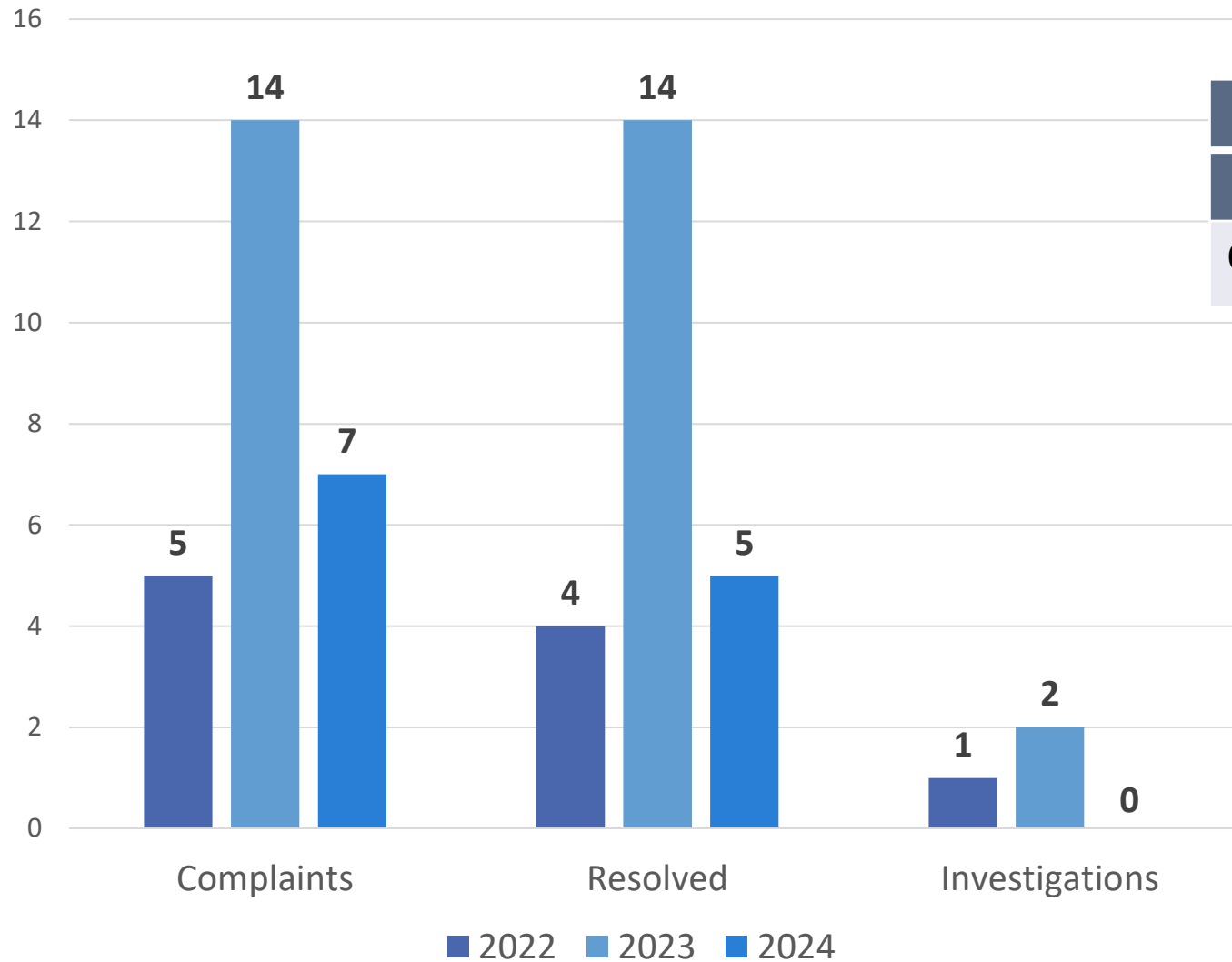
