Inking sketch, 9×12 , 6/15/2024



Lotus


Watercolor, 11 x 14, 5/12/24

Fire & Water Acrylic, 11 x 14, 5/19/23



02 Cityscapes

I've lived on three continents and explored many countries, my travels inspired me to explore various landscapes and city scenes.

"City Days" shows a rainy, crowded street where people move through their day, with soft colors reflecting a sense of solitude. In contrast, "Canal City" presents a peaceful view of Venice in warm sunlight, using delicate watercolors to create a feeling of nostalgia. These artworks aim to show the complexity of city life, highlighting both its isolation and its lasting charm.

"City Days" captures the frenetic energy and melancholic beauty of a rainy cityscape, reminiscent of my time in London. Collage, 18 x 24, 3/5/23



Imaginary Audience

This artwork blends acrylic paints with photograph cutouts, depicting the childhood fear of being constantly watched. Through vivid imagery and symbolism, it explores universal themes of paranoia and vulnerability, inviting viewers to contemplate the boundaries between reality and "The Imaginary Audience". along with how it shapes our sense of self.



Friend or Foe

Acrylic, 18 x 24, 12/12/2023

Inspired by psychological themes from Edgar Allan Poe, Frida Kahlo, and Vincent Van Gogh, this artwork explores the complex realm of the mind—our friend or foe. The intricate designs within the girl's mind and the two flowers and hands depict the clash of opposing forces. Viewers are asked to contemplate the endless battle within, questioning whether the mind will be a loyal companion or an opponent to us.



The Beauty Within

Colored Pencil on Foam Board, 18 x 24, 1/14/2024

Inspired by Afremov's palette and Kahlo's emotional appeal, this piece centers on a girl with a twist. With the theme of 'Latching on to Past,' her eye holds a void, a vessel for a blooming daffodil symbolizing unexpected growth. Vibrant hues reflect vivid memories, exploring the idea that within unforeseen circumstances, there's room for internal beauty and transformation.



04 Observational Pieces

This category combines my previous work, reflecting my love for exploring different countries, cultures, and my own background.

This collection of portraits explores the deep connections we have with ourselves, our loved ones, and the animals that bring joy to our lives. Solitude Acrylic, 11 x 14, 3/20/2024



Keeping up with technology, I started exploring digital art using an iPad and stylus switching from a traditional canyas


