This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, and protect your personal information when you use our website. By using our website and choosing your cookie preferences, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Privacy Notice.

1. Information We Collect:

We use Matomo Analytics to gather information about the usage of our website. Matomo Analytics uses two cookies:

_pk_id (13 months): This cookie is used to store a few details about the user, such as the unique visitor ID. It helps us understand how visitors interact with our website over time.

_pk_ses (one hour): This cookie is used to temporarily store data for the visit. It helps us track the pages visited and the duration of the visit.

These cookies do not collect personally identifiable information.

2. How We Use the Information:

The information collected through Matomo Analytics is used to analyze website usage patterns, track the effectiveness of our content, and improve the user experience. We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer this information to external parties.

3. Your Options:

When you first visit our website, you will encounter a cookies management pop-up. You have the option to accept or reject analytical cookies set by Matomo Analytics. If you choose to reject these cookies, Matomo Analytics will not collect data about your visit.

By not accepting analytical cookies, you will still be able to access the functionalities of our site.

4. Data Security:

The data collected by Matomo Analytics is stored in servers located within the European Union (EU), ensuring compliance with EU data protection regulations. We do not collect personally identifiable information such as ip address.
