

The Urban Community Development Commission (UCDC) was established by Ordinance No. 1,479, adopted on July 15, 1975. The Commission functions as the governing body for the Local Housing Authority (LHA) and exercises the power, authority, jurisdiction and functions of housing authorities and federal surplus property authorities granted under the Marks Foran Residential Rehabilitation Act to charter cities.
