

The Successor Agency to the Compton Community Redevelopment Agency, is a distinct and separate legal entity from the City of Compton, and was established by Resolution No. 1, adopted on February 7, 2012. The Successor Agency is limited to the assets and liabilities of the dissolved Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) of the City of Compton and shall have the authority to perform the functions and duties described in Part 1.85 to Division 24 of the California Health and Safety Code.
