PUBLIC COMMENTS ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

Lorraine Cervantes, Compton resident, assented to being impressed by the incoming executive secretary. However she stated, he's not really the executive secretary until he signs the contract. She charged that in the past, she's been accused of helping certain commissioners go to jail. She claimed that she's never had anything to do with anybody going to jail and from what she could see, they put themselves in jail. She contested to seeing several violations of the City Charter and presumed the City Attorney should tell the Commission that they do not have exclusive power, only collectively, nor do they have the right to give orders to any commissioner or city employee. She maintained that if these violations persist, she will do everything within her power to make sure someone goes to jail.

Lynn Boone, Compton resident, forewarned the members of the audience that she would continue to remind them about last week's budget process. She conceded that the budget was approved by three commissioners; a budget that did not balance, had many flaws, and was rewritten within a matter of two weeks. She apologized to Chairperson Perrodin for leaving the meeting and indicated that there were things she believed Chairperson Perrodin wanted to say, but forgot. One of them being, the City Attorney disrespecting the Commission and the citizens by hiring two interns for his office. She contended that this was not in line with his job description in the City Charter and further suggested that he expend his own funds to do so. She reported that Reverend Colven hadn't been feeling well and asked that he be allowed to speak under the City Council agenda.
