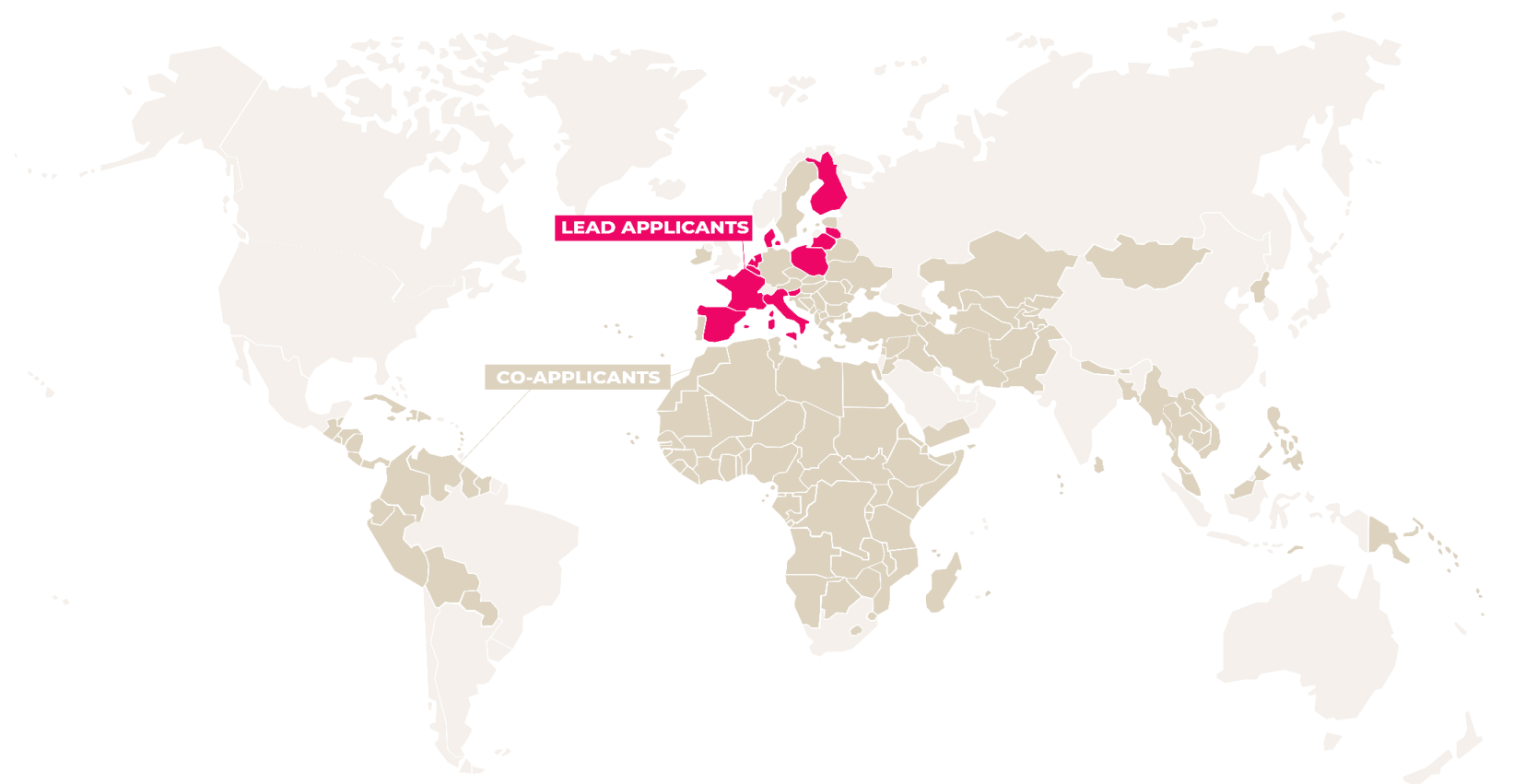


Figure 1 - World map showcasing eligible countries for lead applicants (highlighted in pink) and co-applicants (pink and dark grey)
