Hello and thank you for inquiring about Amazing Grace Early Education Center's 2½-to 8 year-old Summer Camp program. You will find that most all our correspondence will be communicated through email, website, or our Facebook page. This allows us to instantly get you the most up-to-date information quickly. Below you will find our prices and our program times. Attached are the enrollment forms that will start the process of enrolling your child with us for summer camp. Once your child is enrolled, you will receive the remainder of the enrollment packet via email.

If you have not had the opportunity to schedule your personal tour with us, please feel free to do so at any time. We are able to schedule personal tours, however, they will be in the evening after school hours per Covid regulations. Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis.

Once the application forms are completed, applications can be emailed directly to Shelley at smcfarland@ageec.net. A Smartcare account will be established with you to pay the registration fee. You may also mail it to Amazing Grace Early Education Center, PO Box 425, Pedricktown, NJ 08067, or you may bring it to the school office. <a href="mailto:Once the applications are received, they are dated and timed because the classroom availability is on a first come first serve basis. All forms must be completed, signed and turned in with the registration fee listed below to be considered complete and for us to enroll the student.

A 5% discount is given for attending 5 days a week. A 10% is given to the second child enrolled.

If your family participates in the Rutgers Quality Care program, parents will be responsible for any co-payments that are not paid for through the Rutgers Quality Care program. For example: Rutgers Quality Care currently pays \$31.28 per child attending full time status. Amazing Grace's cost from 8:30 am to 3:15 pm is \$42.00 a day, the difference the parents would be responsible for is \$10.72 a day. If a student uses morning care or aftercare services, those costs are additional as well and paid for by the parent. The total cost from 7 am to 5:30 pm is \$59.50, Quality Care covers up to \$31.28 a day, the co-payment for the parent would be \$28.22 a day which is the responsibility of the parent.

Once a family has completed the summer enrollment application the tuition invoice will be calculated for you by how many days the child is enrolled for a week and how long the child is enrolled each day. AGEEC does not charge for scheduled holidays and holiday breaks. **Tuitions are based on weekly totals and are to be paid weekly on the Monday of the week of camp.** If a parent does not pay by Wednesday of the current camp week, the child will not be permitted to finish camp of the current week or attend the following weeks they are registered for until payment is received. Payments can be made on your Smartcare account which will be established upon enrollment. Cash, check, or credit cards are accepted. If a credit card is used, a 3% percent fee will be charged. Parents can pay with a credit card or ACH on the Smartcare system which will be assigned to them. (If you use your checking account information, no fee will be charged.)

Late Pickup Policy

I understand and accept:

Pickup for camp is from 3:15 pm to 3:30 pm Monday through Friday unless my child is participating in extended care. Parents must enroll their child in the aftercare program prior to attending.

Cancellation Policy

I understand and accepts:

Deposits and application fees are non-refundable. Any cancellations made due to medical reasons before camp begins must include a letter from the child's physician. This will result in a refund of camp fees.

There is a \$15 administration fee for switching camp dates. Switching is not allowed fewer than 7 days from the start of camp. Switching is only permitted if space is available.

AGEEC reserves the right for a camp week to me cancelled due to lack of enrollment. All camp schedules will be known by the end of May 2021 so that families can make other arrangements if a week should be cancelled.

Food Policy
